SEC In The NET

- Four of the top six teams in the NCAA's NET rankings are from the SEC: Auburn 2nd, Florida 4th, Tennessee 5th, and Alabama 6th.
- The SEC leads the nation with seven teams ranked in the Top 20 and 14 in the Top 50 of the NET.
- SEC teams have amassed 113 Quad 1 wins and 181 wins against Quad 1 & 2 teams combined. Equally as telling is that the SEC is 148-2 against Quad 1 & 2.
- The SEC averages 7.06 Quad 1 wins per team and 11.31 Quad 1+2 wins per team, both lead the nation.

More Metrics

- The SEC's +22.06 KenPom rating is the highest rating in history, breaking the ACC's +21.37 record in 1997.
- Five of the top six teams in KenPom's Adjusted Offensive Efficiency are from the SEC: Auburn 1st, Florida 3rd, Alabama 4th, Missouri 5th, and Kentucky 6th.
- Four SEC teams are ranked in the Top 10 of KenPom's team rankings, seven are in the Top 25, 14 are in the Top 50 and all 16 teams rank in the Top 85.

In The Polls

- Four of the top eight teams and eight of the top 25 teams in the Associated Press Poll are from the SEC.
- Auburn is ranked No. 3 in the AP Poll while Florida is No. 4, Alabama is No. 5, Tennessee is No. 8, Texas A&M 14th, Kentucky 15th, and Missouri 21st.
- The SEC occupies four of the top eight spots in the Coaches' Poll: Auburn 3rd, Florida 4th, Tennessee 6th, and Alabama 8th.
- Eighty-eight percent (14 of 16) of the SEC's teams have been ranked by the AP this season, tying the record set by the ACC in 1983-84 (7 of 8 teams ranked).
- The SEC has had at least nine teams ranked in 12 of the 19 Associated Press polls this season.
- The SEC's 10 teams ranked in the Dec. 23, Dec. 30 and Jan. 27 polls are the most by a conference since the Associated Press began compiling a weekly poll during the 1948-49 season.

Worth Noting

- Auburn earned its fifth SEC regular season title, the third of which has come under the direction of head coach Bruce Pearl.
- Forty-three of the SEC's 144 (29.8 percent) league games featured two ranked teams playing each other.
- Six SEC teams (Auburn 1st, Alabama 2nd, Florida 4th, Tennessee 5th, Texas A&M 6th, and Kentucky 10th overall) were listed in the NCAA Selection Committee's Top 16 rankings on Feb. 15.
- Eleven SEC schools have tied or broken their record for number of games played against AP Top 25 teams during the regular season: Alabama, Arkansas, Auburn, Georgia, LSU, Ole Miss, Mississippi State, South Carolina, Tennessee, Texas A&M, and Vanderbilt.
- The Feb. 15 Auburn at Alabama game marked the first No. 1 vs. No. 2 AP matchup in conference history.
- Eleven of the 50 players listed on the USBWA's Oscar Robertson Trophy Watch List are from the SEC.
- Three SEC coaches rank among the winningest active coaches in the nation: John Calipari (1st/831 wins), Rick Barnes (2nd/830 wins) and Bruce Pearl (11th/689 wins).
- Eight of the 26 players announced as NBA All-Stars attended SEC schools: Kevin Durant (PHX/TX), Shai Gilgeous-Alexander (OKC/UK), Karl-Anthony Towns (NYK/UK), Anthony Davis (DAL/UK), Anthony Edwards, (MIN/UG), Darius Garland (CLE/VU), Tyler Herro (MIA/UK), and Trae Young (ATL/OU).

Non-Conference Recap

- SEC teams won 88.9 percent (185-23) of their non-conference games this season. That tops the nine-team ACC in 2003-04 that had a 88.2 winning percentage (75-10) in games before New Year's Day.
- SEC teams are 59-19 (75.6 percent) against teams from the ACC (30-4), Big 12 (14-2), Big East (5-4) and Big Ten (10-9).
- SEC teams posted a 21-7 record against non-conference teams ranked in the Associated Press Top 25, including a 6-2 mark against teams ranked in the Top 10.

Postseason Awards

The Coaches All-SEC team with individual awards will be released on Tuesday, March 11. This year's awards include: All-SEC First, Second and Third Teams, All-Freshman Team, All-Defensive Team, Coach of the Year, Player of the Year, Defensive Player of the Year, Scholar-Athlete of the Year, Sixth Man of the Year and Freshman of the Year.

SEC SUCCESS

Individual

- In 2024, Kentucky's Reed Sheppard earned the SEC's third straight National Freshman of the Year (Auburn's Jabari Smith in 2022 and Alabama's Brandon Miller in 2023).
- Tennessee's Dalton Knecht was named a 2024 Consensus First Team All-America while Alabama's Mark Sears was a Consensus Second Team All-America.
- Five players earned All-America honors from the Associated Press in 2024, including Alabama's Mark Sears (2nd team) and Auburn's Johni Broome (3rd team).
- 65 SEC players have been selected in the last seven NBA Drafts. That leads all conferences: 57 ACC, 46 Pac-12, 45 Big Ten, 34 Big 12 and 27 Big East.
- 38 SEC players have been selected in the first round of the last seven NBA Drafts. That leads the nation: 35 ACC, 23 Pac-12, 19 Big Ten, 18 Big 12 and 13 Big East.
- 20 NBA Draft Lottery picks in the last seven years are the most in the nation. That leads the nation: 15 ACC, 10 Big 12, 10 Big Ten, 7 Pac-12, and Big East 6.
- Six No. 1 overall NBA Draft picks since 2010.
- 12 NBA Draft picks in 2021, 2020 and 2019.
- 100 players from SEC schools were on 2024-25 NBA Opening Day rosters.
- Eight players from SEC schools were named to the 2025 NBA All-Star roster.
- Four players from SEC schools were members of the USA Basketball's gold medal winning team at the 2024 Paris Olympics.


Team

- The SEC has had 43 NCAA Tournament selections over the last six tournaments.
- A record-tying 10 SEC teams received postseason bids in 2023 and 2024. The SEC's eight NCAA Tournament selections in both 2023 and 2024 tied its previous best set in 2018. Additionally, two SEC teams competed in the NIT each year.
- Every SEC team has made at least one NCAA Tournament appearance in the last nine tournaments.
- Nine different SEC teams have advanced to the Sweet 16 in the last seven NCAA Tournaments. All 16 SEC members have advanced to the Sweet 16 since 1996.
- At least one team has advanced to the Elite Eight in 10 of the last 14 tournaments.
- The SEC has advanced a team in the Final Four seven of the last 13 tournaments.
- Eleven different SEC teams (Alabama, Arkansas, Auburn, Florida, Georgia, Kentucky, LSU, Mississippi State, Oklahoma, South Carolina and Texas) have appeared in the Final Four.
- Since the 2018-19 season, four different SEC schools have been ranked No. 1 in the Associated Press Poll: Alabama 2023, Auburn 2022, Kentucky 2020, and Tennessee 2019.
- Ten different SEC schools have been ranked No. 1 in the Associated Press Poll: Alabama, Arkansas, Auburn, Florida, Kentucky, Missouri, Oklahoma, South Carolina, Tennessee and Texas.

Coaches

- Three coaches enter the 2025 season ranking among the winningest active coaches in the nation: John Calipari (1st/813 wins), Rick Barnes (2nd/806 wins) and Bruce Pearl (12th/683 wins).
- Five coaches have been named national coach of the year: Rick Barnes, Chris Beard, John Calipari, Bruce Pearl and Rodney Terry.
- Six coaches have coached in the Final Four: Rick Barnes, Chris Beard, John Calipari, Nate Oats, Porter Moser and Bruce Pearl.

2025 SEC BASKETBALL TOURNAMENT • BRIDGESTONE ARENA • NASHVILLE, TN



The winner of the 13-game SEC Men's Basketball Tournament receives the league's automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament. The tournament seeds are determined by the 18-game conference schedule during the regular season. Teams are seeded 1-14 based on their regular season conference finish.

Atlanta served as host of the inaugural SEC Tournament played following the 1932-33 season and did so again after the 1933-34 season. The event was held every year through 1952, with the exception of 1935. After a 26-year layoff (1953-78), the tournament was renewed in 1979. The 2020 tournament will be the 61st in league history and the 42nd since the renewal.

The event has helped set the stage for SEC teams in the NCAA Tournament, as 27 of the tournament champions since the tournament resumed in 1979 have advanced to at least the Sweet 16. Twenty of those teams have gone on to the Elite Eight, 12 to the Final Four and three have been crowned national champion. Six of the last 15 SEC Tournament champions have advanced to the Final Four with three of those teams winning a national championship. The SEC Tournament Champion has failed to win at least one NCAA Tournament game only four times.

Kentucky leads the league with 31 SEC Tournament titles. Alabama is second with seven, while Tennessee and Florida are tied for third with four. Mississippi State has three championship trophies while Auburn, Georgia, Ole Miss and Vanderbilt have two. Arkansas, LSU and former league member Georgia Tech have each won one SEC Tournament championship.

SEC Tournament Tie-Breaker Procedures

Teams will be seeded No. 1 through No. 14 in the SEC Men's Basketball Tournament bracket based upon the final regular season Conference standings. Teams that finished No. 1 through No. 4 in the final regular season standings shall receive first and second-round byes and teams that finish No. 5 through No. 10 will receive first-round byes in the SEC Men's Basketball Tournament.

1. **Two-Team Tie:** The following procedure will be used in the following order until the tie is broken:

- Won-lost results of head-to-head competition between the two teams.
- Won-lost record of the two teams versus the No. 1 seed (and proceeding through the No. 14 seed, if necessary).
- Coin flip by the Commissioner.

2. **Three-Team Tie (or more):** When three or more teams are tied, the following procedure will be used in the following order until the tie is broken. If two teams remain tied after a tiebreaker provision, the two-team tiebreaker form

- Best winning percentage of games played among the tied teams (Example: Team A is 3-1, Team B is 2-2 and Team C is 1-3 – Team A would be seeded highest, Team B second-highest and Team C lowest of the three).
- Best winning percentage of the tied teams versus the No. 1 seed (and proceeding through the No. 14 seed, if necessary).
- If two teams remain, coin flip by the Commissioner.
- If three or more teams remain, draw by the Commissioner.

For the purpose of seeding, if an institution is precluded from participating in the tournament, such institution will automatically be seeded last. The No. 11 seed will then receive a bye. However, for the purpose of breaking ties, that team will remain where it finished in the regular-season standings BEFORE being seeded last.
