>>> SOUTH CAROLINA OFFENSE NOTES

- LaNorris Sellers connected with Vandrevius Jacobs for a 49-yard touchdown reception with 11:26 left in the second quarter. It was Jacobs' second touchdown reception of the season.
- Sellers then hit Brian Rowe for a 24-yard touchdown with 2:31 left in the first half. It was Rowe's first career touchdown reception.
- Sellers was 18-for-28 on the day for 302 yards with two touchdowns
- It was Sellers' highest passing output since he went for 307 yards against Wofford in 2024
- Jacobs had a career high 128 yards receiving, which also was the highest by a Gamecock this season
- That's the most receiving yards by a Gamecock since Joshua Simon had 132 yards against Texas A&M in 2024.
- Rowe had a career high 50 yards on three receptions
- Seven different Gamecocks had catches vs. Missouri
