FOR STARTERS

- Carolina ends its four-game homestand on Tuesday night (April 1) as the Gamecocks welcome Presbyterian.
- First pitch is at 7 p.m., at Ray Tanner Field at Founders Park.
- Tuesday's game will be televised on SEC Network with Roy Philpott and David Dellucci on
- Tuesday's game also will be on the Gamecock Sports Network presented by Learfield with Derek Scott and Stuart Lake on the call.

SCOUTING PRESBYTERIAN

- The Blue Hose won 2-of-3 games at UNC Asheville this past weekend.
- Trey Fenderson was a perfect 5-for-5 at the plate in PC's 12-7 win over Asheville in Saturday's second game of a doubleheader.
- Presbyterian's signature win was an 11-8 win over Alabama on March 9.
- Fenderson leads the Blue Hose with a .374 batting average while Ryan Ouzts has seven home runs
- On the mound, Jacob Fields has a team-best five saves to go along with a 2.81 ERA.
- Elton Pollock is in his 21st season as head coach at Presbyterian. He was named the Big South Coach of the Year in 2024.

SERIES VS. PRESBYTERIAN

- Carolina leads the all-time series with Presbyterian 50-21 heading into Tuesday's game.
- The Gamecocks won last year's meeting, 19-14, on March 26 as Dalton Reeves drove in six runs with Ethan Petry having five RBI. Kennedy Jones scored five runs in the win.
- Carolina is 42-7 all-time against Presbyterian in Columbia.

HALL OF HITTING

- Junior Nathan Hall continues to lead the Gamecocks at the plate this season.
- Hall has a .378 batting average, good for ninth in the SEC, to go along with four home runs and 24 RBI.
- Hall is slugging at a .559 clip and is reaching base 45.5 percent of the time.
- Hall leads the team with eight steals and has added eight doubles.
- In Sunday's game against Arkansas, Hall led off the game with a home run and had three hits on the day.
- It was the first time a Gamecock led off a game with a home run since Will McGillis in the 2023 Gainesville Super Regional.
- Hall then had three RBI, including a home run in the first inning, on March 25 against North Carolina.

EVANS REMAINS PERFECT IN 2025

- Junior Jarvis Evans is a perfect 3-0 with a 3.62 ERA and 32 strikeouts in 32.1 innings pitched
- He went six innings in a 4-3 win over the College of Charleston on March 18, striking out five and allowing just one run.
- Evans had a spot start in Sunday's game against Arkansas, pitching three innings and allowing two runs.
- Evans has the longest outing by innings this season, going seven strong at The Citadel on
- In the outing vs. Tennessee on March 29, Evans went six solid frames, striking out five

and allowing three runs with just one walk.

FOUR HIT CLUB

- Carolina had three hitters with four hits in a game this past weekend against Tennessee (March 28-30).
- On Friday night, both Ethan Petry and Jordan Carrion had four hits against the Volunteers. Carrion was a perfect 4-for-4 on the night.
- Both players tied their career high in hits in a game.
- Then in Saturday's game, Beau Hollins was a perfect 4-for-4 at the plate.
- Those three join Nathan Hall (vs. Queens) and Will Tippett (vs. Milwaukee) with four-hit games this season.

FROSH AT THE CORNERS

- Freshmen KJ Scobey and Beau Hollins are manning the corners for Carolina this season.
- Scobey had four hits and three runs scored in the series against Oklahoma and added four hits in the Arkansas series.
- Scobey has played in 28 games this season and is hitting .268 with three home runs and 12 RBI. He also has committed just three errors at third base.
- Hollins had four hits in Saturday's game vs. Tennessee and currently has a .317 batting average with 14 runs scored.
- The duo is joined by fellow freshman Gavin Braland, who caught the final two games of the Tennessee series and had an RBI single on Sunday.

PETRY SHOOTS UP CAREER HOME RUN LIST

- Junior Ethan Petry will enter the Tennessee series with 51 home runs at Carolina, which has him in second place on the all-time home run list
- The Land O' Lakes. Fla., native had 23 home runs in his freshman season in 2023, then followed that up with 21 his sophomore
- Petry has been named to the preseason All-America second team by both D1 Baseball and Perfect Game, the third team by the NCBWA, was named to the Preseason All-SEC first team and is on the Golden Spikes Award Watch List.
- Last season, Petry hit .306 with 21 home runs and 53 RBI while leading the team with 51 walks. He was named to the All-Raleigh Regional team.
- Petry is 11 home runs away from tying Justin Smoak (2006-08) for the all-time mark.
- Petry had a solo home run in the first inning on March 25 against North Carolina in Char-
- The junior is hitting .358 with eight doubles, a triple, seven home runs and leads the team with 25 RBI.

MILESTONE CENTRAL

Head Coach Paul Mainieri heads into the North Carolina game with the most career wins of any active head coach in Division I baseball. Mainieri has 1,522 career wins in his

- stops at St. Thomas, Air Force, Notre Dame and LSU.
- Ethan Petry is second in career home runs at Carolina with 51, but he also has 153 career RBI in 153 games played. He needs 15 RBI to be in a tie for 10th in Carolina history.
- Matthew Becker now has 238 career strikeouts after the Tennessee outing. Currently, he has 238 punchouts in 168.1 innings pitched.
- Kennedy Jones enters 2025 with 36 career home runs, 45 career doubles and 259 career hits between his time at UNC Greensboro and Carolina.
- Blake Jackson has 27 doubles and 11 home runs to go along with 117 hits between Charlotte and Carolina.

MAINIERI ERA STARTS IN 2025

- Head Coach Paul Mainieri started his South Carolina tenure on Feb. 14, 2025
- Mainieri is the 31st head coach in Gamecock history and is starting his 40th season as a head coach.
- Mainieri is the active leader in head coaching wins with 1,522.
- Mainieri most recently was the head coach at LSU for 15 seasons, guiding the Tigers to a national championship in 2009, a runner-up finish in 2017 and five CWS appearances.
- In 11 of 14 full seasons at LSU, Mainieri led the Tigers to at least one team championship.
- In his 40-year career, Mainieri has made six College World Series appearances (5 with LSU, 1 with Notre Dame), four SEC championships, six SEC Tournament championships and 10 NCAA Regional championships.
- Mainieri moved to sixth place on the all-time wins list for head coaches after the Winthrop win on Feb. 18, passing Larry Hays (1971-2008), who coached at Texas Tech and Lubbock Christian.
- Mainieri is a two-time SEC Coach of the Year and four-time National Coach of the Year.

A WELL ROUNDED STAFF

- Head Coach Paul Mainieri hired his coaching staff over the summer, retaining one coach and hiring two others.
- Associate head coach Monte Lee returns for his third consecutive season and ninth overall at Carolina. Lee is the hitting coach to go along with the associate head coach title.
- Lee has helped the Gamecocks to back-to-back 100-plus home run seasons with an over .400 on-base percentage.
- Terry Rooney will begin his first season with the Gamecocks as the pitching coach/recruiting coordinator.
- Rooney was at LSU last year as the Associate Director of Program Development. He has been Mainieri's pitching coach for two years at LSU (2007-08) and three years at Notre Dame (2004-06).
- John Hendry starts his first season as an assistant coach with Carolina.
 Hendry was at Virginia for the last three seasons as the program's Director of Player Development.
- Chris Gordon (Director of Ops/Player Development) and Caleb Westfall (Graduate Assistant) round out the staff.

GAMECOCKS IN THE SHOW

- Carolina currently has five players on Major League Baseball Opening Day rosters.
- Christian Walker changed teams this offseason, heading to the Houston Astros after playing in Arizona for the last eight seasons. Walker will start at first base for the Astros in 2025.
- Carmen Mlodzinski will be in the rotation for the Pittsburgh Pirates.
- Jonah Bride will head into his second season with the Miami Marlins.
- Clarke Schmidt will start the season on the Yankees' Injured List while Jordan Montgomery is out for the season for the Diamondbacks.

RAY TANNER FIELD AT FOUNDERS PARK

 Two-time National Championship Baseball Coach and Athletics Director Ray Tanner will have his name on the baseball field at Founders Park during a pre-game ceremony on Feb. 15 before the Sacred Heart game.

- The Gamecock baseball field will now be "Ray Tanner Field."
- Ray Tanner Field is the first USC athletics competition surface to carry the name of a former coach or student-athlete.
- In 16 seasons as the Gamecock head coach, Tanner compiled a 738-316 (.700) record with six College World Series appearances, winning the 2010 and 2011 NCAA Championships and national runners-up finishes in 2002 and 2012.
- Carolina made 14 NCAA tournament appearances under Tanner, advancing to 10 Super Regionals. USC won three SEC regular season championships (2000, 2002 and 2011), the 2004 SEC Tournament and six SEC East titles (1999, 2000, 2002, 2003, 2011, 2012).
- Under Tanner's leadership, the Carolina baseball program set an NCAA record for consecutive NCAA Tournament wins (22) and CWS wins (12) between 2010-12, as the Gamecocks became just the sixth and last school to win back-to-back baseball national titles.

STOUT SCHEDULE FOR THE GAMECOCKS

- Carolina will face eight teams ranked in D1Baseball.com's Top-25 this season.
- This includes the top two teams in the country, with three-game series against No. 1 Tennessee and No. 2 Arkansas
- Carolina also has a three-game series against No. 6 Clemson, No. 7 LSU, No. 9 Ole Miss, No. 10 Oklahoma and No. 16 Auburn and a single game against No. 19 North Carolina in Charlotte.

2024 REWIND

- The Gamecocks finished the 2024 season with a 37-25 overall record and a 13-17 SEC record.
- Carolina advanced to its 35th NCAA Tournament in program history as it was extended an invitation to the NCAA Raleigh Regional, going 1-2.
- Carolina had three wins (Alabama, Arkansas, Kentucky) in the SEC Tournament with catcher Cole Messina earning All-Tournament honors.
- Messina led USC with a .326 batting average to go along with 21 home runs and 71 RBI. He was drafted by the Colorado Rockies in the third round of the MLB First-Year Player Draft.
- Ethan Petry matched Messina with 21 home runs while hitting .306 on the year.
- Carolina hit 101 home runs and walked 382 times for a .411 on-base percentage.
- On the mound, Dylan Eskew had three wins and a .240 opponent's batting average while Garrett Gainey had six saves and 68 strikeouts in 54 innings pitched.

IMPACT TRANSFERS

- Carolina brings in eight transfers from Division I schools as well as six junior college transfers in 2025.
- Shortstop Henry Kaczmar comes to Columbia after two seasons at Ohio State, where he hit .307 with 20 doubles and 14 home runs. Kaczmar was named the No. 24 Impact Transfer by D1 Baseball.
- USC has a pair of Clemson transfers in Nathan Hall and Nolan Nawrocki.
 Hall will start in center field while Nawrocki will see time at second base.
- Jarvis Evans (Georgia), Max Kaufer (Texas A&M), Caleb Jones (Winthrop), Ashton Crowther (Mlami) and Wyatt Evans (Tennessee) also will be on the Gamecocks after transferring from a Division I school.
- Cayden Gaskin (No. 11 player) and Brandon Stone (No. 27 pitcher) were on D1 Baseball's Top JUCO transfers in the country.
- Brandon Sweeney, Aydin Palmer, Jase Woita and Jackson Soucie all come to Columbia from the junior college ranks.

SEC LEADERS

- Parker Marlatt is tied for third in the SEC with 13 appearances on the mound while Tyler Pitzer is tied for seventh with 12 appearances.
- Brendan Sweeney is tied for sixth in the league with four saves.
- Jake McCoy is tied for eighth in the SEC with 48 strikeouts.
- Nathan Hall is tied for sixth in the SEC with 42 hits and ninth with a .378 batting average.
- In SEC games only, Jordan Carrion is tied for seventh with 15 hits

- The Gamecocks travel to Starkville, Miss., for a three-game series at Mississippi State starting Friday, April 4.
- Friday's game starts at 7 p.m. EDT with Saturday and Sunday's games at 3 p.m. and 2 p.m. Eastern, respectively.

PAUL MAINIERI

HEAD COACH 1ST SEASON AT SOUTH CAROLINA - 40TH SEASON AS A HEAD COACH FLORIDA INTERNATIONAL (1980)

Paul Mainieri has been named the head baseball coach at the University of South Carolina, Athletics Director Ray Tanner announced today (Tuesday, June 11). He becomes the 31st head coach in the history of Gamecock baseball.

Mainieri, who is the active leader in career wins in Division I (1,505), guided LSU to a 2009 national championship and a 2017 runner-up finish. He has made six College World Series appearances, five with LSU and one with Notre Dame, four SEC championships, six SEC Tournament championships and 10 NCAA regional championships. Mainieri is a two-time SEC Coach of the Year and a four-time National Coach of the Year (2000, '08, '09 and '15).

Mainieri spent 15 seasons at LSU, guiding the Tigers to the 2009 College World Series national championship and five CWS appearances. During Mainieri's tenure, LSU captured a remarkable 31 team championships, including the 2009 NCAA title, nine NCAA Regional championships, five NCAA Super Regional championships, four Southeastern Conference championships, six SEC Tournament titles and six SEC Western Division crowns.

In 11 of his 14 full seasons at LSU – the 2020 season was canceled after only 17 games due to COVID-19 – Mainieri led the Tigers to at least one team championship.

Mainieri posts a 1,522-786-8 (.658) record in 40 seasons of collegiate coaching at St. Thomas University (1984-88), Air Force (1989-94), Notre Dame (1995-2006) and LSU (2007-21). Mainieri is No. 7 in all-time NCAA Division I Baseball wins, and he is one of only five Division I coaches in NCAA history to have won over 1,500 games and a national championship.

He has guided his teams to 46 team championships – 31 at LSU and 15 at Notre Dame. As head coach at Notre Dame from 1995-2006, Mainieri directed the Irish to an NCAA Super Regional title and an NCAA Regional championship, eight regular-season conference championships and five league tournament titles.

Mainieri recorded a 641-285-3 (.692) mark at LSU, and he has the fourth-highest winning percentage in SEC history, trailing only former LSU coach Skip Bertman, who was 870-330-3 (.724) from 1984-2001, current Tennessee head coach Tony Vitello, who has a 295-112 (.725) record from 2018-current and former South Carolina coach Ray Tanner, who posted a 738-316 (.700) mark from 1997-2012.

Under Mainieri, the Tigers earned an NCAA Tournament National Seed in six consecutive seasons (2012-17), making LSU and Stanford (1999-2004) the only schools in NCAA history to capture six straight National Seeds. Beginning in 2008, LSU earned nine NCAA Tournament National Seeds, the second-best mark in the country over the past 14 full seasons.

Mainieri's LSU players earned First-Team All-America recognition on 13 occasions, and 25 of his former Tigers have played Major League Baseball. LSU players were chosen in the MLB Draft on 90 occasions during Mainieri's tenure, including a first-round selection in seven of the past 13 seasons.

He served as the head coach of the United States Collegiate National Team for its 2018 summer tour, and he led Team USA to a 12-3 record that included series victories over Chinese Taipei, Japan and Cuba.

His sincere commitment to everyday excellence was recognized in a substantial way on January 3, 2014, in Dallas when he was inducted into the American Baseball Coaches Association Hall of Fame.

Mainieri, a four-time National Coach of the Year, joined in the Hall of Fame his father, Demie Mainieri, who coached Miami-Dade North Community College to 1,012 wins and a national title in his 30-year career. Demie and Paul Mainieri are the only father-son combination in the ABCA Hall of Fame.

Mainieri's commitment to academic achievement was illustrated by the Tigers' performance in the classroom, as 103 LSU baseball players earned their degrees during his tenure. Twenty-five of the graduates were players who signed professional contracts before completing their college eligibility and returned to LSU to finish their degree requirements. In addition, LSU players received SEC Academic Honor Roll recognition on 151 occasions during Mainieri's tenure.

He established an active community service function within the baseball program, as the Tigers regularly visit hospitals and schools in the Baton Rouge area. The team also participated in events like the in the ALS Walk — promoting awareness of the treatment of Lou Gehrig's Disease — and in the Buddy Walk, which is designed to encourage acceptance and inclusion of people with Down Syndrome.

Mainieri is personally involved in several philanthropic causes, including Cancer Services of Baton Rouge, the ALS Association, the Baton Rouge Children's Advocacy Center, the Knock Knock Children's Museum, Prostate Cancer Awareness and the Kelli Leigh Richmond Ovarian Cancer Foundation.

A four-year letterwinner in college, Mainieri played one season at LSU, one season for his father – legendary JUCO coach Demie Mainieri – at Miami-Dade North Community College, and two seasons at the University of New Orleans. The second baseman helped the Privateers win two Sun Belt Conference titles and advance to the 1979 NCAA Tournament during his senior season.

After completing his undergraduate degree requirements at Florida International (1980), Mainieri played two minor-league seasons before earning a master's in sports administration from St. Thomas in 1982.

Mainieri's coaching career began at his alma mater, Columbus High School in Miami, where he served as assistant baseball and football coach for three years before taking over as the head coach at St. Thomas in the fall of 1982. He also spent the final three years at St. Thomas as director of athletics. Mainieri was inducted into the Columbus High School Sports Hall of Fame in October 2009. He is a member of the St. Thomas Athletics Hall of Fame, and the St. Thomas baseball facility in March 2013 was named Paul Demie Mainieri Field in his honor.

Born August 29, 1957, in Morgantown, W.Va., Mainieri and his wife, Karen, have four children – Nicholas, Alexandra, Samantha and Thomas – and four grandchildren – Holden, Jonathan, Wren and Rocco.




