KEY STORYLINES BIG BENCH MINUTES: With Tuesday being the Highlanders' third game in four days, going to the roster's bench depth may be necessary when facing the well-rested Gamecocks who last played on Wednesday, November 12th. Off the bench this season for Radford, the Highlanders have gotten great showings from Brennan Rigsby Jr. and Lukas Walls.

Most recently, Walls played a huge role for Radford this previous weekend at the Skechers Greenbrier Tip-Off. Walls helped Radford navigate foul trouble with 13 bench points on 3-of-4 shooting with a pair of threes and six rebounds. Rigsby Jr. has also been a valuable call from the bench this season averaging 5.4 ppg with eight point showings against Western Illinois and Cleveland State.

A LOOK BACK: The Highlanders and Gamecocks meet for a second straight season and for the fifth time in program history Tuesday night. South Carolina has won the previous four match ups, all coming in Columbia, S.C. Last season. Radford put a scare in their SEC foes with a 36-30 lead at halftime. That lead fizzled away, however, as South Carolina stormed back in the eventual 74-48 finish.

THE 2025-26 SEASON BY THE BEAT

GOOD LOOKS ON NATIONAL STAGE

In Radford's first big test of the season, the team played hard at #18 North Carolina with a big run early that gave the team a lead over the Tar Heels. The 74 points scored were the most by a Radford squad against a ranked opponent in over 10 years and the most ever against North Carolina over four games played in the series history. Dennis Parker Jr. led the scoring with 23 points, followed closely by Del Jones' 22, as Radford tied North Carolina's physicality with an even 30 points each in the paint.

FIRST OPENER WIN SINCE 2015-16

Radford's win over Western Illinois was the program's first in a season opener against a Division I opponent since the 2015-16 season. Del Jones dropped a career-high 22 points in his first game as a Highlander while Radford outscored Western Illinois in the fastbreak, paint and off the bench. In the 2015-16 opener, the Mike Jones-led Highlanders upset Georgetown on the road in overtime.

CHU WASTES NO TIME FOR WIN #1

Head Coach Zach Chu wasted no time claiming his first victory, defeating Western Illinois in Radford's season opener 80-75. The Highlanders burst out ahead early and staved off a late run from the Leathernecks to hold on in front of a solid crowd. The victory was Radford's first in the season opener over a Division I opponent since 2015.

JOHNSON'S PRESEASON HONORS

Following his honors as an Ohio Valley all-conference first-team member, Johnson was tabbed to the Big South's preseason all-conference first-team prior to the start of the season. The senior joined Radford for the 2025-26 campaign bringing with him an impressive stat line of 14.3 ppg, 4.8 apg and 35.2 mpg. Johnson scored in double figures in 25 games while leading the conference in assists, the first Tennessee Tech player to do so since the 2011-12 season.

START OF A NEW ERA

Radford Men's Basketball Head Coach Zach Chu is entering his first season in the role after being named the ninth head coach in program history on March 16th, 2025. In the offseason, Chu orchestrated the complete overhaul of the roster bringing in 13 newcomers to the roster while adding a wealth of coaching talent that includes Marcus Jenkins (Associate), Jordan Surenkamp (Assistant), Josh Adel (Assistant), Conor Dow (Assistant), David Watkins (Assistant) and Brady Baker (Director of Scouting).

PLAY BY PLAY

After Cleveland State came out with a 5-0 lead, Radford showcased a renewed energy scoring 15 unanswered points. Mari Jordan got things started with 4 quick points as Jaylon Johnson, Dennis Parker Jr. and Jones all added makes in the run. A tough and-one look from Brennan Rigsby Jr. kept things chugging along and a tip-in by Rigsby Jr. made it 22-10 Radford.

Jones scored four of Radford's next five points while Walls hit his first triple of the game making it a 30-15 lead. Free throws took over the next segment of the game as the next six points came from the charity stripe. Layups by Brown and Parker Jr. got Radford back in rhythm until the under four media. Up 41-29 after another three from Rigsby Jr., Radford got another run going thanks to six paint points from Jones and Jordan. Radford's lead was now 49-32, their biggest of the day, only slightly cut down by a three from the Vikings at the very end of the half.

Out of the break, Radford reestablished its 17-point lead thanks to free throws from Parker Jr. and a second chance make from Brown. At the 16:11 mark another second chance make from Brown put Radford up 57-41. For the next five minutes, though, Radford had its first crucial scoring drought of the second half. The Vikings clawed back into the game with six unanswered points primarily coming from the free throw line. Radford's next floor make wouldn't come until the 11:53 mark as Brown added more points that had Radford up 60-50.

A free throw by Parker Jr. put Radford up 74-64 with 5:14 to play, their last double-digit lead of the game. A 9-0 run by the Vikings pulled the game to its closest margin since the opening minutes. A quick three and jumper gave Cleveland State its first lead also for the first time since the opening minutes. Radford would get multiple looks in the final minutes of the game to try and salvage the final, but Cleveland State made it out on top in the 87-82 finish.

Radford University has found the next leader of its men's basketball program, as the hiring of Zach Chu was made official by Director of Athletics Robert Lineburg on March 16. Chu is the ninth head coach in the storied program's history.

A native of Dallas, Texas, Chu brings with him over nine years of experience in the National Basketball Association (NBA) and most recently served as the Chief Strategist for Men's Basketball for SMU for the past season.

"The landscape of intercollegiate athletics is undeniably undergoing rapid change," Chu commented at his hiring. "The traditional methods of building a program are far less relevant. I have strong conviction that an analytically driven strategy can create a distinct competitive advantage, particularly when applied end-to-end across a basketball program: from player evaluation, to portal management, to game strategy. I am grateful that Robert and Dr. Danilowicz embrace a forward-looking mindset. We can create an environment to facilitate success for our studentathletes which prioritizes their development both academically and athletically. From the top down at Radford, there's a positive energy which drives a belief that we can take a differentiated approach and create sustainable success."

While at SMU, Chu helped the Mustangs to a 23-10 record overall, which included a mark of 13-7 in conference play. The team advanced to the ACC quarterfinals and put itself in position to become a bubble team for the upcoming NCAA Tournament, all during the program's first year in the prestigious power conference.

Prior to his role with the Mustangs, Chu served for three seasons on Carlisle's staff with the Indiana Pacers as the Manager of Game Strategy and Analytics. While with the Pacers, the squad advanced

all the way to the Eastern Conference Finals in 2023-24. He also hit the sidelines as an assistant coach for Indiana's summer league team for two summers in Las Vegas.

Before his time in Indiana, Chu served as an assistant coach for three years with the Texas Legends, the G-League affiliate of the Dallas Mavericks, followed by two seasons as the analytics liaison to Carlisle with the Mavs.

During Chu's tenure with the Mavericks, the team achieved the most efficient offense in NBA history at the time with an offensive rating of 115.9 in 2020. His time with the Legends was highlighted by a 29-21

campaign in 2017-18, which led to the team's second post season appearance all-time since moving to Texas.

To go with his standout experience in the professional ranks, Chu has also traveled extensively as part of Nike's grassroots basketball initiatives, which included eight trips to Asia as a coach and ambassador for the game of basketball. His experience included work with the Nike All-Asia camp in Guangdong, China and with the Chinese National Team in Beijing.

Chu graduated from the University of Richmond where he was a walk-on member of the men's basketball team from 2011-15.



ON THE BENCH



Jenkins brings over 19 years of championship experience to the New River City and most recently worked as an assistant coach with Minnesota out of the Big Ten for the past four seasons. Before he was with the Gophers, Jenkins served as the associate head coach at Richmond for three years after he was promoted from assistant coach. A proven recruiter, he helped the Spiders to a 14-9 record during the 2020-21 campaign and a spot in the NIT Quarterfinals. He also oversaw scouting operations for Richmond's biggest victory of the season; an upset at No. 10 Kentucky in legendary Rupp Arena. Jenkins helped engineer Richmond's turnaround in 2019-20 where the Spiders went 24-7 to tie the school record for most regular season wins. It was a 11-win improvement from the previous year and the third-largest increase in all of NCAA Division I basketball. Jenkins was also named one of the top five assistants in the Atlantic 10 as a result of a survey of A-10 staffs by Stadium.



Jordan Surenkamp joined the Highlanders as an assistant coach in May 2025 after nearly a decade of experience in the NBA. He most recently served as an assistant coach this past season with the Birmingham Squadron, a G League affiliate of the New Orleans Pelicans organization. Prior to his time in Birmingham. Surenkamp was the head coach of the Greensboro Swarm, the G League affiliate of the Charlotte Hornets for three years. During his time with the program, over 15 roster players earned and advanced to NBA call ups. two-way contracts and other international opportunities. Before leading the Swarm for three seasons, Surenkamp served for three years with the NBA's Charlotte Hornets, which included two years as the team's head video coordinator. He also was named the head coach for the Hornets summer league squad in 2022. He began his career in professional basketball with the Brooklyn Nets, which included time as the head video coordinator for their G League affiliate.



Josh Adel makes his way to the New River City by way of the University of Minnesota, where he most recently served as an assistant coach with the program. Adel spent the past 11 years with the Gophers overall. A true grinder with a passion for the game and his student-athletes, Adel climbed the ranks from operations director (2013-14) to video coordinator (2014-23) to his latest role as an assistant on staff. During his time in Minnesota, Adel was a part of the program's two NCAA Tournament appearances in 2017 and 2019. He also served on the staff during the Gophers' 2013 NIT Championship campaign. Adel also spent the 2012-13 season at Florida International where he was the program's video coordinator under head coach Richard Pitino. He also spent five years with Florida from 2007-12 and was promoted to the Gators' head manager position in August 2009.



Conor Dow joins Radford as assistant coach and director of recruiting, bringing with him a global and multi-level coaching background that includes experience with the NBA, G League, FIBA, international academies, and elite collegiate programs. Most recently, Dow spent two years at the NBA Latin America Academy in San Luis Potosí, Mexico, where he oversaw player development, practice planning, and scouting for elite international prospects from over 30 countries. He served as head coach in elite matchups against Nike EYBL teams, top U.S prep schools, and other NBA Academies from around the world. Before his time with the NBA Academy, Dow was an assistant coach at Johns Hopkins University. In the 2022-23 season, the Blue Jays went 25-5 overall en route to a NCAA Sweet 16 appearance and Centennial Conference Coaching Staff of the Year honors. Before Hopkins, Dow spent one season on the sidelines at Ithaca College, posting a 17-9 record.



David Watkins enters his first season with the Radford men's basketball program after a historic two-vear run as an assistant coach at Daytona State College, where he specialized as the Falcons' defensive coordinator. Watkins built one of the top defensive units in the country, guiding Daytona State to back-to-back top five national rankings in forced turnovers. The Falcons averaged 17.7 turnovers forced per game during the 2023-24 season and improved to 18.3 per game in 2024-25. Over that two-year span, Daytona State compiled a 56-8 record overall, tying the school record for wins in consecutive seasons with 28 victories each year. The Falcons also captured back-to-back Citrus Conference Championships and for the first time in program history, made consecutive appearances in the NJCAA National Tournament. In Watkins' final season, the team advanced to the Elite Eight for the first time in school history.



Brady Baker joined the Radford men's and women's basketball programs in September 2025. He is entering his first season in the role. Born and raised in Edinburg, Va., in the Shenandoah Valley, Baker returns to Virginia with over seven years of experience in the National Basketball Association (NBA) and most recently served as the Manager of Basketball Data Science for the Indiana Pacers for the past four seasons. While in Indiana, Baker installed analytical processes on both the front office and coaching side to help the Pacers to two straight Eastern Conference Finals and their first NBA Finals appearance since 2000 last season. During his tenure in Indiana, Baker worked for a prestigious NBA staff that included Head Coach Rick Carlisle and President of Basketball Operations Kevin Pritchard. Baker assisted in all aspects of the basketball department including draft scouting, free agency, coaching gameplans, and more using modern data science and analytics.
