>>> SOUTH CAROLINA NOTES

- Attendance at Williams-Brice Stadium was 79,827.
- South Carolina's captains for the game were Nick Barrett, Trovon Baugh, Brady Hunt and Bryan Thomas Jr.
- Clemson has a 73-45-4 series advantage on Carolina after today's game
- South Carolina is now 647-625-44 all-time.
- Shane Beamer is now 33-30 as a head coach at South Carolina.
- Clemson won the toss and elected to receive.

>>> SOUTH CAROLINA OFFENSE NOTES

- LaNorris Sellers finished 23-42 with 381 yards, two touchdowns and two interceptions.
- Sellers has thrown a touchdown pass in five-straight games.
- The Gamecocks first touchdown of the day was a 53-yard TD pass from Sellers to Nyck Harbor with 11:14 remaining in the second quarter.
- Harbor has scored a touchdown in the last five games he's played in.
- Harbor is the first Gamecock to have TD receptions in five-straight games in a single season since Alshon Jeffery in 2010.
- Sellers connected with Vandrevius Jacobs for a 74-yard touchdown pass with 5:29 left in the second quarter.
- This marked the longest reception of Jacobs' career (previous was 59 vs. Kentucky)
- This also marked the second longest touchdown pass from Sellers this season (last was 80 yards @ Texas A&M on 11/15/25).
- Jacobs (141) and Habor (115) each finished with 100+ receiving yards on seven and six catches, respectively.
- This marked the first time two players have had 100+ yards receiving since Deebo Samuel (210) and Shi Smith (109) did so at Clemson (11/12/18).
- Seven different Gamecocks caught passes in the Clemson game.
- Jacobs matched a career high seven receptions, a mark that was set earlier this season at Missouri.
- Rahsul Faison led the ground with 37 yards on five carries.

>>> SOUTH CAROLINA DEFENSE NOTES

- Jalon Kilgore picked off Klubnik in the endzone to regain possession at the 3:50 mark of the first quarter.
- This was his eighth career interception, second this season.
- Fred Johnson led the defense with eight total tackles, five solo.
- Jalon Kilgore and Peyton Williams added in seven apiece.
- Bryan Thomas Jr. chipped in two tackles for loss and a forced fumble occurring in the 6:38 mark in the second quarter.
- Williams recorded a sack in the second quarter for a loss of two yards.
