#### FOR STARTERS

- Carolina closes out the regular season this weekend, hosting No. 1 LSU in a three-game SEC series from May 15-17.
- Thursday and Friday's games will start at 7 p.m. with Saturday's game beginning at 3 p.m.
- Thursday's game will be televised on SEC Network with Dave Neal and Jackie Bradley Jr., on the call.
- Friday and Saturday's game will be streamed on SEC Network Plus.
- All three games also will be on the Gamecock Sports Network presented by Learfield with Derek Scott and Stuart Lake on the call.

#### **SCOUTING LSU**

- The Tigers won 2-of-3 games against Arkansas this past weekend, winning Friday's game 5-4 in 10 innings and Saturday's contest 13-3 in seven frames.
- Freshman Derek Curiel is hitting .352 with 15 doubles and 44 RBI while Jared Jones has 16 home runs.
- Former Gamecock Michael Braswell III has played in 49 games and has 14 RBI.
- On the mound, Anthony Eyanson is 8-2 with a 2.91 ERA and 116 strikeouts in 74.1 innings pitched.
- Jay Johnson is in his fourth season at LSU. He guided the Tigers to the 2023 national championship.

#### **SERIES VS. LSU**

- LSU has a 44-32-1 series advantage on Carolina heading into Thursday's game.
- Carolina is 14-18 against LSU in Columbia.
- The two teams met in the SEC Tournament twice last season. LSU won a pair of one-run games. Cole Messina had six RBI in the 11-10 game on May 23.
- The two teams last met in Columbia in 2023.
   The rain-shortened series was split as Carolina won 13-5 in the first game and fell 8-7 in game two
- Ethan Petry had eight RBI in the first game of 2023, including a home run off Paul Skenes and a grand slam.

#### **CAROLINA CELEBRATES SENIOR DAY ON FRIDAY**

- Prior to Friday's game vs. LSU, the Gamecock baseball program will honor the 10 seniors on Senior Night.
- Matthew Becker, Jordan Carrion, Dylan Eskew, Blake Jackson, Caleb Jones, Kennedy Jones, Roman Kimball, Talmadge LeCroy, Dalton Mashore and Evan Stone will be recognized while eight more managers, analytics, bullpen catchers and creative media seniors will be honored on field.

#### GAMECOCKS WIN IN THE MIDWEEK

- Carolina defeated Winthrop, 6-5, on May 13.
- It improved the Gamecocks' midweek record to 13-1 on the year.
- The only loss in the midweek was against current No. 4 team in the country North Carolina.
- The Gamecocks are 22-0 against Quad 2, 3 and 4 teams this season.

#### KAZ, WOITA GETTING HOT IN SEC PLAY

 Henry Kaczmar and Jase Woita are leading the team in average in conference games this season.

- Woita had five hits in the Auburn series, including his fifth home run on May 8, and is now hitting .333 with three home runs and eight RBI in SEC games.
- Kaczmar homered and had four hits in the three games and has a .326 average in the 27 conference games with four home runs and 15 RBI.

#### FROSH AT THE CORNERS

- Freshmen KJ Scobey and Beau Hollins are manning the corners for Carolina this season.
- Scobey has played in 52 games this season and has seven home runs and 23 RBI.
- Scobey homered for the seventh time this season in a 6-5 win over Winthrop May 13.
- Hollins gave Carolina a 6-5 lead over Winthrop with his three-run double in the eighth.
- Hollins has four hits in a game three times this season, including May 9 at Auburn.
- The duo is joined by fellow freshman Gavin Braland, who had four hits and two RBI in the Kentucky series.

#### PETRY SHOOTS UP CAREER HOME RUN LIST

- Junior Ethan Petry will enter the LSU series with 54 home runs at Carolina, which has him in second place on the all-time home run list.
- The Land O' Lakes, Fla., native had 23 home runs in his freshman season in 2023, then followed that up with 21 his sophomore season.
- Petry has been named to the preseason All-America second team by both D1 Baseball and Perfect Game, the third team by the NCBWA, was named to the Preseason All-SEC first team and is on the Golden Spikes Award Watch List.
- Petry is eight home runs away from tying Justin Smoak (2006-08) for the all-time mark.
- Petry had a solo home run in the third inning in the 8-7 loss at Texas A&M on April 10.
- The junior is hitting .321 with 10 doubles, a triple, 10 home runs and 34 RBI.

#### STONE GOES ALL NINE IN OLE MISS WIN

- Sophomore Brandon Stone went the distance in the 3-2 win over Ole Miss on April 17, striking out four and allowing two runs on six hits with no walks in nine innings.
- Stone needed just 86 pitches, with 61 of them for strikes, in the nine innings.
- It was Carolina's first complete game since Noah Hall against Georgia in 2023 and first nine-inning complete game since Brett Kerry against Kentucky in 2021.
- The complete game was just the second nine-inning CG in the league this season (LSU's Kade Anderson vs. Oklahoma) and the third overall (LSU's Anthony Eyanson vs. Texas A&M).
- Stone's defense was big as the Gamecocks turned three double plays, including one with a runner on and no one out in the ninth.
- Stone retired the first seven batters of the game and had four 1-2-3 frames.

#### HALL OF HITTING

- Nathan Hall continues to have a stellar junior season for the Gamecocks.
- Hall has a .330 batting average to go along with seven home runs and 38 RBI.
- Hall leads the team with 13 steals and has added 13 doubles.
- In the game against Ole Miss on April 18, Hall homered and drove in three runs, including a big two-run single in the eighth.

#### MILESTONE CENTRAL

- Head Coach Paul Mainieri heads into the LSU series with the most career wins of any active head coach in Division I baseball. Mainieri has 1,532 career wins in his stops at St. Thomas, Air Force, Notre Dame and LSU.
- Ethan Petry is second in career home runs at Carolina with 54, but he also has 162 career RBI in 168 games played. He needs six RBI to be in a tie for 10th in Carolina history.
- Petry recorded his 200th career hit in the North Florida win, a double in the fourth inning.
- Matthew Becker now has 260 career strikeouts after the Florida outing. Currently, he has 260 punchouts in 185.2 innings pitched.
- Kennedy Jones enters 2025 with 36 career home runs, 46 career doubles and 267 career hits between his time at UNC Greensboro and Carolina.
- Blake Jackson has 28 doubles and 13 home runs to go along with 125 hits between Charlotte and Carolina.

#### **MAINIERI ERA STARTS IN 2025**

- Head Coach Paul Mainieri started his South Carolina tenure on Feb. 14, 2025
- Mainieri is the 31st head coach in Gamecock history and is starting his 40th season as a head coach.
- Mainieri is the active leader in head coaching wins with 1,532.
- Mainieri most recently was the head coach at LSU for 15 seasons, guiding the Tigers to a national championship in 2009, a runner-up finish in 2017 and five CWS appearances.
- In 11 of 14 full seasons at LSU, Mainieri led the Tigers to at least one team championship.
- In his 40-year career, Mainieri has made six College World Series appearances (5 with LSU, 1 with Notre Dame), four SEC championships, six SEC Tournament championships and 10 NCAA Regional championships.
- Mainieri moved to sixth place on the all-time wins list for head coaches after the Winthrop win on Feb. 18, passing Larry Hays (1971-2008), who coached at Texas Tech and Lubbock Christian.
- Mainieri is a two-time SEC Coach of the Year and four-time National Coach of the Year.

#### A WELL ROUNDED STAFF

- Head Coach Paul Mainieri hired his coaching staff over the summer, retaining one coach and hiring two others.
- Associate head coach Monte Lee returns for his third consecutive season and ninth overall at Carolina. Lee is the hitting coach to go along with the associate head coach title.
- Lee has helped the Gamecocks to back-to-back 100-plus home run seasons with an over .400 on-base percentage.
- Terry Rooney will begin his first season with the Gamecocks as the pitching coach/recruiting coordinator.
- Rooney was at LSU last year as the Associate Director of Program Development. He has been Mainieri's pitching coach for two years at LSU (2007-08) and three years at Notre Dame (2004-06).
- John Hendry starts his first season as an assistant coach with Carolina.
   Hendry was at Virginia for the last three seasons as the program's Director of Player Development.
- Chris Gordon (Director of Ops/Player Development) and Caleb Westfall (Graduate Assistant) round out the staff.

#### GAMECOCKS IN THE SHOW

- Carolina currently has five players on Major League Baseball Opening Day rosters.
- Christian Walker changed teams this offseason, heading to the Houston Astros after playing in Arizona for the last eight seasons. Walker will start at first base for the Astros in 2025.
- Carmen Mlodzinski will be in the rotation for the Pittsburgh Pirates.
- Jonah Bride was traded from the Mlami Marlins to the Minnesota Twins on April 16.
- Clarke Schmidt is back in the rotation for the New York Yankees after starting the season on the injured list while Jordan Montgomery is out for the season for the Diamondbacks.

#### RAY TANNER FIELD AT FOUNDERS PARK

- Two-time National Championship Baseball Coach and Athletics Director Ray Tanner will have his name on the baseball field at Founders Park during a pre-game ceremony on Feb. 15 before the Sacred Heart game.
- The Gamecock baseball field will now be "Ray Tanner Field."
- Ray Tanner Field is the first USC athletics competition surface to carry the name of a former coach or student-athlete.
- In 16 seasons as the Gamecock head coach, Tanner compiled a 738-316 (.700) record with six College World Series appearances, winning the 2010 and 2011 NCAA Championships and national runners-up finishes in 2002 and 2012.
- Carolina made 14 NCAA tournament appearances under Tanner, advancing to 10 Super Regionals. USC won three SEC regular season championships (2000, 2002 and 2011), the 2004 SEC Tournament and six SEC East titles (1999, 2000, 2002, 2003, 2011, 2012).
- Under Tanner's leadership, the Carolina baseball program set an NCAA record for consecutive NCAA Tournament wins (22) and CWS wins (12) between 2010-12, as the Gamecocks became just the sixth and last school to win back-to-back baseball national titles.

#### **2024 REWIND**

- The Gamecocks finished the 2024 season with a 37-25 overall record and a 13-17 SEC record.
- Carolina advanced to its 35th NCAA Tournament in program history as it was extended an invitation to the NCAA Raleigh Regional, going 1-2.
- Carolina had three wins (Alabama, Arkansas, Kentucky) in the SEC Tournament with catcher Cole Messina earning All-Tournament honors.
- Messina led USC with a .326 batting average to go along with 21 home runs and 71 RBI. He was drafted by the Colorado Rockies in the third round of the MLB First-Year Player Draft.
- Ethan Petry matched Messina with 21 home runs while hitting .306 on the year.
- Carolina hit 101 home runs and walked 382 times for a .411 on-base percentage.
- On the mound, Dylan Eskew had three wins and a .240 opponent's batting average while Garrett Gainey had six saves and 68 strikeouts in 54 innings pitched.

#### **IMPACT TRANSFERS**

- Carolina brings in eight transfers from Division I schools as well as six junior college transfers in 2025.
- Shortstop Henry Kaczmar comes to Columbia after two seasons at Ohio State, where he hit .307 with 20 doubles and 14 home runs. Kaczmar was named the No. 24 Impact Transfer by D1 Baseball.
- USC has a pair of Clemson transfers in Nathan Hall and Nolan Nawrocki.
   Hall will start in center field while Nawrocki will see time at second base.
- Jarvis Evans (Georgia), Max Kaufer (Texas A&M), Caleb Jones (Winthrop), Ashton Crowther (Mlami) and Wyatt Evans (Tennessee) also will be on the Gamecocks after transferring from a Division I school.
- Cayden Gaskin (No. 11 player) and Brandon Stone (No. 27 pitcher) were on D1 Baseball's Top JUCO transfers in the country.
- Brandon Sweeney, Aydin Palmer, Jase Woita and Jackson Soucie all come to Columbia from the junior college ranks.

#### **SEC LEADERS**

- Parker Marlatt is tied for fourth in the SEC with 23 appearances on the mound.
- Brendan Sweeney is tied for fifth in the league with six saves and tied for 10th in the SEC with 21 appearances.

### **PAUL MAINIERI**

## HEAD COACH 1ST SEASON AT SOUTH CAROLINA - 40TH SEASON AS A HEAD COACH FLORIDA INTERNATIONAL (1980)

Paul Mainieri has been named the head baseball coach at the University of South Carolina, Athletics Director Ray Tanner announced today (Tuesday, June 11). He becomes the 31st head coach in the history of Gamecock baseball.

Mainieri, who is the active leader in career wins in Division I (1,505), guided LSU to a 2009 national championship and a 2017 runner-up finish. He has made six College World Series appearances, five with LSU and one with Notre Dame, four SEC championships, six SEC Tournament championships and 10 NCAA regional championships. Mainieri is a two-time SEC Coach of the Year and a four-time National Coach of the Year (2000, '08, '09 and '15).

Mainieri spent 15 seasons at LSU, guiding the Tigers to the 2009 College World Series national championship and five CWS appearances. During Mainieri's tenure, LSU captured a remarkable 31 team championships, including the 2009 NCAA title, nine NCAA Regional championships, five NCAA Super Regional championships, four Southeastern Conference championships, six SEC Tournament titles and six SEC Western Division crowns.

In 11 of his 14 full seasons at LSU – the 2020 season was canceled after only 17 games due to COVID-19 – Mainieri led the Tigers to at least one team championship.

Mainieri posts a 1,532-803-8 (.656) record in 40 seasons of collegiate coaching at St. Thomas University (1984-88), Air Force (1989-94), Notre Dame (1995-2006) and LSU (2007-21). Mainieri is No. 7 in all-time NCAA Division I Baseball wins, and he is one of only five Division I coaches in NCAA history to have won over 1,500 games and a national championship.

He has guided his teams to 46 team championships – 31 at LSU and 15 at Notre Dame. As head coach at Notre Dame from 1995-2006, Mainieri directed the Irish to an NCAA Super Regional title and an NCAA Regional championship, eight regular-season conference championships and five league tournament titles.

Mainieri recorded a 641-285-3 (.692) mark at LSU, and he has the fourth-highest winning percentage in SEC history, trailing only former LSU coach Skip Bertman, who was 870-330-3 (.724) from 1984-2001, current Tennessee head coach Tony Vitello, who has a 295-112 (.725) record from 2018-current and former South Carolina coach Ray Tanner, who posted a 738-316 (.700) mark from 1997-2012.

Under Mainieri, the Tigers earned an NCAA Tournament National Seed in six consecutive seasons (2012-17), making LSU and Stanford (1999-2004) the only schools in NCAA history to capture six straight National Seeds. Beginning in 2008, LSU earned nine NCAA Tournament National Seeds, the second-best mark in the country over the past 14 full seasons.

Mainieri's LSU players earned First-Team All-America recognition on 13 occasions, and 25 of his former Tigers have played Major League Baseball. LSU players were chosen in the MLB Draft on 90 occasions during Mainieri's tenure, including a first-round selection in seven of the past 13 seasons.

He served as the head coach of the United States Collegiate National Team for its 2018 summer tour, and he led Team USA to a 12-3 record that included series victories over Chinese Taipei, Japan and Cuba.

His sincere commitment to everyday excellence was recognized in a substantial way on January 3, 2014, in Dallas when he was inducted into the American Baseball Coaches Association Hall of Fame.

Mainieri, a four-time National Coach of the Year, joined in the Hall of Fame his father, Demie Mainieri, who coached Miami-Dade North Community College to 1,012 wins and a national title in his 30-year career. Demie and Paul Mainieri are the only father-son combination in the ABCA Hall of Fame.

Mainieri's commitment to academic achievement was illustrated by the Tigers' performance in the classroom, as 103 LSU baseball players earned their degrees during his tenure. Twenty-five of the graduates were players who signed professional contracts before completing their college eligibility and returned to LSU to finish their degree requirements. In addition, LSU players received SEC Academic Honor Roll recognition on 151 occasions during Mainieri's tenure.

He established an active community service function within the baseball program, as the Tigers regularly visit hospitals and schools in the Baton Rouge area. The team also participated in events like the in the ALS Walk — promoting awareness of the treatment of Lou Gehrig's Disease — and in the Buddy Walk, which is designed to encourage acceptance and inclusion of people with Down Syndrome.

Mainieri is personally involved in several philanthropic causes, including Cancer Services of Baton Rouge, the ALS Association, the Baton Rouge Children's Advocacy Center, the Knock Knock Children's Museum, Prostate Cancer Awareness and the Kelli Leigh Richmond Ovarian Cancer Foundation.

A four-year letterwinner in college, Mainieri played one season at LSU, one season for his father – legendary JUCO coach Demie Mainieri – at Miami-Dade North Community College, and two seasons at the University of New Orleans. The second baseman helped the Privateers win two Sun Belt Conference titles and advance to the 1979 NCAA Tournament during his senior season.

After completing his undergraduate degree requirements at Florida International (1980), Mainieri played two minor-league seasons before earning a master's in sports administration from St. Thomas in 1982.

Mainieri's coaching career began at his alma mater, Columbus High School in Miami, where he served as assistant baseball and football coach for three years before taking over as the head coach at St. Thomas in the fall of 1982. He also spent the final three years at St. Thomas as director of athletics. Mainieri was inducted into the Columbus High School Sports Hall of Fame in October 2009. He is a member of the St. Thomas Athletics Hall of Fame, and the St. Thomas baseball facility in March 2013 was named Paul Demie Mainieri Field in his honor.

Born August 29, 1957, in Morgantown, W.Va., Mainieri and his wife, Karen, have four children – Nicholas, Alexandra, Samantha and Thomas – and four grandchildren – Holden, Jonathan, Wren and Rocco.


