

Perennial Power

Under Dawn Staley, South Carolina women's basketball had been a perennial national power since winning its first SEC title in 2013-14. A few highlights from that stretch.

- 5 straight NCAA Final Four appearances (2021-2025) is the longest active streak and the second-longest streak in tournament history.
- 3 National Championships are third most by a single program in tournament history.
- 10th undefeated National Championship season in NCAA history (2023-24)
- 84 AP No. 1 rankings are third-most by a program in the poll's history.
- 126 straight AP Top-10 rankings is the longest active streak – more than three times the next program
- 11 Gamecocks have earned All-America status at least once in their careers

The Arkansas Series

The Gamecocks lead the all-time series with Arkansas 28-18 behind a 21-4 mark in the Dawn Staley era (beginning in 2008-09). The series is tied 10-10 in games played in Fayetteville.

South Carolina has won the last 10 meetings, including last season's 95-55 decision on Feb. 20, 2025, in Columbia. The Gamecocks' last trip to Fayetteville was on Feb. 29, 2024, when they claimed a 98-61 victory that included 12 points from then-freshman Tessa Johnson on 4-of-5 shooting from 3-point range.

Road Ready

The Gamecocks are 322-263 (.550) all-time in road games (some records prior to 1976-77 did not include location of games), including a 148-48 mark (.755) under head coach Dawn Staley, giving her the best road winning percentage in program history. In SEC road games, the Gamecocks are 102-34 (.750) during Staley's tenure.

Ranked Readings

Against ranked teams, South Carolina is 135-72 (652) in the Dawn Staley era (beginning 2008-09), and even that mark is skewed by the early seasons of her tenure. Since the start of the 2014-15 campaign, the Gamecocks are 120-33 (.784) against ranked teams, including a 50-6 (.893) mark since the start of the 2021-22 season.

This season, South Carolina is 3-1 against ranked opponents with all three games happening outside of Columbia – W 69-52 vs. #8/10 Southern Cal (Nov. 15), L 64-66 vs. #4/4 Texas (Nov. 27), W 79-77 at #22/21 Louisville (Dec. 4), W 83-57 vs. #/24 Alabama (Jan. 1).

Schedule Sketch

South Carolina's schedule continues to challenge and prepare the team for the postseason. This year's slate features 12 games against teams ranked in the current top 25 – five home, five road and two neutral sites. Four of the 10 games are against teams in the top 10.

The non-conference schedule was highlighted by three ranked matchups – vs. #8/10 Southern Cal (W, 69-52), vs. #4/4 Texas (L, 64-66) and at #22/21 Louisville (W, 79-77).

In the NET rankings, South Carolina is ranked third and has 12 Quad 1 games on the schedule, including four non-conference matchups. The Gamecocks lead the SEC in the NET rankings and have the best average opponent NET ranking (18). Their three Quad 1 wins this season are fourth-most in the nation (2nd in SEC).

Ranking Review

South Carolina is currently ranked No. 3 in both the AP Poll and the USA Today/WBCA Coaches' Poll.

It marks the Gamecocks' 126th consecutive entry in the AP top 10, beginning with the 2019-20 preseason poll. It is the longest active streak and the eighth longest in the history of that poll (7th is 137, Baylor). Their 257 straight appearances in the AP Poll, dating back to Dec. 10, 2012, mark the second-longest active streak in the nation and is tied for the sixth longest all-time (5th, Duke/Stanford, 312).

In the USA Today/WBCA Coaches' Poll, South Carolina has been in the top 10 since claiming the No. 10 spot in the 2019-20 preseason poll.

Staley's Standard

In her 26th season as a head coach, Dawn Staley has a .776 (662-191) winning percentage, which ranks ninth in the nation among active head coaches and 10th all-time.

With three national championships, she ranks fourth among head coaches all-time in NCAA titles.

Staley is one of just two women's basketball coaches to lead their teams to multiple 40-game win streaks in NCAA history with the Gamecocks' program-record 43-game streak (2023-24) ranking seventh longest in NCAA history. She is one of just 11 men's or women's basketball coaches all-time to win at least three NCAA National Championships and the first Black head coach to win multiple titles. She is one of seven coaches to lead a team to at least four NCAA National Championship games.

Now in her 18th season with the Gamecocks, Staley is the program's all-time winningest coach (490) with a program-record 14 postseason appearances. She accounts for all seven of the Gamecocks' Final Four appearances and the only NCAA National Championships in program history. Her leadership on the court and in the community resulted in the City of Columbia commissioning a statue of Staley, which stands a short distance from the Gamecocks' home Colonial Life Arena.

Staley's nine SEC regular-season championships trail only Pat Summitt's 16 in league history, and her seven SEC Coach of the Year awards trail Summitt's league record by just one. Staley's 216 SEC regular-season wins are the most among active league coaches and third all-time – behind just Summitt (Tennessee, 306) and Andy Landers (Georgia, 273). She was the second-fastest to the 200-win mark in league history with her 255 games trailing Summitt's mark of 229. Staley's .794 SEC winning percentage (216-56) is second only to Summitt (.874) among coaches in the league more than five seasons. She owns the SEC record for consecutive regular-season conference victories with a 57-game streak that began in the 2021-22 season and ended in 2024-25.

Efficiency Report

A focus for South Carolina on both sides of the ball is efficiency – creating its own and disrupting its opponents'. This season, they are among the best in the nation at both – ranking second in the NCAA in field goal percentage (.527) and fifth in field goal percentage defense (.321).

Individually, three Gamecock starters are among the SEC's top 10 in field goal percentage, including the top two in Madina Okot (611) and Joyce Edwards (609), who rank 11th and 12th in the nation, respectively. Ta'Niya Latson's 51.9 percent accuracy comes in ninth in the SEC.

From 3-point range, the Gamecocks are 19th in the nation with a .373 shooting percentage (3rd in SEC). Tessa Johnson is among the nation's most accurate outside shooters with her SEC-best 45.0 percent accuracy ranking 15th in the nation. Her 2.4 made 3s per game are sixth in the SEC.

Paint Production

South Carolina has long controlled the paint, and this season is no different, even with a guard-dominated roster.

With 56.3 percent of their points coming in the paint, the Gamecocks are second in the nation with 51.3 paint points per game and are out-scoring opponents in that space by an average of 28.9 points, including a +13.5 edge against ranked opponents. They tied the program record for single-game paint points in back-to-back outings with 74 at USF (Dec. 18) and at FGCU (Dec. 20).

The Gamecocks are shooting 63.7 percent in the paint compared to opponents' 41.7 percent accuracy.

Fast Forward

The Gamecocks have been on the move this season, ranking second in the nation with 25.2 fast break points per game. For context, the program record of 18.0 fast break points per game was set in 2023-24, and last season's average was 17.1.

South Carolina's season-high of 56 fast break points against Queens (Nov. 23) were the third-most in program history. The Gamecocks are out-scoring opponents on the break by 18.2 points per game (25.2-7.0).

Block Party

The Gamecocks have been a premier shot blocking program since their first national championship in 2017. They ranked in the top 15 in blocks per game that season and have only climbed higher in the eight subsequent seasons, including four years leading the nation in the stat and twice coming in second. Beyond the number of blocks, their block percentage has led the nation three seasons.

This season, South Carolina is fifth in the nation with 6.6 blocks per game, including 4.3 against ranked opponents and 6.5 per game in SEC play. The Gamecocks have blocked 16.2 percent of opponents' 2-point attempts, which ranks fourth in the nation, per Her Hoop Stats.

Madina Okot tops the individual list with 1.53 blocks per game to rank eighth in the SEC. Joyce Edwards is just behind at 1.5 per game (10th). Gamecock guards have added 2.3 blocks per game to the team's average.

Glass Work

South Carolina is fifth in the nation in rebounding margin (+14.4) and seventh in rebounding average (45.7). They have corralled 43.3 percent of their missed shots for an offensive rebounding percentage that ranks eighth.

Senior Madina Okot is seventh in the nation with 11.5 rebounds per game (2nd in SEC), and her 4.0 offensive rebounds per game are 15th (2nd in SEC). She has been in double figures in rebounds in 12 games.

Sophomore Joyce Edwards is next in line at 6.3 rebounds per game, and four double-digit games. Freshman Agot Makeer leads the guards with 4.27 boards per game after her 10-rebound outing against Providence (Dec. 28).

Quarter Breakdown

South Carolina has been started and finished strong this season with a +9.8 scoring margin in the first quarter and a +10.3 margin in the fourth. The offense has been

most efficient in those two periods as well, shooting 55.9 percent in the first and 54.2 in the fourth. Opponents have been least efficient in the fourth quarter, shooting just 25.4 percent in the final 10 minutes.

Individually, four Gamecocks have scored double digits in a single quarter a combined 14 times – Joyce Edwards (7), Tessa Johnson (2), Ta'Niya Latson (2), Madina Okot (2), Raven Johnson (1). The top single-quarter individual scoring this season is 13 points by Latson in the third and fourth quarters against NC Central (Dec. 4) and Okot in the fourth quarter at FCGU (Dec. 20).

That's So Raven

Senior point guard Raven Johnson has been at the tip of the spear for the Gamecocks on both sides of the ball and has led the team to nothing but winning.

In Johnson's fourth full season, South Carolina is 122-6 (.953) with her in the lineup (missed one game each in the 2022-23 and 2023-24 seasons), including a 37-4 mark (.902) against ranked teams. Her three complete seasons feature three trips to the Final Four, including a National Championship (2024) and runner-up finish (2025), three SEC Regular-Season titles and three SEC Tournament championships in the three full seasons of her career.

Johnson is sixth in program history in career assists (501 – 5th is Sharon Rivers, 507) and fifth in the category for SEC play (173). She owns three of the top seven single-season assist-to-turnover ratios in program history,

digit assist games. She is seventh in the nation and second in the SEC with a 3.5 assist-to-turnover ratio. Her stat stuffing includes a career-best 10.0 points, 4.3 rebounds and 1.6 steals per game. She is shooting 50.4 percent from the field, including 39.0 percent from 3-point range – both career-best numbers. Against ranked opponents, her numbers rise to 12.3 points per game on 57.1 percent shooting, 57.1 percent from 3-point range, and 4.8 rebounds per game.

Johnson has a pair of double-doubles this season in two different ways – 11 points, 11 assists vs. Bowling Green; 14 points, 11 rebounds vs. #8/10 Southern Cal.

Let Us Re-Joyce

Forward Joyce Edwards is backing up a solid freshman season – just the third freshman in program history to earn First-Team All-SEC honors – with a dominating sophomore campaign. Edwards is on the watch lists for every national player of the year award and the Katrina McClain Power Forward of the Year list as well.

Her team-high 21.0 points per game ranks 12th in the nation (3rd) in the SEC, including a team-best nine 20-point outings. Her scoring has come on 60.9 percent field goal shooting, which is also 12th in the nation (2nd in SEC). She has a pair of games shooting over 90.0 percent, including a 14-of-15 (93%) outing at USF (Dec. 18), which tied for the second-highest single-game percentage in program history.

Edwards is stuffing the box score beyond scoring, averaging 2.6 assists, including three outings of at least five, and upping her rebounding to 6.0 per game. She has twice been named SEC Player of the Week (Nov. 11-17 and Dec. 16-22).

It's T-Time

Junior guard Tessa Johnson has shaken off her "Tournament Tessa" moniker to bring "Trusted Tessa" out every time she steps on the court and on both sides of the ball while adapting to a starting role this season.

After an offseason focused on her physical conditioning and how nutrition multiplies that effort, Johnson is logging 30.1 minutes per game and her scoring and efficiency have risen to career-best levels.

Johnson's SEC-best .450 3-point percentage is 15th in the nation as part of her overall 49.0 percent accuracy (13th in SEC). Her 2.4 made 3s per game are sixth in the SEC. She is also averaging a career-best 2.9 assists.

Johnson's 13.4 points per game are fourth on the team, and the mark includes 13.8 points per game against ranked opponents.

Johnson has built steadily year over year, beginning with a freshman year that saw her shine in the most crucial moments of the team's undefeated run to the 2024 National Championship. She averaged 14.0 points on 58.8 percent shooting in the final weekend of the season, including a team-best 19 points in the title game to earn a spot on the NCAA Final Four All-Tournament Team.

Changes in Lat-itude

The top scorer in the nation last season, senior guard Ta'Niya Latson decided to join South Carolina for her final college season because she knew head coach Dawn Staley and the Gamecocks had what she needed to challenge herself to expand areas of her game she was not able to hone at Florida State. Without the pressure of being the sole focal point of an offense, Latson's efficiency has skyrocketed and her defensive skills are steadily expanding.

Named an AP Preseason All-American and to the watch lists of every national player of the year award, Latson improved her strength in the offseason, which has helped her make strides defensively, and she is seeing the court better on offense.

Latson is 11th in the SEC in scoring at 16.9 points per game and ninth in field goal percentage, hitting 51.9 percent, including 41.7 percent from 3-point range. Her 4.0 assists per game (13th in SEC) have led to another 9.2 points per game, meaning she has her hands on 28.1 percent of the Gamecocks' total offense (26.1 ppg).

M.O.-mentum

After just starting the sport at 17 years old, 6-foot-6 center Madina Okot is becoming one of the most dominant centers in the sport. Last season at Mississippi State, she was the SEC's top percentage shooter (.649) and fourth in rebounding. With her final year of eligibility, she came to Columbia with the mindset to be the next entry in the Gamecocks' legacy of dominant post players.

The quiet Okot has drawn praise from her head coach on her strength and agility and been challenged to show her dominance every time she steps on the court. After an average season opener, Okot has been rising to that challenge, and both her production and her comfort level have been growing exponentially.

Okot is among the nation's top 15 in four stats – double-doubles (2nd, 11), rebounds per game (7th, 11.5), field goal percentage (11th, .611) and offensive rebounds per game (15th, 4.0). Her field goal percentage leads the SEC and her 1.53 blocks per game come in eighth.

Mighty Mouse

Sophomore point guard Maddy McDaniel, whose nickname is Mouse, is a spark of energy and speed off the bench. She has started to string together solid performances in practices and games as the Gamecocks start SEC play.

Through the first two league games of the season, McDaniel is averaging 6.0 points and 3.5 assists per game, playing 29.6 minutes per outing. Her assist average is 13th in the conference, and her 2.33 assist-to-turnover ratio in SEC play is sixth.

A-got Send

Freshman guard Agot Makeer was ranked sixth in the Class of 2025 and drew McDonald's All-America and honorable mention Naismith All-America honors out of Montverde Academy (FL). She opened her college career on the USWBA Tamika Catchings Freshman of the Year and the Wooden Award watch lists.

The long, lithe Makeer is averaging 6.5 points to go along with 4.3 rebounds per game. She earned her first career starts in her first two SEC games and responded with 7.0 points per game on 45.5 percent shooting, including 3-of-5 from 3-point range. She capped 2025 with her first career double-double with 10 points and 10 boards in just 23 minutes against Providence (Dec. 28).

The Ay-las Have It

The #15 player in the 2025 Class, freshman guard Ayla McDowell is a McDonald's All-American and a three-time district MVP out of Cypress, Texas, who's international experience with Brazil's national team has helped smooth her transition to college basketball.

Coaches have praised her competitive fire and her predictability on the defensive end, meaning she is trusted to make the right play. On the other end of the court, McDowell is finding her spots in the flow of the offense, learning when to shoot and when to defer.

McDowell is scoring 4.8 points per game and hitting 76.2 percent of her free throws.

Le Tour de France

Freshman Alicia Tournebize arrived in Columbia on New Year's Day to bolster the Gamecocks' frontcourt. The 6-foot-7 forward is France's first documented woman to dunk in a game who has gone on to do it as part of her professional and international teams, including a two-handed effort against Belgium in the 2025 FIBA U18 EuroBasket.

SEASON THEME: BEYOND MEASURE

Each year Dawn Staley chooses a theme for the team and fans to center their season around, and it often reflects not just the state of South Carolina women's basketball, but that of the game overall.

The Gamecocks' 2025-26 season theme is Beyond Measure, which centers on the value of the whole person or group beyond the commonly measured scale. A player's value to the team is not measured solely by her statline but also by a myriad of other ways she elevates her team. Championships and awards are not valued because they yield a trophy but also because they lift up a university, a city, a state. The value of the FAMs who support the team around the country is more than the value of ticket sales, but it is in the way they form a united community that supersedes all their difference.

More broadly, Beyond Measure is a reminder that the ceiling of the team and its players – and that of women's basketball as a sport – will always shatter any limitations others may place on it.

Tournebize helped France to third place at that tournament, leading the team in scoring (12.1 ppg) and rebounding (8.9 rpg), both of which ranked in the tournament's top 10 and helped her claim a spot on the All-Star 5. She was also part of the French team that took fourth at the 2024 FIBA U17 World Cup.

Basketball is in Tournebize's DNA as her mother, Isabelle Fijalkowski, played at Colorado and in the WNBA along with her decorated international career. She is in the French Basketball Academy Hall of Fame (2011) and the FIBA Hall of Fame (2020) and is set to be inducted into the Women's Basketball Hall of Fame as part of the 2026 Class.

Everybody's All-American

The Gamecocks' 11-woman roster includes eight McDonald's All-Americans – Maryam Dauda, Joyce Edwards, Raven Johnson, Tessa Johnson, TaNiya Latson, Agot Makeer, Maddy McDaniel and Ayla McDowell.

At South Carolina, Staley has coached 29 McDonald's All-Americans, including 22 who signed as freshmen.

What's Next

Just as the 2025-26 season began, event organizers were already releasing plans for the Gamecocks' 2026-27 season. South Carolina will be making its second appearance at all four events.

The Gamecocks will return to Paris for Oui Play 2026, facing Maryland in the season opener on Nov. 2. The return game of the Sprouts Farmers Market The Real SC game is set for Bon Secours Wellness Arena in Greenville, S.C., on Nov. 15. The Gamecocks are slated to take on UConn in the 2026 Basketball Hall of Fame Women's Showcase on Nov. 24. And the Charlotte Sports Foundation announced South Carolina's three-year commitment to the Ally Tipoff with games against North Carolina (2026), UConn (2027) and NC State (2028).

Who's Next

Head coach Dawn Staley signed a pair of top-20 players in the early signing period in forwards Kelsi Andrews and Kaeli Wynn. Both are on the Naismith Trophy Girls' High School Player of the Year watch list, released in November.

The 6-foot-3 Andrews is the #18 player in the Class of 2026 after helping lead IMG Academy to a high school national championship in 2025 with a 12-point, 13-rebound performance in the title game. She has also helped the U.S. to gold medals in the 2024 FIBA U17 World Cup and the 2023 FIBA U16 Americas Championship.

Wynn is the #17 player in the 2026 Class, standing

6-foot-2 and coming from basketball coach parents. She was a first-team all-state selection as a junior, averaging 17 points, 7.1 rebounds and 2.7 assists at Mater Dei High School, which was ranked No. 1 in the nation throughout the season.

WNBA Pipeline

Dawn Staley's status as a dream merchant is most evident by the steady stream of Gamecocks being drafted into and enjoying lengthy careers in the WNBA. Since her first Gamecock was drafted in 2015, she has seen 18 have their name called on draft night – the second-most by a program in that time.

Staley's numbers have skyrocketed since 2020 with an NCAA-best 12 draft picks since then, including a best-in-the-nation six first-round selections in that time.

In proof Staley sends players to the league ready, six Gamecocks have earned All-Rookie Team honors, including three WNBA Rookies of the Year – Allisha Gray (2017), A'ja Wilson (2018), Aliyah Boston (2023).

Great Gamecock Fans

South Carolina fans have led the nation in average attendance for the last 11 seasons, although the NCAA does not officially recognize the COVID-limited attendance in the 2020-21 season. The Gamecocks are on track to continue that streak after selling out of season tickets for the second time in as many seasons and hosting eight of the 10 highest-attended games of the season to average 15,621 fans per game.

The Gamecocks have had at least one sellout of their 18,000-seat Colonial Life Arena for eight straight seasons (excluding COVID-limited 2020-21 season) dating back to the first ever sellout of 18,000 on Feb. 8, 2016. There have been at least five sellouts in each of the last two seasons.

South Carolina's 2024-25 attendance average of 16,437 was the second-highest in the history of the NCAA, narrowly trailing Tennessee's 1998-99 average of 16,565. That mark included a program-record seven sellouts.

**18th Season at South Carolina
26th Season in Career**

Since thrusting South Carolina into the national spotlight when she was hired in May 2008, Dawn Staley has made the Gamecocks a mainstay in the battle for SEC and national championships. The Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame inductee as a player is angling for another induction as a coach with her standing as one of five head coaches with at least three women's basketball National Championships and the only Black basketball head coach with multiple national titles, one of five head coaches to lead an undefeated team to a National Championship, and the first Black head coach of the USA Basketball Senior National Team.

In Staley's 17 seasons at the helm of the Gamecocks, highlights include:

- Three National Championships (2017, 2022, 2024)
- Seven NCAA Final Fours in the last 10 tournaments (2015, 2017, 2021, 2022, 2023, 2024, 2025)
- Ranking in the AP Top 25 every week since Dec. 10, 2012, the second-longest active streak in the nation and sixth-longest all-time (257)
- 38 straight weeks at No. 1 in the AP Poll, just the third program to go wire-to-wire in back-to-back seasons
- 86 total weeks at No. 1 in the AP Poll, the third-most in the history of that poll
- Eight 30-win seasons, including a program-record 38 wins in 2023-24
- Nine SEC regular-season championships (2014, 2015, 2016, 2017, 2020, 2022, 2023, 2024, 2025)
- Nine SEC Tournament titles (2015, 2016, 2017, 2018, 2020, 2021, 2023, 2024, 2025)
- SEC-record 57 consecutive league regular-season victories, which ranks sixth in NCAA history for conference win streaks

While her coaching career is in full bloom, Staley is still recognized for her body of work as a one of the most decorated participants in United States women's basketball history. The Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame solidified that legacy with her enshrinement as part of the Class of 2013. The Phoenix Club of Philadelphia established the Dawn Staley Award recognizing the nation's top guard in women's Division I basketball in 2013 as well. Staley was inducted into the Women's Basketball Hall of Fame as part of the Class of 2012, and she was part of the FIBA Hall of Fame Class of 2025.

In her 26th season as a head coach, Staley has led her college teams to 15 25-win seasons, a total of 21 postseason appearances (two WNIT) and 216 weeks in the Associated Press top 10, including 86 in the No. 1 spot – the third most times in the top spot in the history of that poll. Her .776 winning percentage (662-191) ranks ninth in the nation among active head coaches and 10th all-time.

Also a force in USA Basketball, Staley was named the U.S. Women's National Team head coach for 2017-21, leading the U.S. to 2018 FIBA World Cup gold to earn USAB National Coach of the Year honors that year, adding gold medals at the 2019 and 2021 FIBA AmeriCups and stretching the U.S. Olympic gold medal streak to seven straight at the 2020 Tokyo Olympic Games, for which she again earned Coach of the Year honors. Prior to that appointment, Staley led three other U.S. teams to gold medals – 2015 FIBA U19 World Championships, 2014 FIBA U18 Americas Championship, 2007 Pan Am Games – and served as an assistant on the Senior National Team 2006-08 and again 2014-16, during which the U.S. claimed gold in the 2014 FIBA World Championship and the 2008 and 2016 Olympics.

In her 19th season at the helm of the Gamecocks, Staley has been named National Coach of the Year five times (2014, 2020, 2022, 2023, 2024). Her 2020 unanimous selection made her the first former Naismith Player of the Year to earn the Naismith Coach of the Year award, and she became the first men's or women's coach to claim the award in three straight seasons 2022-24. She is a seven-time SEC Coach of the Year and was the 2012 BCA Female Coach of the Year. She is the only Gamecock basketball coach – men's or women's – to amass 300 victories at South Carolina and became the fastest coach to 200 wins in program history, needing just 277 games at South Carolina to reach the plateau. She is the program's all-time winningest coach with 490 wins, a .815 (490-111) winning percentage and a program-record 14 postseason appearances.

In the vaunted SEC, Staley's 216 league wins are the most among active league coaches and third all-time, trailing just Women's Basketball Hall of Fame Inductees Andy Landers (Georgia, 273) and Pat Summitt (Tennessee, 306). She was the second fastest to 200 league wins (255 games), trailing only Summitt at 229. Her .794 SEC winning percentage (216-56) is second only to Summitt (.874) in league history. Her Gamecocks are the only SEC program with multiple 16-0 seasons in league history, hitting that mark four times (2015-16, 2019-20, 2022-23, 2023-24). Staley's back-to-back SEC undefeated seasons helped the Gamecocks to an SEC-record 57-game win streak in league play, which ranks sixth in NCAA history for conference win streaks.

In addition to coaching two National Players of the Year, two National Defensive Players of the Year and a National Freshman of the Year, Staley has helped 13 Gamecocks collect 29 All-America selections, three to pick up seven SEC Player of the Year honors, four to earn SEC Defensive Player of the Year recognition a total of eight times, three to SEC 6th Player of the Year honors and six to capture SEC Freshman of the Year. She has coached 23 Gamecocks to All-SEC honors a combined 44 times, including 22 first-team selections. Since her first Gamecock was selected in the 2015 WNBA Draft, a total of 18 South Carolina have been chosen, which is the second-most of any program in that timeframe. Of those 18, 11 have been first-round picks, highlighted by two No. 1 overall picks since 2018. Three Gamecocks have been named WNBA Rookie of the Year and have amassed 13 All-Star selections. A'ja Wilson went on to become a three-time WNBA MVP and two-time WNBA Defensive Player of the Year.
