- The SEC leads the nation with five teams (Auburn 1st, Tennessee 4th, Florida 6th, Alabama 8th, and Kentucky 10th) ranked in the Top 10 of the NCAA's NET rankings.

- The SEC leads the nation with eight teams ranked in the Top 25 and 14 in the Top 60 of the NET.

- SEC teams have amassed 50 Quad 1 wins and 80 wins against Quad 1 & 2 teams combined.

- The SEC's +20.83 KenPom rating is the highest rating by a conference since the ACC posted +21.37 in 1997.

- Four of the top 10 teams in KenPom's Adjusted Offensive Efficiency are from the SEC: Auburn 1st, Kentucky 2nd, Florida 6th, and Alabama 7th.

- Four SEC teams are ranked in the Top 10 of KenPom's team rankings, eight are in the Top 25, 13 are in the Top 50 and all 16 teams rank in the Top 75.

- Three of the top five teams, five of the top 10 and nine of the top 25 teams in the Associated Press Poll are from the SEC.

- Auburn is ranked No. 1 in the AP Poll for the second time in school history (January-February 2022). Alabama moved up to No. 4 in the poll, Florida is No. 5, Tennessee is No. 6, Kentucky 8th, Texas A&M 11th, Mississippi State 15th, Ole Miss 21st and Georgia 23rd. Additionally, Oklahoma and Missouri are among teams receiving votes.

- The SEC has had at least nine teams ranked in six of the 11 Associated Press polls this season.

- The SEC's 10 teams ranked in the Dec. 23 and Dec. 30 polls are the most by a conference since the Associated Press began compiling a weekly poll during the 1948-49 season.

- Alabama's Mark Sears and Florida's Alex Condon were named SEC Co-Players of the Week while Georgia's Asa Newell was tabbed SEC Freshman of the Week.

- SEC teams won 88.9 percent (185-23) of their non-conference games this season. That tops the nine-team ACC in 2003-04 that had a 88.2 winning percentage (75-10) in games before New Year's Day.

- SEC teams are 59-19 (75.6 percent) against teams from the ACC (30-4), Big 12 (14-2), Big East (5-4) and Big Ten (10-9).

- SEC teams posted a 21-7 record against non-conference teams ranked in the Associated Press Top 25, including a 6-2 mark against teams ranked in the Top 10.

- The SEC's 21 regular-season, non-conference Top 25 wins were eight more than any other league has ever had in a season (per former ESPN researcher Jared Berson).

- The SEC entered conference play 51-22 (69.9 percent) vs. Top 100 teams in Bart Torvik's ratings system. No other conference was better than .500 against the Top 100.

- The last three undefeated teams in the nation were all from the SEC with Tennessee being the last to fall and was preceded by Oklahoma and Florida.

- The SEC dominated the second annual SEC/ACC Challenge, winning 14-2. The average margin of victory in the 14 SEC wins was 16.2 points while the margin in the two losses was 3.5 points.

- Five SEC teams won MTE titles this season: Auburn (Maui Invitational), Florida (ESPN Events Invitational), Oklahoma (Battle 4 Atlantis), Tennessee (Baha Mar Hoops Bahamas Championship), and Texas (Legends Classic).

- Three SEC coaches rank among the winningest active coaches in the nation: John Calipari (1st/824 wins), Rick Barnes (2nd/822 wins) and Bruce Pearl (11th/678 wins).

SEC SUCCESS

Individual

- In 2024, Kentucky's Reed Sheppard earned the SEC's third straight National Freshman of the Year (Auburn's Jabari Smith in 2022 and Alabama's Brandon Miller in 2023).
- Tennessee's Dalton Knecht was named a 2024 Consensus First Team All-America while Alabama's Mark Sears was a Consensus Second Team All-America.
- Five players earned All-America honors from the Associated Press in 2024, including Alabama's Mark Sears (2nd team) and Auburn's Johni Broome (3rd team).
- 65 SEC players have been selected in the last seven NBA Drafts. That leads all conferences: 57 ACC, 46 Pac-12, 45 Big Ten, 34 Big 12 and 27 Big East.
- 38 SEC players have been selected in the first round of the last seven NBA Drafts. That leads the nation: 35 ACC, 23 Pac-12, 19 Big Ten, 18 Big 12 and 13 Big East.
- 20 NBA Draft Lottery picks in the last seven years are the most in the nation. That leads the nation: 15 ACC, 10 Big 12, 10 Big Ten, 7 Pac-12, and Big East 6.
- Six No. 1 overall NBA Draft picks since 2010.
- 12 NBA Draft picks in 2021, 2020 and 2019.
- 100 players from SEC schools were on 2024-25 NBA Opening Day rosters.
- Eight former SEC players were named to the 2024 NBA All-Star roster.
- Four players from SEC schools were members of the USA Basketball's gold medal winning team at the 2024 Paris Olympics.


Team

- The SEC has had 43 NCAA Tournament selections over the last six tournaments.
- A record-tying 10 SEC teams received postseason bids in 2023 and 2024. The SEC's eight NCAA Tournament selections in both 2023 and 2024 tied its previous best set in 2018. Additionally, two SEC teams competed in the NIT each year.
- Every SEC team has made at least one NCAA Tournament appearance in the last nine tournaments.
- Nine different SEC teams have advanced to the Sweet 16 in the last seven NCAA Tournaments. All 16 SEC members have advanced to the Sweet 16 since 1996.
- At least one team has advanced to the Elite Eight in 10 of the last 14 tournaments.
- The SEC has advanced a team in the Final Four seven of the last 13 tournaments.
- Eleven different SEC teams (Alabama, Arkansas, Auburn, Florida, Georgia, Kentucky, LSU, Mississippi State, Oklahoma, South Carolina and Texas) have appeared in the Final Four.
- Since the 2018-19 season, four different SEC schools have been ranked No. 1 in the Associated Press Poll: Alabama 2023, Auburn 2022, Kentucky 2020, and Tennessee 2019.
- Ten different SEC schools have been ranked No. 1 in the Associated Press Poll: Alabama, Arkansas, Auburn, Florida, Kentucky, Missouri, Oklahoma, South Carolina, Tennessee and Texas.

Coaches

- Three coaches enter the 2025 season ranking among the winningest active coaches in the nation: John Calipari (1st/813 wins), Rick Barnes (2nd/806 wins) and Bruce Pearl (12th/683 wins).
- Five coaches have been named national coach of the year: Rick Barnes, Chris Beard, John Calipari, Bruce Pearl and Rodney Terry.
- Six coaches have coached in the Final Four: Rick Barnes, Chris Beard, John Calipari, Nate Oats, Porter Moser and Bruce Pearl.

2025 SEC BASKETBALL TOURNAMENT • BRIDGESTONE ARENA • NASHVILLE, TN

The winner of the 15-game SEC Men's Basketball Tournament receives the league's automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament. The tournament seeds are determined by the 18-game conference schedule during the regular season. Teams are seeded 1-16 based on their regular season conference finish.

Atlanta served as host of the inaugural SEC Tournament played following the 1932-33 season and did so again after the 1933-34 season. The event was held every year through 1952, with the exception of 1935. After a 26-year layoff (1953-78), the tournament was renewed in 1979. The 2025 tournament will be the 66th in league history and the 47th since the renewal.

The event has helped set the stage for SEC teams in the NCAA Tournament, as 28 of the tournament champions since the tournament resumed in 1979 have advanced to at least the Sweet 16. Twenty of those teams have gone on to the Elite Eight, 12 to the Final Four and three have been crowned national champion. Six of the last 18 SEC Tournament champions have advanced to the Final Four with three of those teams winning a national championship. The SEC Tournament Champion has failed to win at least one NCAA Tournament game only FIVE times.

Kentucky leads the league with 31 SEC Tournament titles. Alabama is second with eight, while Tennessee has five and Florida has four. Auburn and Mississippi State have three championship trophies while Georgia, Ole Miss and Vanderbilt have two. Arkansas, LSU and former league member Georgia Tech have each won one SEC Tournament championship.

SEC Tournament Tie-Breaker Procedures

Teams will be seeded No. 1 through No. 16 in the SEC Men's Basketball Tournament bracket based upon the final regular season Conference standings. Teams that finished No. 1 through No. 4 in the final regular season standings shall receive first- and second-round byes and teams that finish No. 5 through No. 8 will receive first-round byes in the SEC Men's Basketball Tournament.

1. **Two-Team Tie:** The following procedure will be used in the following order until the tie is broken:

- A) Won-lost results of head-to-head competition between the two teams.
- B) Won-lost record of the two teams versus the No. 1 seed (and proceeding through the No. 16 seed, if necessary).
- C) Coin flip by the Commissioner.

2. **Three-Team Tie (or more):** Won-lost record of the two teams versus the No. 1 seed (and proceeding through the No. 16 seed, if necessary).

A) Best winning percentage of games played among the tied teams (Example: Team A is 3-1, Team B is 2-2 and Team C is 1-3 – Team A would be seeded highest, Team B second-highest and Team C lowest of the three).

B) Best winning percentage of the tied teams versus the No. 1 seed (and proceeding through the No. 16 seed, if necessary).

C) If two teams remain, coin flip by the Commissioner.

D) If three or more teams remain, draw by the Commissioner.

For the purpose of seeding, if an institution is precluded from participating in the tournament, such institution will automatically be seeded last. The No. 9 seed will then receive a bye. However, for the purpose of breaking ties, that team will remain where it finished in the regular-season standings BEFORE being seeded last.

• SEC Co-Players of the Week – Alabama guard Mark Sears and Florida forward/center Alex Condon were named SEC Co-Players of the Week. Sears, a 6-foot-1, 190-pound senior from Muscle Shoals, Ala., averaged 24.5 points, 5.0 assists and 2.5 rebounds in wins at South Carolina and at No. 10 Texas A&M. He shot 46.7 percent from the field, 50 percent from three and 86.7 percent from the free throw line. They were the ninth and 10th games this season scoring 20 points or more. Condon, a 6-foot-11, 230-pound sophomore player from Perth, Australia, averaged 12.0 points, 11.0 rebounds, 4.0 assists and 2.5 blocks in wins against No. 1 Tennessee and at Arkansas. Condon is the first player in the nation this century to go for 12 points, 12 rebounds and four assists without a turnover vs. the No. 1 team. He is just the eighth player in this century to post those numbers in SEC play regardless of rankings.

• SEC Freshman of the Week – Georgia forward Asa Newell, a 6-foot-11, 220-pound freshman from Destin, Fla., averaged 16.0 points, 7.5 rebounds and 1.5 blocks in wins over No. 6 Kentucky and No. 17 Oklahoma. On the week, shot 52.6 percent from the floor, including 33.3 percent from 3-point range, and 76.9 percent at the line.
