NOTABLES

• **MILLER EARNS 500TH CAREER WIN:** Sean Miller recorded his 500th career victory as a collegiate head coach with Saturday's win at Oklahoma. Miller enters Tuesday's contest with an on-court career record of 500-205 (.709) in 21 seasons.

• **SWAIN ON A DIFFERENT LEVEL:** Over his last four games, junior G/F Dailyn Swain has averaged 25.8 points, 7.3 rebounds, 3.8 assists and 2.5 steals in 37.1 minutes per contest. He has converted 64.9-percent (37-57) from the floor, including a 44.4-percent (8-18) mark from three-point range, and 87.5-percent (21-24) from the free throw line in this stretch.

• **HEIDE HEATS UP:** Junior F Camden Heide has averaged 15.0 ppg while hitting 84.6-percent (11-13) from the floor, including an 80-percent (8-10) mark from three-point range, in 29.6 mpg over his last two contests. Heide had 13 points (5-6 FG, 3-4 threes) in 22 minutes during Saturday's win at Oklahoma.

SOUTH CAROLINA SERIES INFO

- Tuesday's contest marks just the **fourth** meeting between Texas and South Carolina.
- The Gamecocks hold a **2-1** lead in the all-time series entering Tuesday's game.
- In the first matchup between the two schools (Dec. 23, 1980), South Carolina posted a 74-70 victory in Columbia.
- In the **most recent meeting in Austin (Jan. 23, 1982)**, then-No. 7 Texas claimed an 88-71 home victory in the Frank Erwin Center.
- In last year's matchup in Columbia (Feb. 22, 2025), the Gamecocks earned an 84-69 win.

BLESS THE MOOD, YEAR FOUR

- Texas is **50-15 (.769)** all-time in games played in Moody Center, including a **9-3** mark this season.
- UT is **5-4** all-time against AP Top 10 foes and **12-6** against AP Top 25 opponents in Moody Center. The Horns are 1-0 this year against AP Top 10 opponents and 2-0 this season against AP Top 25 foes in games played in Moody Center.
- Texas is **32-2** in non-conference games in Moody Center.
- The Longhorns have averaged **10,811** fans per game during the arena's first **65** games. Moody Center's official capacity is 10,763, but there is a standing-room only area in the upper concourse for UT students used as overflow for the Corral.
- The \$375 million world-class arena opened for concerts in April 2022.
- Moody Center is named in honor of a \$130 million grant to The University of Texas at Austin from the Moody Foundation, the single-largest gift from a foundation in the university's history. The Moody Foundation has supported museums, libraries, universities and hospitals throughout the state of Texas for over 75 years.

THE CORRAL

- Prior to the 2022-23 season, UT Athletics and Matthew McConaughey joined forces to launch the new official student section for Texas Men's Basketball, **the Corral**.
- UT students get the best seats for games at Moody Center, 270-degrees around the court. The seating capacity for the Corral is 1,000.
- There is also an overflow standing-room only section (the Upper Corral) in the upper concourse that can fit approximately 550 students.

HOME SUCCESS

- The Longhorns are off to a **9-3** start in **home** games in the Sean Miller era.
- Texas sports a **+18.6** (87.3-68.8) scoring margin and a **+10.6** (41.6-31.0) rebound margin in those 12 contests.

OKLAHOMA RECAP

- Texas has now claimed road wins in EACH of its last seven trips to Norman.
- Overall, the Longhorns have won nine of the last 10 and 29 of the last 42 meetings in the series.
- Texas trailed by as much as 14 points (23-9) at the 9:38 mark of the first half. The 14-point comeback marked the largest deficit that the Longhorns have overcome in the 2025-26 season (previous: trailed Georgia by nine points at the 0:37 mark of the first half).
- The Longhorns also faced a 61-55 deficit with 8:37 remaining in the contest. From that point on, Texas closed the game on a 24-8 run.
- UT converted 60.0-percent (30-50) from the floor. That marked Texas' top FG-percentages mark in SEC play this season and second highest of the year (65.8 vs. Chaminade).
- Five different Texas players reached double figures in scoring.
- The Longhorns committed a season-low 11 fouls during the victory.
- Texas posted a plus-4 (32-28) rebound margin and has now outrebounded 19 of its first 22 opponents this year.
- The Longhorns tallied a 42-28 advantage in points in the paint.
- During the second half, Texas posted a 49-36 scoring margin. The Longhorns hit 72.0-percent (18-25) from the floor, including a 6-of-11 (.545) mark from three-point range, and 7-of-9 (.778) from the free throw line in the final 20 minutes. UT limited Oklahoma to 38.2-percent (13-34) from the floor, including a 4-of-15 (.267) mark from three-point range, in the second half.
- **Camden Heide** reached double figures in scoring (13 points) for the seventh time this year (21 games) and 14th time in his career (96 games). Heide hit 5-of-6 field goals, including 3-of-4 from three-point range, in 22 minutes.
- **Jordan Pope** reached double figures in scoring (12 points) for the 17th time this year (22 games) and 88th time in his career (121 games). He registered 10 of his 12 points in the second half.
- **Dailyn Swain** recorded a double-double (18 points, 10 rebounds) for the fourth time this season (22 games) and seventh time in his career (85 games). He added a game-high six assists and three steals in 37 minutes. Swain reached double figures in scoring for the 20th time this year and 45th time in his career. He reached double digits in rebounds for the fourth time this season and seventh time in his career. In 17:57 of action in the second half, Swain posted 13 points (4-5 FG, 5-5 FT), four boards, two assists and two steals.
- **Matas Vokietaitis** reached double figures in scoring (14 points) for the 18th time this year (22 games) and 36th time in his career (56 games). He tied his career high in assists (2).
- **Simeon Wilcher** reached double figures in scoring (10 points) for the eighth time this year (22 games) and 22nd time in his career (86 games). He tied his season high in field goals made (4-7).

STACKING RANKED WINS

- Texas has posted a **4-3** mark this season against AP Top 25 opponents, including **wins in each of its last three games** against ranked foes.
- The Longhorns have recorded victories over No. 23 NC State (neutral site), No. 13 Alabama (road), No. 10 Vanderbilt (home) and No. 21 Georgia (home).
- Texas earned a 92-88 win at No. 13/12 Alabama (Jan. 10) before claiming an 80-64 victory over No. 10/8 Vanderbilt (Jan. 14) in Austin.
- This marked the first time the Longhorns had recorded **back-to-back wins in consecutive games against AP Top 15 opponents** since Jan. 30-Feb. 4, 2023. Texas earned a 76-71 home win over No. 11/11 Baylor (Jan. 30, 2023) and followed with a 69-66 victory at No. 7/6 Kansas State (Feb. 4, 2023).

THE DEBUT SEASON OF THE SEAN MILLER ERA

- **Sean Miller** was named the **27th** head coach in Men's Basketball program history at The University of Texas on March 24, 2025.
- A proven and consistent winner with **21** years of experience as a head coach at Xavier University, the University of Arizona and now at The University of Texas, Miller has posted a career record of **500-205 (.709)** and helped his teams claim **eight** regular-season conference titles and **four** conference tournament championships.
- He has guided teams to **13** NCAA Tournament appearances, including **four** trips to the Elite Eight and **eight** to the Sweet 16. Miller has compiled a **22-13 (.629)** record in NCAA Tournament contests, including a 13-7 mark at Arizona and 9-6 at Xavier.
- Miller's **.709** career winning percentage ranks **SEVENTH among active head coaches** with a **minimum of 10 full years** as a Division I head coach. His **22** career NCAA Tournament wins rank **10th** among active coaches.
- Miller ranks second only to current Arkansas coach John Calipari in the **number of NBA players produced over the last 20 seasons**. Miller has developed 27 players whom he signed and/or coached that have seen action in the NBA. Of those 27 individuals, **12** were selected in the first round of the NBA Draft including **six lottery picks**. His list of lottery picks include: Deandre Ayton (No. 1 pick in 2018), Derrick Williams (No. 2 pick in 2011) and Aaron Gordon (No. 4 pick in 2014).
- Miller currently has **10 active players in the NBA** entering the 2025-26 season: Deandre Ayton (Los Angeles Lakers), Aaron Gordon (Denver Nuggets), Josh Green (Charlotte Hornets), Colby Jones (Detroit Pistons), Christian Koloko (Los Angeles Lakers), Lauri Markkanen (Utah Jazz), Bennedict Mathurin (Indiana Pacers), T.J. McConnell (Indiana Pacers), Zeke Nnaji (Denver Nuggets) and Dalen Terry (Chicago Bulls).
- Miller spent the last three seasons (2022-25) in his second stint as the head coach at Xavier. He previously served as head coach at Xavier for five years (2004-09). During his eight total seasons with the Musketeers, Miller compiled an overall record of **185-87 (.680)**. He led Xavier to six NCAA Tournament appearances, including three trips to the Sweet 16 (2008, 2009 and 2023) and one to the Elite Eight (2008).

- Miller served for 12 seasons (2009-21) as head coach at Arizona and registered a **302-109 (.735)** mark. He guided the Wildcats to seven NCAA Tournament appearances, including five trips to the Sweet 16 (2011, 2013, 2014, 2015 and 2017) and three to the Elite Eight (2011, 2014 and 2015).
- Since becoming a collegiate head coach in 2004, **EVERY** player that Miller coached who has exhausted his eligibility has gone on to graduate. Through the completion of the 2024-25 academic calendar year, that number has grown to **59** graduates, including 27 from Xavier and 32 from Arizona.

GETTING OFFENSIVE

- Known more for his teams' hard-nosed, defensive prowess during his first stint at Xavier and throughout his tenure at Arizona, **Sean Miller** implemented an offensive identity in his second stint at Xavier that emphasized pace, tempo, ball movement and spacing.
- During Texas' first 22 games this season, the Longhorns have averaged **85.5 ppg** while converting **49.5-percent** from the floor.
- According to KenPom (through games of Feb. 1), UT ranks **8th nationally in offensive efficiency** at 126.1.
- The 85.5 ppg marks the **highest scoring average for Texas** since the **1994-95** squad averaged 92.9 ppg. It also marks the first time the Longhorns have averaged **over 80 ppg since the 2009-10 team** averaged 81.2 ppg.
- UT's 49.5-percent FG shooting marks the **highest FG percentage** since the 1984-85 team hit 50.7-percent from the floor. The last Texas team to shoot at least 48-percent from the floor over a season was in 1994-95 (48.0).
- UT has posted a combined **339-193** margin in **fast-break points** against its opponents this season.

- The **119** points scored vs. Chaminade (Nov. 25) marked a tie for the ninth-highest single-game total in UT program history. The **65.8**-percent FG shooting against Chaminade marked the fourth-highest single-game FG percentage in program history (since 1961-62) and highest since UT converted 66.7-percent (28-42) at Arkansas on Jan. 24, 1983. The **48 field goals made** marked the fourth-highest single-game total in program history (since 1932-33) and most since UT made 49 against Miami (Fla.) on Feb. 22, 1989.
- In the **102-97 win over No. 23/22 NC State** (Nov. 26) in Maui, the Longhorns hit 55.8-percent (29-52) from the floor, including a 50-percent (16-32) from three-point range, and 84.8-percent (28-33) from the free throw line. Texas had 18 assists against seven turnovers and posted a 24-7 advantage in fast-break points.
- Last year at Xavier (2024-25), the Musketeers led the BIG EAST and ranked ninth nationally in fastbreak points (15.2 ppg) and were second in the league and sixth nationally in free throw percentage (.794). Xavier also ranked second in the BIG EAST and seventh nationally in 3-point percentage (.388) and third in the league and 15th nationally in assists per game (16.9 apg).
- During Miller's first year back at Xavier in 2022-23, the Musketeers led the nation in assists per game (19.1 apg) and ranked in the top 10 nationally in scoring offense (10th at 80.9 ppg), field goal percentage (seventh at .492) and 3-point percentage (fifth at .390).

TOPPING THE CENTURY MARK

- Texas topped the century mark for the first time in the Sean Miller era with its **119-78** win over Chaminade (Nov. 25).
- The Longhorns surpassed the mark for the second-straight night and 117th time in program history in their **102-97** victory against No. 23/22 NC State (Nov. 26).
- Texas topped the **100-point mark in back-to-back games** for the first time since the 2009-10 season, when the Longhorns posted a 104-42 home win over UT-Pan American (Dec. 15, 2009) and followed with a 103-90 victory against No. 10 North Carolina in Arlington, Texas (Dec. 19, 2009).

GETTING TO THE LINE

- Texas is averaging **26.6** free throw attempts and **21.8** fouls drawn per game in its first 22 contests.
- According to KenPom (through games of Feb. 1), UT ranks **5th nationally in Free Throw Rate** (how often a team gets to the line relative to shots taken) at 46.6. George Mason is first at 48.2.
- In the second half against UMES (Dec. 22), the Longhorns converted 25-of-**33** from the free throw line. The **33 attempts** were just one shy of tying the school record (dating back to 1965-66) for most free throws attempted in a half.
- Texas went 29-of-**40** from the free throw line in the home overtime loss to Mississippi State (Jan. 3).

CLEANING THE GLASS

- Texas has registered a **+8.9** rebound margin (39.4-30.5) this season and has outrebounded **19 of its first 22** opponents.
- According to KenPom (through games of Feb. 1), UT ranks **22nd** nationally in **offensive rebounding percentage** (37.1).
- The Longhorns have reached **double figures in offensive rebounds** in 17 of their first 22 games, including 18 in the season opener against No. 6/5 Duke (Nov. 4), 18 at No. 13/12 Alabama (Jan. 10), 15 at No. 21/22 Tennessee (Jan. 6), 13 at No. 5/5 UConn (Dec. 12) and 13 at Kentucky (Jan. 21).
- Texas **tied a program record** for highest rebound margin in a game with a **plus-39** margin (59-20) in the win over Chaminade (Nov. 25). This equaled the plus-39 mark (54-15) set against Samford on Nov. 16, 2005.

BREAKING DOWN THE 2025-26 ROSTER

- Texas retained three core rotational players from last year's roster in graduate G **Tramon Mark**, senior G **Jordan Pope** and senior G **Chendall Weaver**. Both Mark (1,791 points) and Pope (1,633 points) have surpassed the **1,600**-career point mark. **That trio by itself has combined career totals of 4,213 points in 387 games played (273 starts).**
- The Longhorns also returned sophomore F **Nic Codie** along with redshirt freshman G **Antho McDermott** and graduate F **Cole Bott** from last year's squad.
- The Texas staff added five newcomers from the Division I portal in the spring. Those players include junior F **Camden Heide** (Purdue), junior G/F **Dailyn Swain** (Xavier), graduate F **Lassina Traore** (Xavier), sophomore C **Matas Vokietaitis** (FAU) and junior G **Simeon Wilcher** (St. John's). Four of the five transfers have **multiple years** of eligibility remaining.
- The Longhorns completed the roster with three incoming freshmen (F **Declan Duru Jr.**, F **John Clark** and C **Lewis Obiorah**) along with graduate transfer G **Brandon Taylor**.
- The 2025-26 Texas roster includes four international players: Declan Duru Jr. (Germany), Lewis Obiorah (England), Lassina Traore (Ivory Coast) and Matas Vokietaitis (Lithuania). This marks the **most number of international players** on a single roster in program history.
- The **11** players who brought previous collegiate experience to this year's roster have combined career totals of **890** games played (**498** starts).

SAY HELLO TO DAILYN SWAIN

Junior G/F **Dailyn Swain** (first name pronounced: DAY-lin) has played in **85** career games (**58** starts) during his three years at Xavier (2023-25) and now at Texas. He owns collegiate totals of **891** points, **432** rebounds, **200** assists and **123** steals. Swain has converted **53.7**-percent (325-605) from the floor and **79.9**-percent (211-264) from the free throw line in his career. He has reached double figures in scoring **45** times, including **seven** 20-point efforts and **two** 30-point performances, and double digits in rebounds **seven** times while recording **seven** career double-doubles.

- During UT's first 22 games (22 starts) this season, Swain **leads the team in scoring (17.5 ppg), rebounding (7.2 rpg), assists (7.5, 3.4 apg), steals (4.0, 1.8 spg) and minutes (30.9 mpg)** while hitting **57.9**-percent (140-242) from the floor.
- He has reached double digits in scoring in **20** of the first 22 games, topped the 20-point mark **six** times, hit the 30-point mark **twice** and posted **four** double-doubles.
- **In SEC play**, Swain is averaging **21.2 ppg**, 7.7 rpg, 3.3 apg and 1.9 spg in 33.5 mpg while hitting 60.0-percent (66-110) from the floor. He has topped the 20-point mark **four** times and the 30-point mark **twice** while posting two double-doubles in his first nine league games. In league play, Swain ranks third in scoring, sixth in rebounding, second in FG percentage, third in defensive rebounds (6.1 rpg) and tied for fourth in steals (1.89 spg).
- He tallied 18 points (5-9 FG, 8-9 FT), a game-high 10 boards, a game-high six assists and three steals in 37 minutes at Oklahoma (Jan. 31).
- Swain registered **30 points** (10-16 FG, **career-best 4-7 threes**, 6-7 FT), seven rebounds and four assists in 37 minutes at Auburn (Jan. 28).
- He posted 26 points (**career-best 12-16 FG**, 2-4 threes), six boards, a **season-high five steals** (one shy of career high) and two assists in a **career-best 39 minutes** in the home win over No. 21/22 Georgia (Jan. 24).

SWAIN IS A TWO-WAY PLAYER

- **Dailyn Swain** is quickly emerging as one of the top two-way players in the SEC this season.
- In league play, he is third in **defensive rebounds** per game (6.11 rpg) and tied for fourth in **steals** (1.89 spg).

Graduate G **Tramon Mark** (first name pronounced: truh-Mon) has played in **158** career games (**116** starts) during his six years at Texas (2024-present), Arkansas (2023-24) and Houston (2020-23). He received a medical redshirt for the 2021-22 season while at Houston. Mark owns collegiate career totals of **1,791** points, **606** rebounds, **293** assists and **162** steals. He has reached double figures in scoring **88** times, topped the 20-point mark **23** times and hit the 30-point mark **twice** in his career. Mark has reached double digits in rebounds **once** and recorded **one** career double-double. He earned his undergraduate degree from Arkansas in Summer 2024.

MARK'S HISTORY OF GAME-WINNING BUCKETS

Tramon Mark is no stranger to making game-winning shots during his collegiate career. Per research from Tom Hart (ESPN/SEC Network), Mark has made **FOUR game-winning baskets** while in college.

- During his freshman season at Houston, Mark banked in a three-pointer from just inside half-court at the buzzer to lift the Cougars to a 67-64 home win over Memphis (March 7, 2021).
- Two weeks later, Mark converted a three-point play with 24 seconds left that proved to be the game-winning basket in Houston's 63-60 victory against Rutgers in the NCAA Tournament Round of 32 (March 21, 2021).
- While at Arkansas in the 2023-24 season, Mark knocked down a pull-up jumper with 1.1 seconds remaining to lift the Razorbacks to a 78-77 home win over Texas A&M (Jan. 16, 2024).
- Mark also converted a high-floating layup from just outside the paint with 3.7 seconds left to lead Texas to a 70-69 home win against No. 13/13 Texas A&M (Jan. 25).

- During UT's first 22 games (one start) this season, Weaver ranks fourth on the team in rebounding (4.7 rpg) and steals (16) and seventh in scoring (6.6 ppg) in 21.9 mpg.
- He **tied his season high with four assists without a turnover** and added four points, two boards, one block and one steal in 22 minutes during the home win over No. 21/22 Georgia (Jan. 24).
- Weaver registered 14 points (6-9 FG, 2-2 FT) and three rebounds in 29 minutes at Kentucky (Jan. 17).
- He tallied a **season-best nine rebounds** (five offensive) to go along with six points and two steals in 23 minutes during the home win over No. 10/8 Vanderbilt (Jan. 14).
- Weaver posted a **season-high 17 points** (4-8 FG, 3-5 threes, 6-7 FT), eight rebounds and three assists without a turnover in 32 minutes during the win over No. 23/22 NC State (Nov. 26). In 17:20 of action in the second half, he had 13 points (3-7 FG, 3-5 threes, 4-4 FT).
- He recorded 15 points (5-9 FG, 5-6 FT) and eight rebounds (four offensive) in 24 minutes against Lafayette (Nov. 8).

TRAORE BACK ON THE COURT

Graduate F **Lassina Traore** (pronounced: luh-SEE-nuh trah-OAR-ee) has played in **109** career games (**68** starts) at Texas (2025-26), Long Beach State (2022-24) and Saint Louis (2021-22). He received a medical redshirt for the 2024-25 season while at Xavier. Originally from Abidjan, Ivory Coast, Traore has registered career totals of **963** points and **879** rebounds. He has converted **52.9**-percent (367-694) from the floor in his career. Traore has reached double figures in scoring **48** times and double digits in rebounds **41** times while recording **33** career double-doubles. He earned his undergraduate degree from Xavier in Summer 2025.

- During UT's first 22 games (one start) this season, he ranks third on the team in rebounding (5.2 rpg) while playing 15.6 mpg.
- Traore has reached double figures in rebounds **three** times and double digits in scoring once while posting one double-double this year.
- He tallied seven points (2-3 FG, 3-5 FT), eight boards (five offensive) and two blocks in 22 minutes during the win at No. 13/12 Alabama (Jan. 10).
- Traore grabbed a **game-high 11 rebounds** (six offensive) and added eight points in 19 minutes against Le Moyne (Dec. 16).
- He **tied his career high with three steals** while posting a game-high seven rebounds in 25 minutes at No. 5/5 UConn (Dec. 12).
- Traore posted a **season-high 14 rebounds** to go along with nine points (4-5 FG) in just 14 minutes against Chaminade (Nov. 25).
- He recorded his **first double-double as a Longhorn** with 10 points (4-6 FG) and a game-high 12 boards (five offensive) in 23 minutes against Kansas City (Nov. 15).

- Traore pulled down a game-high 10 rebounds (three offensive) and added five points in 18 minutes against FDU (Nov. 12).
- He registered a team-best nine rebounds (three offensive) to go along with five points, two steals and one assist in 18 minutes against No. 6/5 Duke (Nov. 4). This marked his **first game action since March 21, 2024** while playing for Long Beach State in a NCAA Tournament Round of 64 contest against Arizona.
- Traore spent last year at Xavier. He suffered a knee injury in October and missed the entire season after undergoing surgery on Oct. 21.

CODIE MAKING GAINS

Sophomore F **Nic Codie** returns for his second season at Texas. He has played in **30** career games (**4** starts) and registered 81 points and 50 rebounds.

- During his first 11 games (four starts) this season, Codie is sixth on the team in rebounding (2.9 rpg) and eighth in scoring (4.5 ppg) in 13.3 mpg while converting 47.4-percent (18-38) from the floor.
- He had a **season-high nine points** (4-4 FG) and four boards in just nine minutes against Chaminade (Nov. 25).
- Codie recorded a **career-best eight rebounds** (five offensive) to go along with eight points (career-high 4-6 FT), two assists, one block and one steal in 20 minutes against FDU (Nov. 12).
- He earned his **first collegiate start** and posted four points, four rebounds (all offensive) and one block in a career-best 23 minutes against No. 6/5 Duke (Nov. 4).
- Codie entered the summer weighing 202 pounds but has gained nearly 20 pounds of good weight and muscle and was at 220 pounds entering the 2025-26 season.

THE DEVELOPMENT OF DURU

Freshman F **Declan Duru** (pronounced: DECK-lun DOO-roo) is originally from Munich, Germany. He spent the last five years with Real Madrid (Spain) in the program's youth development system. Duru joined the Longhorn program at the start of the Fall 2025 semester.

- He has played in 11 games this season and averaged 1.4 ppg and 1.3 rpg while posting five steals in 7.4 mpg.
- Duru helped his native Germany earn a silver medal at the 2025 FIBA U19 World Cup in Lausanne, Switzerland (June 28-July 6). He reached double figures in scoring in six of the seven games and averaged 11.4 ppg and 5.1 rpg in 26.8 mpg while converting 52.4-percent (22-42) from the floor.
- Duru played for Real Madrid B and the Real Madrid U19 team last season.

THE FALL SIGNING CLASS

- Four high school prospects each signed an Athletic Scholarship Agreement (ASA) during the fall signing period to play next season at Texas.
- The four-person class is currently ranked **No. 6** nationally by 247 Sports and **No. 7** by On3.
- **Austin Goosby** (6-5, 175), a guard from Melissa, Texas, who plays at Dynamic Prep (Irving, Texas), is ranked as the No. 18 prospect in the nation by 247 Sports, No. 19 by ESPN, No. 23 by On3 and No. 24 by 247 Sports Composite. Goosby is the No. 2-ranked player in the state of Texas according to 247 Sports Composite. In his junior year at Melissa HS, he averaged 24.1 ppg and 7.1 rpg at Melissa HS. During the 2025 Nike EYBL season, Goosby played for Drive Nation (Texas) and averaged 16.2 ppg, 6.2 rpg, 3.8 apg and 1.7 spg in the 17U Spring circuit while earning a spot on the EYBL 17U Spring All-Circuit first team.
- **Bo Ogden** (6-6, 195), a guard from Austin, Texas, who plays at Westlake HS, is ranked as the No. 30 prospect in the nation by 247 Sports, No. 34 by On3, No. 37 by 247 Sports Composite and No. 42 by ESPN. Ogden is the No. 4-ranked player in the state of Texas according to 247 Sports Composite. During his junior year at St. Michael's Preparatory School (Austin, Texas), he averaged 14.8 ppg, 4.8 rpg and 1.9 apg while leading St. Michael's to a 32-4 mark and the Class 6A TAPPS state championship. While playing with the ASAK Elite program on the 2025 spring and summer Adidas 3SSB circuit, Ogden ranked ninth on the circuit in scoring (20.9 ppg) while hitting 52.8-percent from three-point range and 86-percent from the free throw line.
- **Joe Sterling** (6-4, 170), a guard from Encino, Calif., who plays at Harvard-Westlake School, is ranked as the No. 93 prospect in the nation by ESPN, No. 100 by 247 Sports Composite, No. 105 by On3 and No. 106 by 247 Sports. As a junior, he helped Harvard-Westlake post a 31-3 record and advance to the CIF regional semifinals. During this past spring and summer on the Pro 16 circuit, Sterling averaged 21 points, three boards and three assists per contest while converting 44-percent from three-point range.
- **Coleman Elkins** (6-10, 240) is a forward from Austin, Texas who is playing his senior season at Blair Academy (Blairstown, N.J.). During his junior year, Elkins played at St. Andrew's Episcopal School (Austin, Texas) and averaged 15 points and 7.6 rebounds per game.

THREE TRIPS TO THE ROUND OF 32 IN LAST FOUR YEARS

- Texas has advanced to at least the NCAA Tournament Round of 32 in three of the last four seasons, including making a run to the 2023 NCAA Elite Eight.
- The Longhorns advanced to the NCAA Round of 32 in 2021-22, the NCAA Elite Eight in 2022-23 and the NCAA Round of 32 again in 2023-24.

TEXAS IN THE BIG DANCE

- Texas has made a total of **39** all-time appearances in the NCAA Tournament (40-42 record).
- UT has made **five**-consecutive trips to the NCAA Tournament (2021-22-23-24-25). This is the longest streak by the Longhorns since they made **14**-straight NCAA tourney appearances from 1999-2012.
- Texas is one of **six** schools to appear in at least 31 of the last 36 NCAA tourneys.

- UT is one of **seven** schools to appear in at least 23 of the last 26 NCAA tourneys.
- The Longhorns have advanced to the Final Four **three** times in program history (1943, 1947 and 2003), the Elite Eight a total of **eight** times and the Sweet 16 a total of **14** times.

IMPRESSIVE THREE-POINT STREAK

- The last time Texas did NOT convert a 3-pointer in a contest came on Dec. 18, 1990, in an 87-84 overtime victory at UC Santa Barbara. The Horns were 0-of-2 from beyond the arc that day.
- **The Longhorns enter Tuesday's contest having hit at least one 3-pointer in 1,183 consecutive games.**
- UT has converted at least one 3-pointer in 1,311 of 1,319 games since the 3-pointer was introduced prior to the 1986-87 season.
- The Horns have failed to ATTEMPT at least one 3-pointer just one time in school history (Feb. 24, 1988 in a 69-55 win at TCU).

REACHING 20 WINS

- UT has reached the 20-win plateau a total of **35** times in its previous 119 seasons of basketball.
- Texas reached the 20-win mark **during the regular season** in three consecutive years (2021-22, 2022-23 and 2023-24) before posting a 17-14 mark in the regular season last year.

THE 120th SEASON

- Texas is currently in its **120th** season of intercollegiate basketball.
- The Longhorns hold an all-time record of **1,931-1,167 (.623)** in their 120 years of competition.
- UT played its first varsity basketball contest on March 10, 1906 and recorded a 27-17 win against Baylor in Austin. The Horns have fielded a varsity basketball team every year since then with the exception of the 1907-08 season.

HORNS IN THE NBA

- A total of **six** former University of Texas players appeared on NBA rosters when the league opened the 2025-26 regular season.
- In addition to the former Longhorns on NBA rosters, Royal Ivey is an assistant coach for the Houston Rockets and Matt Hill is an assistant coach with the Charlotte Hornets.

DID YOU KNOW ...

- **Cole Bott** earned his bachelor's degree in Finance in May 2024 (in just three years) from the prestigious McCombs School of Business at Texas. Cole is pursuing his master's degree in Strategic Communications.
- **John Clark** wears jersey No. 9 as a tribute to the late musician Juice WRLD, who frequently used the number in his branding and music to push the theme of taking a bad situation or negative experience and using it to move forward in a positive direction.
- **Nic Codie** wears jersey No. 10 to pay tribute to his late friend, Deshawn Jagwan. Jagwan wore No. 10 at Woodrow Wilson HS and passed away in 2022 in a car crash. Nic's father, Nakia, played football at Baylor (1994-98) before spending one year with the Detroit Lions and three years with the Pittsburgh Steelers in the NFL.
- **Declan Duru Jr.** was born in Munich, Germany and lived there until he was age 11. His younger brother, Dennis, plays soccer for the 1860 Munich U17 club team. He wears jersey No. 4 as the angel number 4 in Catholicism is significant as an expression of the fullness of creation. Declan is fluent in German, Spanish and English.
- **Camden Heide** has one older brother, Keaton, who played football (quarterback) at South Dakota State University. Their father, Craig, built a sport court in their backyard in Wayzata when Camden was 13, and the one-on-one battles were intense. Camden also played baseball (pitcher/centerfielder) in his youth, and his age 11-12 club summer team (NorthStar Baseball Club) was the top-ranked team in the country.
- **Tramon Mark** has an uncle, Vernon Crawford, who played football (linebacker) at Florida State and went on to play three seasons with the New England Patriots in the NFL. Tramon's cousin, Kayden Henry, was the starting centerfielder for the Texas Softball national championship team last year and returns in 2026 for her junior season.
- **Antho McDermott's** father (Dustin) and mother (Misty) both played basketball at Northwestern Oklahoma State University (Alva, Okla.). His older sister, Addison, played volleyball at Northwestern State (La.).
- **Jordan Pope** lost his mother, Chantay Pope, four days prior to his fourth birthday from breast cancer. His father, Rodney Sr., has since remarried and Jordan has four siblings. Jordan began wearing jersey No. 0 in the seventh grade.
- **Brandon Taylor** father, Jamaar, played football (WR) at Texas A&M (2001-03) and went on to play two seasons with the New York Giants. His uncle, Earvin, played football at Texas A&M. Brandon's cousin, Jeffrey Taylor, played basketball at Vanderbilt and was the No. 31 pick in the 2012 NBA Draft by the Charlotte Bobcats. Brandon wears jersey No. 44 in honor of his cousin who wore the number at Vanderbilt.
- **Lassina Traore** lived in Korhogo, Ivory Coast until he was age 15, when he moved to Abidjan. He began playing basketball after the move to Abidjan, and his parents have never seen Lassina play in a basketball game at any level. He is fluent in French, Bambara (native language in Ivory Coast) and English.
- **Matas Vokietaitis** wears jersey No. 8 in recognition of his father's (Algirdas) birthday (July 8). Matas is fluent in Lithuanian, Russian and English.
- **Chendall Weaver** wears jersey No. 2 to honor the memory of his best friend, Nevaeh Lopez who passed in 2020 (she attended Mansfield Timberview HS and wore jersey No. 2). His older sister, Chennedy Carter, played basketball at Texas A&M (2016-19) and was the No. 4 pick of the 2020 WNBA Draft by the Atlanta Dream. She played two seasons with the Atlanta Dream (2020-21), one season with the Los Angeles Sparks (2022) and one season with the Chicago Sky (2024).
- **Simeon Wilcher** wears jersey No. 7 because his grandmother on his father's side, Margaret Wilcher, has seven grandchildren. His father, Sergio Sr., played basketball at Morgan State University. His older brother, CJ, played basketball at Xavier (2020-21), Nebraska (2021-24) and Texas A&M (2024-25). Simeon took his first steps on a local track when he was 11 months old, as his father coached for the Plainfield Tsunami Track & Field Club.
