GAMECOCK NOTABLES

- Tonight's game marks the Gamecocks' second appearance in the ACC/SEC Challenge. In the inaugural event last season, South Carolina topped #24 North Carolina 65-58 in Chapel Hill (Nov. 30, 2023).
- South Carolina is playing its fourth ranked opponent of the season, and the Gamecocks' schedule includes 14 games against teams ranked this week or at the time of the game. Seven of those games are against non-conference foes.
- The Gamecock bench is notable for more than just its scoring (see below). The group also accounts for 20.4 rebounds per game, which is 47.8 percent of the team's total. Two of the team's top three rebounders come off the bench – Ashlyn Watkins (6.3) and Joyce Edwards (6.1). The duo is also the team's top two in steals and among the top three in blocks.
- Since returning from injury at Clemson, sophomore Tessa Johnson has been on an offensive tear, leading the team with 10.5 points per game on 50.0 percent shooting that includes 57.1 percent accuracy from 3-point range in that stretch. In the last three games, including two against ranked opponents, she averaged 11.3 points.
- Joyce Edwards earned SEC co-Freshman of the Week honors this week after leading the team with 12.0 points and 10.0 rebounds per game at the Fort Myers Tip-Off last weekend. The forward was building to the moment, which included her first career double-double (vs. #15/15 Iowa State), averaging 10.0 points over the last five games on 50.0 percent shooting in that stretch. Her 3.13 offensive rebounds per game on the season rank 12th in the SEC.
- Freshman Maddy McDaniel is second in the nation with a 7.00 assist-to-turnover ratio that includes four games of at least four assists and three turnover-free games.
- Senior Te-Hina Paopao remains the Gamecocks' top scorer at 12.0 points per game and is 15th in the SEC with 49.4 percent shooting. She also continues to show her value and skills beyond scoring. She applied full-court defensive pressure in the Gamecocks' domination of #15/15 Iowa State, and her 2.9 assists per game are second on the team.
- Sophomore MiLaysia Fulwiley shook off a pair of tough shooting games to pour in 14 points on 45.5 percent shooting against Purdue (Nov. 30)

A Perennial Power

South Carolina women's basketball had been a national power for more than a decade under head coach Dawn Staley, including seven 30-win seasons in the last 10 campaigns. The Gamecocks have played in six Final Fours in the last nine NCAA Tournaments, including the last four, with National Championships in 2017, 2022 and 2024. They have been ranked in every AP Poll since Dec. 10, 2012, including a top-10 spot every week since the start of the 2019-20 season. The Gamecocks have amassed 86 AP No. 1 rankings all-time, the third-most by a program in the history of that poll.

Under head coach Dawn Staley's leadership, 11 Gamecocks have earned All-America status, three have earned SEC Player of the Year honors and 22 have picked up All-SEC recognition at least once.

In the last nine seasons, 14 Gamecocks have been selected in the WNBA Draft, including 10 first-round picks, highlighted by two No. 1 overall picks in the last six years. In the 2024 season, 12 Gamecocks were on a WNBA roster, the second most of any program in the country. Three Gamecocks have been named WNBA Rookie of the Year and one is a three-time WNBA MVP and two-time WNBA Defensive Player of the Year.

The Duke Series

The Gamecocks are 7-2 all-time against Duke, including a 6-1 mark in the Dawn Staley era (beginning 2008-09).

South Carolina has won the last four meetings overall and the last four in which both teams have been nationally ranked. The two teams have met three times in Colonial Life Arena with all three going to the Gamecocks.

In last season's meeting in Durham (Dec. 3), South Carolina used dominant second and fourth quarters to rally back for a 77-61 victory. The Blue Devils tied the game at 55-55 with 7:43 to play before 22-6 run closed the game.

Home Sweet Home

The Gamecocks are 532-166 (.761) in home games (some records prior to 1976-77 did not include location of games). Current head coach Dawn Staley is 220-34 at home for a program-best .866 winning percentage.

South Carolina currently has a program-record 61-game home winning streak that began on Dec. 17, 2020.

Playing in its 22nd season at Colonial Life Arena, South Carolina boasts a 282-67 (.808) record in the building, including four undefeated seasons since 2013-14. Staley's share of that record is 217-34 (.864).

Ranking Review

South Carolina climbed one spot in both polls to rank No. 3 in this week's AP Poll and No. 4 in the USA Today/WBCA Coaches' Poll.

It marks the Gamecocks 101st consecutive entry in the AP top 10, beginning with the 2019-20 preseason poll. It is the longest active streak and the 11th longest in the history of that poll (10th is 107, Duke). Their 232 straight

appearances in the AP Poll, dating back to Dec. 10, 2012, marks the second-longest active streak in the nation and the ninth longest all-time (8th place, Notre Dame, 234).

In the USA Today/WBCA Coaches' Poll, South Carolina has been in the top 10 since claiming the No. 10 spot in the 2019-20 preseason poll.

The Staley File

In her 25th season as a head coach, Dawn Staley has a .768 (619-187) winning percentage, which ranks ninth in the nation among active head coaches with at least 15 years of experience and 11th all-time.

The unanimous 2020 National Coach of the Year, Staley became the first person to win both Naismith Player of the Year and a Naismith Coach of the Year. In 2024, she became the first men's or women's coach to earn Naismith Coach of the Year in three straight seasons. Staley is also the first Black head coach to win multiple national championships in men's or women's basketball. She has been named national coach of the year by at least one organization five times, including four of the last five years.

Now in her 17th season with the Gamecocks, Staley is the program's all-time winningest coach (445) with a program-record 13 postseason appearances. She accounts for all six of the Gamecocks' Final Four appearances (2015, 2017, 2021, 2022, 2023, 2024) and the only NCAA National Championships in program history (2017, 2022, 2024).

Staley's eight SEC regular-season championships trail only Pat Summitt's 16 in league history, and her seven SEC Coach of the Year awards trails Summitt's league record by just one. Staley's 199 SEC regular-season wins are the most among active league coaches and third all-time – behind just Summitt (Tennessee, 306) and Andy Landers (Georgia, 273). Her 12.4 SEC wins per season is the best in league history among coaches with more than three years in the league, and her .783 SEC winning percentage (199-55) is second only to Summitt (.874).

Serious Scheduling

South Carolina head coach Dawn Staley has never been afraid to challenge her team to prepare it for the

rigors of March and April. This season is no different.

The Gamecocks' 30-game regular-season schedule includes 14 games against teams in the national rankings this week or at the time of the game, including four against teams in the top five and three others against top-10 foes. Seven of those 14 games are against non-conference opponents.

Over the last 10 seasons, South Carolina has played an average of 9.6 regular-season games against ranked foes.

If this season's 14 games remain, it would be the most regular-season ranked matchups in program history. The seven non-conference opponents would top the 2021-22 schedule's six.

So far this season, South Carolina is 2-1 against ranked foes – vs #9/8 NC State (W, 71-57; 11/10), at #5/6 UCLA (L, 62-77; 11/24), vs. #15/15 Iowa State (W, 76-36; 11/28).

All About Balance

Like last season, South Carolina's greatest asset is its depth. Returning nine of 11 letterwinners from last season's undefeated National Championship team, the 2024-25 roster features six Gamecocks who averaged at least 18.0 minutes and scored at least 8.1 points per game last season.

This season, 10 Gamecocks have played at least 15.0 minutes per game. Seven average at least 7.0 points and five have grabbed at least 4.0 rebounds per game. Ten Gamecocks have scored in double figures at least once, including eight who have done it at least twice, and five have led the team in scoring at least once.

Bench Mob

Head coach Dawn Staley's 13-player roster gives her the ability to make a full line change with little decline in production.

This season, the Gamecock bench is second in the nation with 40.6 points per game to account for 50.8 percent of the total offense. The South Carolina bench has out-scored its opponents' bench by 26.8 points per game.

On the glass, the bench averages 20.4 rebounds per game compared to just 8.1 for their opponents' bench.

Glass Work

South Carolina has long dominated the glass with a full team rebounding effort. After an uncharacteristic effort on the boards in the season opener, the Gamecocks have returned to form, rising to eighth in the nation with 46.8 rebounds per game and sixth in rebounding margin (+14.9).

South Carolina's 19.1 offensive rebounds per game rank seventh in the nation, and its 45.8 offensive rebounding percent is sixth, according to Her Hoop Stats.

Five Gamecocks average at least four rebounds on the season with junior Chloe Kitts leading the way at 8.0 to rank 11th in the SEC. Ashlyn Watkins is second at 5.8 per game, and freshman Joyce Edwards averages 6.1.

Paint Production

South Carolina has long dominated the paint, and this season's numbers have upheld that tradition.

With 55.3 percent of their points coming in the paint, the Gamecocks are out-scoring opponents in that space 44.3 to 21.2 (+23.0) for the season, including by +13.3 points per game against ranked opponents (36.7-23.3). They are shooting 51.2 percent in the paint compared to opponents' 37.9 percent accuracy in the space.

Individually, two Gamecocks have scored double digits in a single quarter – Tessa Johnson (1) and Chloe Kitts (1). The top single-quarter individual scoring this season is 10 points, which has happened twice – Chloe Kitts in 1st quarter vs. Coppin State (11/14), Tessa Johnson in 3rd quarter vs. Purdue (11/30).

First Watch

Seven Gamecocks have been named to national award watch lists to start the 2024-25 season.

Fifth-year senior Te-Hina Paopao and sophomore MiLaysia Fulwiley lead the way, appearing on both the Naismith Preseason Watch List and the Wooden Award Preseason Top 50 in addition to their position award watch lists – Nancy Lieberman Award (point guard) and Ann Meyers Drysdale Award (shooting guard), respectively.

Junior Raven Johnson joined Paopao on the Naismith and Lieberman Award watch lists.

Senior Bree Hall joined Fulwiley on the preseason list of the Meyers Drysdale Award. Maryam Dauda was among the 20 on the Cheryl Miller Award (small forward), and Sania Feagin earned a spot on the Katrina McClain Award (power forward) list. Sakima Walker rounded out the positional honors with a spot on the Lisa Leslie Award (center) watch list, continuing a long line of Gamecocks on that award's watch lists.

Pao-erful Impact

Fifth-year senior guard Te-Hina Paopao is a four-time all-conference selection across two conferences, but added two first-time accolades to her resume last season – All-American and NCAA Div. I 3-point percentage leader. This season she has leveled up again, appearing on both the Naismith and Wooden Award watch lists and posting her Gamecock career-high 23 points in a commanding win over #9/8 NC State (Nov. 10).

Paopao leads the team with 12.0 points per game this season, shooting 49.4 percent from the field and 43.8 percent from 3-point range. Those numbers rise against ranked opponents to 16.0 points per game on 55.6 percent shooting and 61.5 percent.

Paopao also hands out 2.9 assists per game, which have led to 6.9 points per game and mean she has her hands on 27.7 percent of the Gamecocks' total offense.

After choosing to transfer to South Carolina because of her belief in head coach Dawn Staley's ability to develop the skills she would need to succeed at the next level, Paopao chose to return for her fifth season of college basketball because of the significant strides she made in her overall game in just a few months in Columbia. This season, Staley has challenged her again to raise her skills, and Paopao is delivering.

In addition to amping up her defensive skills, the veteran has diversified her offense as well. Paopao is averaging 4.3 points from 3-point range, 5.0 from the paint and 2.8 from her midrange game.

CK Obsession

Forward Chloe Kitts showed flashes of her potential throughout her sophomore season, and, after an offseason of focusing on building her strength as much as her skills, she exploded into her junior campaign with three straight double-figure scoring games.

In just her fourth semester on campus, Kitts is 11th in the SEC with 8.0 rebounds per game, and her 10.9 points per game are second on the team. Her 3.71 offensive rebounds per game are eighth in the SEC and have added 2.6 points per game to her scoring.

The Full-wiley

The generational talent that is sophomore MiLaysia Fulwiley wow-ed fans last season with her creativity and athleticism. This season, the extremely coach-able guard is learning the art of steadying her play between the "wow" moments.

Fulwiley earned SEC All-Freshman honors last season and was the SEC Tournament MVP after a phenomenal title game that saw her net a career-high 24 points against #8/5 LSU. She finished the season second on the team in scoring at 11.7 points per game on 43.8 percent shooting.

This season Fulwiley is third on the team in scoring at 10.8 points per game while shooting 42.5 percent. Her four double-figure scoring games are second on the team.

It's T-Time

Sophomore guard Tessa Johnson saw her consistent effort and steady demeanor pay off in the biggest

moments of her freshman campaign, and she has picked up right where she left off this season.

The quiet guard earned NCAA Final Four All-Tournament honors after exploding for 14.0 points per game on the season's final weekend, including 19 points on 7-of-11 shooting in the National Championship game. The whole three weeks in the NCAA Tournament were solid for Johnson, who posted three of her 10 double-digit scoring games in the last five games of the season and averaged 10.2 points over the six-game event.

In the season opener against Michigan, Johnson was the steadiest guard offensively, pouring in 15 points on 6-of-12 shooting, including 3-of-6 from 3-point range, highlighted by netting seven points in an 11-5 run midway through the second half.

For the season, Johnson's 9.5 points per game have come on 48.8 percent shooting, including a scorching 55.0 percent (11-of-20) from 3-point range.

Ashlyn SWAT-kins

The first Gamecock to dunk in a game, Ashlyn Watkins' athleticism has never been in question. The All-SEC Second-Team selection brought all aspects of her game together last season and is coming back into form now.

Watkins' 6.3 rebounds per game are second on the team and include 2.7 offensive boards per game. Her scoring has been climbing steadily to 7.7 points per game after reaching double figures in two of her last four games. Defensively, Watkins is 14th in the SEC with 1.3 blocks per game and her 11 steals are second on the team.

Let Us Re-Joyce

The No. 3 recruit in the 2024 signing class, according to ESPNW, forward Joyce Edwards has been as advertised with her athleticism and intellect allowing her to play multiple positions already.

The National Gatorade Player of the Year dominated the Gamecocks' exhibition games, leading the team with 19.5 points and 11.5 rebounds. In her official college debut, her 10 points and seven rebounds against Michigan included a clutch defensive rebound and a pair of free throws all in the final 13 seconds to close out the win.

Early in the season, Edwards is averaging 9.8 points and 6.1 rebounds, including five double-digit scoring games, which leads the team. Her 3.1 offensive boards per game are 12th in the SEC, and she has a team-high 14 steals.

Edwards posted her first career double-double with a 13-point, 11 rebound effort against #15/15 Iowa State (Nov. 28). After nearly repeating the effort in the next game, she earned a spot on the Fort Myers Tip-Off All-Island Division Team and SEC co-Freshman of the Week.

M-M Good!

After missing much of the preseason and first two games recovering from an injury, point guard Maddy McDaniel is beginning to show off the skill set that makes her head coach beam.

The two-time All-Washington Catholic Athletic Conference Player of the Year ranks second in the nation with an SEC-best 7.00 assist-to-turnover ratio that includes three turnover-free games and four games of four or more assists – hitting both marks at #5/6 UCLA (Nov. 24) and #15/15 Iowa State (Nov. 28). Her 3.5 assists per game lead the team.

McDaniel is finding confidence in calling her own number as well, averaging 5.0 points per game for the season on 65.0 percent shooting, including a perfect 5-of-5, 10-point outing against Purdue (Nov. 30).

More New Faces

Two other new faces made their Gamecock debuts this season in redshirt freshman Adhel Tac, junior transfer and Maryam Dauda.

Tac was part of the Gamecocks No. 2 ranked 2024 signing class before enrolling early after her second

season-ending injury in as many high school seasons. She has seen time in five games so far this season.

Dauda joined the Gamecocks after two seasons at Arkansas, including a 2023-24 campaign that saw her average 10.1 points and 6.3 rebounds and lead the SEC in blocks per league game (2.8). In six games this season, she averages 2.5 points and 2.7 rebounds.

Preseason Predictions

As the reigning national champion, the Gamecocks are atop both preseason polls by a near unanimous decision, claiming 27 No. 1 votes in both the Associated Press Poll (30 voters) and the USA Today Coaches Poll (31 voters).

The Gamecocks were also selected to repeat as SEC Regular-Season Champions by both the media and league

coaches in preseason voting. Both groups tapped senior guard Te-Hina Paopao with Preseason First-Team All-SEC honors and gave second-team recognition to guards Raven Johnson and the MiLaysia Fulwiley.

Who's Got Next

On the first day of the early signing period, South Carolina landed No. 22 recruit Ayla McDowell (Cypress, TX). The 6-foot-2 wing poured in 19.6 points and 9.2 rebounds per game in leading Cypress Springs to a 30-3 record and a spot in the 6A regional semifinals in 2023-24. She is on the 2024-25 Naismith Trophy High School Player of the Year Preseason Watch List.

Everybody's All-American

The Gamecocks' 13-woman roster includes 10 McDonald's All-Americans – Maryam Dauda, Joyce Edwards, Sania Feagin, MiLaysia Fulwiley, Bree Hall, Raven Johnson, Tessa Johnson, Maddy McDaniel, Te-Hina Paopao and Ashlyn Watkins.

At South Carolina, Staley has coached 26 McDonald's All-Americans, including 20 who signed as freshmen.

WNBA Pipeline

With 12 alumnae playing in the WNBA in 2024, South Carolina had the second-most players in the league of any college program.

Since the first Staley-trained Gamecock was drafted in 2015 (Aleighsa Welch), a total of 15 South Carolina players have been taken in the WNBA Draft with 11 of those going in the first round, including two No. 1 overall picks.

In proof Staley sends players to the league ready, six Gamecocks have earned All-Rookie Team honors, including three WNBA Rookies of the Year – Allisha Gray (2017), A'ja Wilson (2018), Aliyah Boston (2023).

Great Gamecock Fans

South Carolina fans have led the nation in average attendance in each of the last 10 seasons with an eye on tying Tennessee for the NCAA-record streak of 11 seasons after selling out of season tickets for the first time in program history – 13,152. They are currently leading the country in average attendance at 16,775, and the Gamecocks have played in front of the three largest crowds in college women's basketball this season.

The Gamecocks have had at least one sellout of their 18,000-seat Colonial Life Arena for eight straight seasons (excluding COVID-limited 2020-21 season) dating back to the first ever sellout of 18,000 on Feb. 8, 2016. Last season's five sellouts were the most in a single season in program history, until five have already been declared for this season as well – vs. East Carolina (Nov. 17), vs. Oklahoma (Jan. 19), vs. LSU (Jan. 23), vs. Auburn (Feb. 2) and vs. UConn (Feb. 16).

Excluding the COVID limited season of 2020-21, South Carolina has drawn at least 10,000 fans for 127 consecutive regular-season games beginning on Jan. 2, 2015.

SPORTS PERFORMANCE

The Gamecocks' athleticism and physicality are both natural and fine-tuned by hours in the weight room under the guidance of sports performance coach Molly Binetti. A few key measurements from the team...

Speed

DAWN STALEY Head Coach

17th Season at South Carolina • 25th Season in Career

Since thrusting South Carolina into the national spotlight when she was hired in May 2008, Dawn Staley has made the Gamecocks a mainstay in the battle for SEC and national championships. The Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame inductee as a player is angling for another induction as a coach with her standing as one of five head coaches with at least three women's basketball National Championships and the only Black basketball head coach with multiple national titles, one of five head coaches to lead an undefeated team to a National Championship, and the first Black head coach of the USA Basketball Senior National Team.

In her 17th season at the helm of the Gamecocks, Staley's highlights include:

- Three National Championships and six NCAA Final Fours in the last nine tournaments
- Ranking in every AP Top 25 since Dec. 10, 2012 (second-longest active streak and ninth-longest all-time (232)
- 38 straight weeks at No. 1 in the AP Poll, (2021-23) third program to go wire-to-wire in that poll in back-to-back seasons
- 86 total weeks at No. 1 in the AP Poll, the third-most in the history of that poll
- Eight SEC regular-season championships and eight SEC Tournament titles
- SEC-record 47 consecutive league regular-season victories (10th in NCAA history for conference win streaks)
- Four top-two recruiting classes (#2 in 2024, #1 in 2021, #1 in 2019, #2 in 2014)
- 10 NCAA Attendance titles (2015, 2016, 2017, 2018, 2019, 2020, 2021, 2022, 2023, 2024)

While her coaching career is in full bloom, Staley is still recognized for her body of work as a one of the most decorated participants in United States women's basketball history. The Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame solidified that legacy with her enshrinement as part of the Class of 2013. The Phoenix Club of Philadelphia established the Dawn Staley Award recognizing the nation's top guard in women's Division I basketball in 2013 as well. Staley was inducted into the Women's Basketball Hall of Fame as part of the Class of 2012.

In her 25th season as a head coach, Staley has led her college teams to 14 25-win seasons, a total of 20 postseason appearances (two WNIT) and 192 weeks in the Associated Press top 10, including 86 in the No. 1 spot – the third most times in the top spot in the history of that poll. Her .768 winning percentage (619-187) ranks ninth in the nation among active head coaches with at least 10 years of experience and 11th all-time.

In her 17th season at the helm of the Gamecocks, Staley has been named National Coach of the Year five times (2014, 2020, 2022, 2023, 2024). Her 2020 unanimous selection made her the first former Naismith Player of the Year to earn the Naismith Coach of the Year award, and she became the first men's or women's coach to claim the award in three straight seasons 2022-24. She is a seven-time SEC Coach of the Year and was the 2012 BCA Female Coach of the Year. She is the only Gamecock basketball coach – men's or women's – to amass 300 victories at South Carolina and became the fastest coach to 200 wins in program history, needing just 277 games at South Carolina to reach the plateau. She is the program's all-time winningest coach with 446 wins, a .807 (447-107) winning percentage and a program-record 13 postseason appearances.

In the vaunted SEC, Staley's 199 league wins are the most among active league coaches and third all-time, trailing just Women's Basketball Hall of Fame Inductees Andy Landers (Georgia, 273) and Pat Summitt (Tennessee, 306). Her .783 SEC winning percentage (199-55) is second only to Summitt (.874) in league history. Her Gamecocks are the only SEC program with multiple 16-0 seasons in league history, hitting that mark four times (2015-16, 2019-20, 2022-23, 2023-24). Staley's back-to-back SEC undefeated seasons helped the Gamecocks to a current 47-game win streak in league play, which is an SEC record and ranks 10th in NCAA history for conference win streaks.

In addition to coaching two National Players of the Year, two National Defensive Players of the Year and a National Freshman of the Year, Staley has helped 11 Gamecocks collect 26 All-America selections, three to pick up seven SEC Player of the Year honors, four to earn eight SEC Defensive Player of the Year recognitions, two to SEC 6th Player of the Year honors and six to capture SEC Freshman of the Year. She has coached 21 Gamecocks to All-SEC honors 41 times, including 21 first-team selections. In the last 10 seasons, 15 Gamecocks have been selected in the WNBA Draft, including 11 first-round picks, highlighted by two No. 1 overall picks in the last seven years. Three Gamecocks have been named WNBA Rookie of the Year.

In women's basketball, Colonial Life Arena has become one of the most feared places to play as enormous crowds fill the building with passion for the Gamecocks.

The state of South Carolina has rallied around head coach Dawn Staley's program in unprecedented numbers as the Gamecocks have led the nation in average attendance in each of the last 10 seasons. The Gamecocks were one of a few programs to finish the 2019-20 season averaging over 10,000 fans and boast 15 sellouts (18,000) in the last 10 seasons of full capacity arenas.

Colonial Life Arena is more than just the home of South Carolina men's and women's basketball, though. It is also a thriving entertainment venue that the city of Columbia and its surrounding metropolitan area are able to enjoy throughout the year.

Colonial Life Arena is the largest arena in the state of South Carolina with 18,000 seats, and the 10th-largest on-campus basketball facility in the nation. Located on the beautiful University of South Carolina campus, this one-of-a-kind facility features 41 suites, four entertainment suites, and the Frank McGuire Club, a full-service hospitality room that has a capacity of 300. The state-of-the-art facility also features plush seating, a technologically advanced sound system and a one-of-a-kind selection of unique concession foods that will delight fans of all ages.

In Summer 2017, a 12-display center-hung video board and ribbon boards were added to the arena bowl at a cost of \$4.2 million. The center-hung board features four convex-curved main displays that measure approximately 12' x 20' and can show any combination of live video, instant replays, statistics and game information, graphics and animations, and sponsorship messages.

The Arena has hosted numerous sold out shows, including Barnum and Bailey Circus, Paul McCartney, country superstars Kenny Chesney and Taylor Swift, WWE Wrestling, Kanye West and numerous other acts.

The largest building ever constructed at the University of South Carolina at 342,000 square feet, the Arena has an intimate double-deck design that puts every seat close to the action. The cantilever of the upper deck over the lower deck extends further than any other arena of its size with great sight lines.

Two spacious locker rooms for Gamecock men's and women's basketball include team meeting rooms, recruiting rooms, coaches locker rooms and an athletic training room.
