GAMECOCK NOTABLES

- South Carolina's 10 wins over ranked opponents include five against top-10 foes – both numbers lead the nation.
- The Gamecock bench leads the nation with 41.4 points per game, which accounts for 51.3 percent of the total offense. South Carolina's starters have lifted their scoring by 3.4 points per game to average 42.6 points over the last five outings.
- After struggling in the third quarter against Vanderbilt on Friday, the Gamecocks turned in their best shooting quarter in program history, hitting 10-of-11 from the field for 90.9 percent over the final 10 minutes to turn back the Commodores.
- Forward Chloe Kitts has been the Gamecocks' top scorer and rebounder over the last three games, posting three straight double-doubles to average 17.7 points and 11.0 rebounds and shooting 64.7 percent over the stretch. The numbers drop off only slightly over the last five to 13.4 points and 10.4 rebounds per game on 61.4 percent shooting.
- SEC Sixth Woman of the Year and Second-Team All-SEC selection Milaysia Fulwiley has brought both flash and substance in the final weeks of the season. The team's top scorer over the last five games at 14.6 points per game on 50.0 percent shooting in addition to her 2.2 steals per game in that stretch. She has scored in double figures in 10 of the last 11 games, including four games of at least 15 points.
- Senior Sania Feagin has had the hot hand over the last three games, pouring in 14.3 points per game (second on the team) on 76.0 percent shooting in addition to reeling in 6.3 rebounds per game in that period.
- First-Team All-SEC forward Joyce Edwards is the team's top scorer at 13.0 points per game on 55.6 percent shooting. Her 22 games in double-figure points leads the team, and she's been the team's top scorer a team-high 13 games, including six against ranked opponents.
- Second-Team All-SEC guard Te-Hina Paopao's 10.1 points per game include 11.5 per game against ranked opponents. Her team-high 3.1 assists per game have delivered another 7.0 points per game for the Gamecocks, and her 2.57 assist-to-turnover ratio is 12th in the nation.

A Perennial Power

South Carolina women's basketball has been a national power for more than a decade under head coach Dawn Staley, including seven 30-win seasons in the last 10 campaigns. The Gamecocks have played in six Final Fours in the last nine NCAA Tournaments, including the last four, with National Championships in 2017, 2022 and 2024. They have been ranked in every AP Poll since Dec. 10, 2012, including a top-10 spot every week since the start of the 2019-20 season. The Gamecocks' 86 AP No. 1 rankings all-time are the third-most by a program in the history of that poll. South Carolina is one of two programs in NCAA history to put together multiple 40-game win streaks.

Under head coach Dawn Staley's leadership, 11 Gamecocks have earned All-America status, three have earned SEC Player of the Year honors and 22 have picked up All-SEC recognition at least once.

In the last nine seasons, 14 Gamecocks have been selected in the WNBA Draft, including 10 first-round picks, highlighted by two No. 1 overall picks in the last six years. In the 2024 season, 12 Gamecocks were on a WNBA roster, the second most of any program in the country. Three Gamecocks have been named WNBA Rookie of the Year and one is a three-time WNBA MVP and two-time WNBA Defensive Player of the Year.

The Oklahoma Series

The Gamecocks are 1-3 all-time against the Sooners, including a 1-1 mark in the Dawn Staley era (beginning 2008-09).

In their regular season meeting on Jan. 19, South Carolina overwhelmed Oklahoma right out of the gate in a 101-60 victory in Columbia. The Gamecocks led 28-9 after the opening 10 minutes and never looked back. Five Gamecocks finished in double figures, including three off the bench.

SEC Tournament Take

South Carolina is 35-25 all-time in the SEC Tournament since joining the league for the 1991-92 season. Head coach Dawn Staley is 32-8 in the event with eight championships, all coming in the last 10 years.

The Gamecocks have reached the tournament championship game nine times, finishing as the runner-up just once. With titles in 2015, 2016, 2017 and 2018, South Carolina is the only program in league history to win four consecutive SEC Tournament titles, and then added titles in 2020, 2021, 2023 and 2024.

Neutral Stance

The Gamecocks are 175-96 (.646) all-time on a neutral court. South Carolina head coach Dawn Staley is 92-27 in games played at neutral sites (.773), including a 57-17 (.770) mark in postseason play.

SEC Sayings

Winning its fourth-straight SEC title this season, South Carolina has been the benchmark in the league over the last decade, amassing nine regular-season titles since 2013-14 (12 seasons) and finishing no lower than second in that time. Since that season, the Gamecocks have a 176-16 record (.917) in league action, including an 92-4 mark (.958) since 2019-20. South Carolina set a new SEC record with its 43rd-consecutive league victory with its win over Georgia on Feb. 18, 2024, and went on to make that new mark 57 consecutive regular-season conference victories. The streak, which is tied for the sixth-longest in NCAA history, spanned three seasons, beginning on Jan. 2, 2022, with a win over Mississippi State and ran through a win at Georgia on Feb. 6, 2025.

The Gamecocks have also had a lock on the SEC Tournament, winning eight titles since claiming their first in 2015. They became the first program to win four consecutive tournaments, claiming the crowns 2015-18.

In the last decade, three Gamecocks have been named SEC Player of the Year a combined seven times, three have collected seven SEC Defensive Player of the Year honors, three have been the league's 6th-Woman of the Year, three have been the league Freshman of the Year, one has been the SEC Scholar-Athlete of the Year, and Staley has been the Coach of the Year seven times – one shy of Pat Summitt's league-record eight selections.

Ranking Review

South Carolina is ranked No. 5 in both the AP Poll and the USA Today/WBCA Coaches' Poll this week.

It marks the Gamecocks 114th consecutive entry in the AP top 10, beginning with the 2019-20 preseason poll. It is the longest active streak and the eighth longest in the history of that poll (7th is 137, Baylor). Their 245 straight appearances in the AP Poll, dating back to Dec. 10, 2012, marks the second-longest active streak in the nation and is the eighth longest all-time (7th, Texas Tech, 248).

In the USA Today/WBCA Coaches' Poll, South Carolina has been in the top 10 since claiming the No. 10 spot in the 2019-20 preseason poll.

The Staley File

In her 25th season as a head coach, Dawn Staley has a .772 (640-189) winning percentage, which ranks eighth in the nation among active head coaches with at least 15 years of experience and 10th all-time.

Staley is one of just two women's basketball coaches to lead their teams to multiple 40-game win streaks in NCAA history with the Gamecocks' recent program-record 43-game streak ranking seventh longest in NCAA history.

She is the first Black head coach to win multiple national championships in men's or women's basketball, the fifth women's coach to win at least three NCAA titles and one of just 11 men's or women's coaches to hit that mark.

Now in her 17th season with the Gamecocks, Staley is the program's all-time winningest coach (468) with a program-record 13 postseason appearances. She accounts for all six of the Gamecocks' Final Four appearances (2015, 2017, 2021, 2022, 2023, 2024) and the only NCAA National Championships in program history (2017, 2022, 2024).

Staley's nine SEC regular-season championships trail only Pat Summitt's 16 in league history, and her seven SEC Coach of the Year awards trails Summitt's league record by just one. Staley's 214 SEC regular-season wins are the most among active league coaches and third all-time – behind just Summitt (Tennessee, 306) and Andy Landers (Georgia, 273). She was the second-fastest to the 200-win mark in league history with her 255 games trailing Summitt's mark of 229. Staley's .793 SEC winning percentage (214-56) is second only to Summitt (.874) among coaches in the league at least five seasons. She owns the SEC record for consecutive regular-season conference victories with a 57-game streak that began in the 2021-22 season and ended in 2024-25.

Serious Scheduling

South Carolina head coach Dawn Staley has never been afraid to challenge her team to prepare it for the rigors of March and April. This season is no different.

The Gamecocks' 30-game regular-season schedule included 13 games against teams in the national rankings at the time of the game – two more than any other ranked team. Six of the 13 games were against non-conference opponents.

The Gamecocks' 10 wins over ranked teams leads the nation with the average ranking of those teams coming in at 11.6. An NCAA-best five of those wins were over top-10 opponents. Their three losses came against top-10 teams, including two on the road.

Over the last 10 seasons, South Carolina has played an average of 10.0 regular-season games against ranked foes with this season's 13 as the most in program history. The

six against non-conference foes matches the 2021-22 schedule for the program high.

All About Balance

Like last season, South Carolina's greatest asset is its depth with nine Gamecocks averaging at least 18.0 minutes. Seven average at least 7.0 points, including four who average double figures. Eleven Gamecocks have scored in double figures at least once, including five who have done it at least 12 times, and six players have led the team in scoring at least twice.

Five players have grabbed at least 4.0 rebounds per game, and four have had at least one double-digit rebounding game this season. Six have led the team in rebounding at least once.

Bench Mob

Head coach Dawn Staley's 13-player roster gives her the ability to make a full line change with little drop off.

This season, the Gamecock bench leads the nation with 41.4 points per game to account for 51.3 percent of the total offense, which rises to 57.1 percent of the offense (35.1 ppg) against ranked opponents and 72.9 percent (42.3 ppg) in SEC play. The South Carolina bench has out-scored its opponents' bench by 25.9 points per game, including 19.6 against ranked teams and 24.1 in SEC play. The bench has outscored the opponent's starting lineup 15 times, including three ranked teams, and outscored the entire opposing team eight times.

On the glass, the bench averages 16.2 rebounds per game (41.6 percent of team total) compared to just 9.0 rebounds per game for their opponents' bench.

Paint Production

South Carolina has long controlled the paint, and this season's numbers have upheld that standard.

With 52.7 percent of their points coming in the paint, the Gamecocks lead the nation with 42.5 paint point per game, according to CBBAnalytics.com, and are out-scoring opponents in that space by 16.3 points per game. They are shooting 54.9 percent in the paint compared to opponents' 41.5 percent accuracy. South Carolina has been outscored in the paint just twice this season (at UCLA, at Texas) and tied three times (Texas, at Tennessee, UConn), going 2-3 in those five games.

Glass Work

South Carolina continues to show a full team rebounding effort, ranking ninth in the nation with 42.6 rebounds per game and 16th in rebounding margin (+8.0).

South Carolina's 39.4 offensive rebounding percent is 13th in the nation, according to CBBAnalytics.com, and their 14.4 offensive boards per game are 26th. The Gamecocks are 10th in the nation in second-chance points, averaging 14.9 on the season, meaning they score 1.03 points per offensive board.

Five Gamecocks average at least four boards on the season with junior Chloe Kitts leading the way at 8.0 to rank ninth in the SEC. Junior Ashlyn Watkins is second with 6.07, and freshman Joyce Edwards is next at 4.9. Sania Feagin rounds out the forwards with 4.6 per game (5.0 vs. ranked teams), and Raven Johnson leads the guards with 4.2.

Block Party

South Carolina annually ranks among the best shot blocking teams in the country, and, with every Gamecock recording at least one block this season, they are continuing the tradition. Even without a dominant center

and the loss of top shot blocker Ashlyn Watkins to injury, the Gamecocks are sixth in the nation with 5.7 blocks per game, including 2.0 per game from guards.

SEC All-Defensive Team selection Sania Feagin is sixth in the SEC with a team-high 1.61 blocks per game, including 2.06 in SEC play, which ranks second the league. MiLaysia Fulwiley is the league's top shot-blocking guard in conference play, ranking 10th with 0.94 blocks per SEC game.

Head coach Dawn Staley has always put a premium on defense, and this year's team has kept that tradition while facing the toughest schedule in the nation. For the fourth time in program history, two Gamecocks were named to the SEC All-Defensive Team – Sania Feagin, Raven Johnson.

The Gamecocks are fifth in the nation in field goal percentage defense, allowing teams to shoot just 35.1 percent from the field. That number drops to an SEC-best 34.7 percent in league games. Only seven teams have shot at least 40.0 percent against the Gamecocks, and six have failed to reach 30.0 percent.

Quarter Breakdown

South Carolina's defense has held an opponent to single digits in a quarter 17 times this season, including seven against ranked teams. The Gamecocks have out-scored their opponent by 10 or more points in a quarter 36 times. The scoring differential is largest in the first quarter (+6.3), and the Gamecocks are best on the boards in the second quarter (+3.2).

Individually, five Gamecocks have scored double digits in a single quarter – Joyce Edwards (4), MiLaysia Fulwiley (2), Tessa Johnson (2), Chloe Kitts (2) and Te-Hina Paopao (1). The top single-quarter individual scoring this season is 14 points by Johnson in the second quarter at Miss. St. (Jan. 5).

Pao-erful Impact

After picking up Second-Team All-SEC honors this week, fifth-year senior guard Te-Hina Paopao has earned all-conference status every year of her career across two conferences, and last year she added two first-time accolades to her resume last season – All-American and NCAA Div. I 3-point percentage leader. This season she remains on the watch lists for the Naismith Trophy and Wooden Award.

After choosing to transfer to South Carolina because of her belief in head coach Dawn Staley's ability to develop the skills she needs to succeed at the next level, Paopao chose to return for her fifth season of college basketball because of the significant strides she made in her overall game in just a few months in Columbia. This season, Staley has challenged her again to raise her skills, and the veteran is delivering.

Paopao's 10.1 points per game this season include 11.5 per game against ranked opponents. She is shooting 45.6 percent from the field, which rises against ranked opponents to 49.6 percent overall and 40.0 from the arc.

Paopao leads the team with 3.06 assists per game overall and 3.44 per SEC game, which ranks her 12th in the league. Her overall 2.6 assist-to-turnover ratio is 12th in the nation, and her 2.29 mark in league play is fourth in the SEC.

In addition to amping up her defensive skills this season, Paopao has expanded her offense as well. She is averaging 4.7 points from 3-point range, 3.3 from the paint and 1.3 from her midrange game.

CK Obsession

Forward Chloe Kitts spent the offseason focusing on building her physical and mental strength as much as her skills. The result has allowed her to fully get to her skill set and play with more confidence this season.

Kitts is averaging 10.0 points on 52.2 percent shooting,

including 17 double-figure scoring games and five games as the team's top scorer. Her career-high nine double-doubles lead the team and include the program's first points-rebounds-assists triple-double in SEC play with her 16-point, 13-rebound, 10-assist outing at Ole Miss (Feb. 27). Three double-doubles have come against ranked opponents and five were in SEC play.

In just her fourth semester on campus, Kitts is ninth in the SEC in rebounding average (8.0 per game, compared to 5.9 last season) and has been the team's top rebounder a team-high 17 times. Kitts' 8.25 rebounds per SEC game are fourth in the league and included 2.81 offensive boards per

The Full-wiley

The generational talent that is sophomore Milaysia Fulwiley wow-ed fans last season with her creativity and athleticism. This season, the extremely coach-able guard, who was named SEC Sixth Woman of the Year and to the All-SEC Second Team, has shown off steady play between the "wow" moments and embraced her ability to impact the game on the defensive end as well.

Fulwiley is second on the team in scoring at 12.0 points per game, including a 13.4 average in SEC action. She has three 20-point games, including 20 against #9/13 TCU (Dec. 8), and she has been the team's top scorer seven times. Her .818 free throw percentage in SEC action is 10th.

In league play, Fulwiley's defense was equally impressive, and she is 10th in the league with 0.94 blocks per game while ranking ninth in the SEC with 1.94 steals in league play, including six games of at least three steals for the season (4 against top-15 foes).

That's So Raven

Junior Raven Johnson earned a spot on the SEC All-Defensive Team this season, marking the third season she has picked up a postseason honor from the league's coaches. While her scoring volume may have dipped this season – although it's often timely – her contributions continue to be integral to the team's success. As Staley says, the Gamecocks have done nothing but win with Johnson in the lineup.

The junior is second on the team with 2.8 assists per game, which rose to 3.1 per SEC game. In league play, she paced the conference with a 3.33 assist-to-turnover ratio, which includes seven zero-turnover games.

Johnson is the team's top rebounding guard at 4.2 per game, including a 10-rebound outing against #5/5 Texas (Jan. 12) and four other games with at least seven rebounds. She continues to be a menace on the defensive end as well with 1.69 steals per league game, including five-steal outings against #5/4 LSU (Jan. 24) and at Mississippi State (Jan. 5) and a career-best six swipes against Auburn (Feb. 2).

Let Us Re-Joyce

Dawn Staley has laid down her marker for Joyce Edwards becoming an elite basketball player in her career, thanks to her tireless work ethic and passion for the knowledge and experience needed to become great. SEC coaches seem to agree, making Edwards just the third freshman in Gamecock history to earn First-Team All-SEC honors.

The Gamecocks' top scorer at 13.0 points per game is already among the best in her class, while logging just 21.0 minutes per game on the Gamecocks' deep roster. Nationally, Edwards is second among freshmen in win shares per 40 minutes (0.24) and third in offensive win shares per 40 minutes (0.17), according to Her Hoop Stats.

Edwards' 24.8 points per 40 minutes is sixth among freshmen nationally and second in the SEC. Her 55.6 percent shooting on the season is seventh among freshmen (min. 5 FGA/gm). All of that production while her usage rate is just 28th.

For the season, she has been the team's top scorer a team-high 13 times, including seven against ranked opponents. She has three double-doubles, including the first of her career in a 13-point, 11 rebound effort against #15/15 Iowa State (Nov. 28) and two in SEC action.

In SEC action, Edwards averaged a team-best 14.4 points to rank 20th in the league on 57.2 percent shooting, which is second.

Sage Seniors

Four-year seniors Sania Feagin and Bree Hall are this year's most veteran players as the two on the roster with the most games in a Gamecock uniform. Communication has played a role in both players' longevity and success with their impact showing up in team results beyond their

individual box score entries.

Staley lauds Feagin's on-court communication as the back-line director of the Gamecocks' defense, which led her to a spot on the SEC All-Defensive Team. Her energy and steady play show the confidence and fitness of the first-year starter with career numbers this season of 7.8 points and 4.6 rebounds per game, playing just three minutes per game more than last season. Defensively she has been a difference-maker for the Gamecocks, ranking sixth in the SEC with 1.60 blocks per game overall. She is second in the league with 2.06 per conference contest.

The more experienced of the two, Hall requires little communication from the coaches as she understands what they want and her value outside traditional measures.

It's T-Time

Sophomore guard Tessa Johnson saw her consistent effort and steady demeanor pay off in the biggest moments of her freshman campaign, and she picked up right where she left off this season.

In the season opener against Michigan, Johnson was the steadiest guard offensively, pouring in 15 points on 6-of-12 shooting, including 3-of-6 from 3-point range, highlighted by netting seven points in an 11-5 run midway through the second half.

For the season, Johnson's 8.2 points per game have

come on 47.3 percent shooting, including 12 double-figure scoring games and her first career 20-point outing with 22 at Mississippi St. (Jan. 5), which included 14 points (4-of-5 3FGs) in the pivotal second quarter

In SEC action, Johnson averaged 8.6 points on 50.0 percent shooting, including 43.5 percent from 3-point range.

Streaking

South Carolina's 43-game win streak that included the first five games of this season featured 12 games against ranked opponents. The run put the Gamecocks in elite company, joining UConn as the only teams to have multiple 40-game win streaks in program history – only six have hit the mark once. South Carolina's first such streak was a 42-game run March 18, 2022, through March 27, 2023.

The Gamecocks' SEC-best 71-game home winning streak (Dec. 18, 2020 - Feb. 13, 2025) is fourth in NCAA history. The stretch included 16 wins over ranked opponents. Their 33-game road win streak (Jan. 6, 2022 - Nov. 20, 2024) is the third longest in NCAA history with seven games versus ranked teams.

South Carolina's 57-straight SEC regular-season wins (Jan. 2, 2022 - Feb. 6, 2025) is a league record and tied for sixth in NCAA history. The Gamecocks' 48-game streak against all SEC foes (regular-season and tournament games) is also a league record (Dec. 29, 2022 - Feb. 6, 2025).

The Gamecocks' 14-straight games with double-digit winning margin this season (Nov. 28-Jan. 23) is a program record and included seven games against ranked opponents.

Who's Got Next

On the first day of the early signing period, South Carolina landed No. 22 recruit Ayla McDowell (Cypress, TX). The 6-foot-2 wing poured in 19.6 points and 9.2 rebounds per game in leading Cypress Springs to a 30-3 record and a spot in the 6A regional semifinals in 2023-24. This season, she was named a McDonald's All-American and is on the Naismith Trophy High School Midseason Team.

Everybody's All-American

The Gamecocks' 13-woman roster includes 10 McDonald's All-Americans – Maryam Dauda, Joyce Edwards, Sania Feagin, MiLaysia Fulwiley, Bree Hall, Raven Johnson, Tessa Johnson, Maddy McDaniel, Te-Hina Paopao and Ashlyn Watkins.

At South Carolina, Staley has coached 26 McDonald's All-Americans, including 20 who signed as freshmen. She will add another to the list next season with the addition of Ayla McDowell.

WNBA Pipeline

With 12 alumnae playing in the WNBA in 2024, South Carolina had the second-most players in the league of any college program.

Since the first Staley-trained Gamecock was drafted in 2015 (Aleighsa Welch), a total of 15 South Carolina players have been taken in the WNBA Draft with 11 of those going in the first round, including two No. 1 overall picks.

In proof Staley sends players to the league ready, six Gamecocks have earned All-Rookie Team honors, including three WNBA Rookies of the Year – Allisha Gray (2017), Aja Wilson (2018), Aliyah Boston (2023).

South Carolina fans have led the nation in average attendance in each of the last 10 seasons with an eye on tying Tennessee for the NCAA-record streak of 11 seasons after selling out of season tickets for the first time in program history – 13,152. They are currently leading the country in average attendance at 16,958, and the Gamecocks have played in front of the six largest crowds in college women's basketball this season.

The Gamecocks have had at least one sellout of their 18,000-seat Colonial Life Arena for eight straight seasons (excluding COVID-limited 2020-21 season) dating back to the first ever sellout of 18,000 on Feb. 8, 2016. After setting the single-season program record of five sellouts last season, the Gamecocks reset the mark this season with seven – vs. East Carolina (Nov. 17), vs. Texas (Jan. 12), vs. Oklahoma (Jan. 19), vs. LSU (Jan. 23), vs. Auburn (Feb. 2), vs. UConn (Feb. 16) and vs. Kentucky (Mar. 2).

SEASON THEME: UNCOMMON

South Carolina women's basketball has been UNCOMMON since Staley's arrival as she brought her reputation as an elite international player and coach to a program that had been mired in the highly competitive SEC and proceeded to build a national powerhouse.

What makes Staley's program UNCOMMON goes beyond the tangible measures of success, though.

Staley's program is grounded by players trusting the process, sacrificing for the good of the team and understanding that commitment will lead them to realize their individual dreams as well as the team's goals. Those actions come from the feeling, the culture of a program based on love and embracing the joy of being part of it.

As always, the FAMS are a key part of this season's theme. They are UNCOMMON in their commitment to supporting the program from Columbia to Paris and every stop in between, building their vacation plans and days off work around the Gamecocks' schedule.

In women's basketball, Colonial Life Arena has become one of the most feared places to play as enormous crowds fill the building with passion for the Gamecocks.

The state of South Carolina has rallied around head coach Dawn Staley's program in unprecedented numbers as the Gamecocks have led the nation in average attendance in each of the last 10 seasons and boast 21 sellouts (18,000) in the last 10 seasons of full capacity arenas.

Colonial Life Arena is more than just the home of South Carolina men's and women's basketball, though. It is also a thriving entertainment venue that the city of Columbia and its surrounding metropolitan area are able to enjoy throughout the year.

Colonial Life Arena is the largest arena in the state of South Carolina with 18,000 seats, and the 10th-largest on-campus basketball facility in the nation. Located on the beautiful University of South Carolina campus, this one-of-a-kind facility features 41 suites, four entertainment suites, and the Frank McGuire Club, a full-service hospitality room that has a capacity of 300. The state-of-the-art facility also features plush seating, a technologically advanced sound system and a one-of-a-kind selection of unique concession foods that will delight fans of all ages.

In Summer 2017, a 12-display center-hung video board and ribbon boards were added to the arena bowl at a cost of \$4.2 million. The center-hung board features four convex-curved main displays that measure approximately 12' x 20' and can show any combination of live video, instant replays, statistics and game information, graphics and animations, and sponsorship messages.

The Arena has hosted numerous sold out shows, including Barnum and Bailey Circus, Paul McCartney, country superstars Kenny Chesney and Taylor Swift, WWE Wrestling, Kanye West and numerous other acts.

The largest building ever constructed at the University of South Carolina at 342,000 square feet, the Arena has an intimate double-deck design that puts every seat close to the action. The cantilever of the upper deck over the lower deck extends further than any other arena of its size with great sight lines.

Two spacious locker rooms for Gamecock men's and women's basketball include team meeting rooms, recruiting rooms, coaches locker rooms and an athletic training room.

17th Season at South Carolina • 25th Season in Career

Since thrusting South Carolina into the national spotlight when she was hired in May 2008, Dawn Staley has made the Gamecocks a mainstay in the battle for SEC and national championships. The Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame inductee as a player is angling for another induction as a coach with her standing as one of five head coaches with at least three women's basketball National Championships and the only Black basketball head coach with multiple national titles, one of five head coaches to lead an undefeated team to a National Championship, and the first Black head coach of the USA Basketball Senior National Team.

In her 17th season at the helm of the Gamecocks, Staley's highlights include:

- Three National Championships and six NCAA Final Fours in the last nine tournaments
- Ranking in every AP Top 25 since Dec. 10, 2012 (second-longest active streak and ninth-longest all-time (244)
- 38 straight weeks at No. 1 in the AP Poll, (2021-23) third program to go wire-to-wire in that poll in back-to-back seasons
- 86 total weeks at No. 1 in the AP Poll, the third-most in the history of that poll
- Nine SEC regular-season championships and eight SEC Tournament titles
- SEC-record 57 consecutive league regular-season victories (t-6th in NCAA history for conference win streaks)
- Four top-two recruiting classes (#2 in 2024, #1 in 2021, #1 in 2019, #2 in 2014)
- 10 NCAA Attendance titles (2015, 2016, 2017, 2018, 2019, 2020, 2021, 2022, 2023, 2024)

While her coaching career is in full bloom, Staley is still recognized for her body of work as a one of the most decorated participants in U.S. women's basketball history. The Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame solidified that legacy with her enshrinement as part of the Class of 2013 after Staley was inducted into the Women's Basketball Hall of Fame as part in 2012. Most recently, Staley was announced as part of the Class of 2025 for induction to the FIBA Hall of Fame.

In her 25th season as a head coach, Staley has led her college teams to 15 25-win seasons, a total of 20 postseason appearances (two WNIT) and 204 weeks in the Associated Press top 10, including 86 in the No. 1 spot – the third most times in the top spot in the history of that poll. Her .772 winning percentage (640-189) ranks eighth in the nation among active head coaches with at least 15 years of experience and 10th all-time.

In her 17th season at the helm of the Gamecocks, Staley has been named National Coach of the Year five times (2014, 2020, 2022, 2023, 2024). Her 2020 unanimous selection made her the first former Naismith Player of the Year to earn the Naismith Coach of the Year award, and she became the first men's or women's coach to claim the award in three straight seasons 2022-24. She is a seven-time SEC Coach of the Year and was the 2012 BCA Female Coach of the Year. She is the only Gamecock basketball coach – men's or women's – to amass 300 victories at South Carolina and became the fastest coach to 200 wins in program history, needing just 277 games at South Carolina to reach the plateau. She is the program's all-time winningest coach with 468 wins, an .811 (467-109) winning percentage and a program-record 13 postseason appearances.

In the vaunted SEC, Staley's 214 league wins are the most among active league coaches and third all-time, trailing just Women's Basketball Hall of Fame Inductees Andy Landers (Georgia, 273) and Pat Summitt (Tennessee, 306). She was the second fastest to 200 league wins (255 games), trailing only Summitt at 229. Staley's .793 SEC winning percentage (214-56) is second only to Summitt (.874) in league history among coaches with at least five seasons in the SEC. Staley's Gamecocks are the only SEC program with multiple 16-0 seasons in league history, hitting that mark four times (2015-16, 2019-20, 2022-23, 2023-24). Staley's back-to-back SEC undefeated seasons helped the Gamecocks to a 57-game win streak in league play (Jan 2, 2022-Feb. 6, 2025), which is an SEC record and ranks seventh in NCAA history for conference win streaks.

In addition to coaching two National Players of the Year, two National Defensive Players of the Year and a National Freshman of the Year, Staley has helped 11 Gamecocks collect 26 All-America selections, three to pick up seven SEC Player of the Year honors, four to earn eight SEC Defensive Player of the Year recognitions, three to SEC 6th Player of the Year honors and six to capture SEC Freshman of the Year. She has coached 23 Gamecocks to All-SEC honors 44 times, including 22 first-team selections. In the last 10 seasons, 15 Gamecocks have been selected in the WNBA Draft, including 11 first-round picks, highlighted by two No. 1 overall picks in the last seven years. Three Gamecocks have been named WNBA Rookie of the Year.
