### OPENING TIP

► No. 11 seed Oklahoma (17-14, 7-11 SEC) meets No. 14 seed South Carolina (13-18, 4-14) in a first-round SEC Tournament game on Wednesday at 8:30 p.m. CT inside 19,395-seat Bridgestone Arena in Nashville, Tenn. The winner will play No. 6 seed Texas A&M on Thursday at 8:30 p.m. (full bracket on page 21).

► Wednesday's game will be televised by SEC Network with **Tom Hart** (play-by-play) and **Dane Bradshaw** (analyst) announcing. It will air on the Sooner Sports Radio Network (KRXX 107.7 FM in Oklahoma City; KTBZ 1430 AM in Tulsa; SiriusXM 106 or 190; Varsity Radio App) with **Toby Rowland** and **Kevin Henry** on the call.

► After losing nine straight games, Oklahoma has won six of its last eight (at No. 15 Vanderbilt, vs. Georgia, vs. Auburn, at LSU, vs. Missouri and at Texas) and each of its last four. In the six victories, OU led for 205:14 of 245 minutes and by double digits for a combined 93:23. Seven Sooners averaged over 9.0 points per game in the six wins and OU shot a combined 53% from the field and 49% (65 for 133) from 3-point range.

► Oklahoma led the SEC in league play with its 39% 3-point field goal mark and ranked third with its 9.6 treys per outing. Over the last seven games, the Sooners are shooting 46% (75 for 163) from behind the arc. They have made at least 10 treys in four of the last five contests and at least eight in 11 of the last 12 games. On the season, OU is averaging 9.9 treys per outing (the school record is 10.3 in 2015-16).

► **Nijel Pack**, a first-year Sooner who is in his sixth year overall, ranks first among active Division I players (and 21st all-time) with 415 career 3-pointers and third with 2,244 points. With his three 3-pointers Saturday in a win over Texas, he passed Davidson's Stephen Curry (414 treys). Pack leads the SEC with his .453 3-point field goal percentage (ranks fifth nationally) and with his 3.3 treys per game. Over the last seven outings, he is a sizzling 26 for 46 (57%) from long distance.

**SATURDAY'S OU-TEXAS RECAP**

► It took overtime to do it, but Oklahoma won its fourth straight game and sixth in eight contests with a thrilling 88-85 victory at Texas in the regular season finale on Saturday at a sold-out Moody Center in Austin.

► OU, which was ahead for 30 of 45 minutes on the night, squandered a 12-point lead with 6:58 remaining in regulation (it led by six with 38 seconds to go), as Texas's Jordan Pope was fouled on a 3-pointer with 3.8 seconds remaining and converted all three free throw attempts to force the extra session.

► The Sooners scored first in overtime but found themselves down by one when **Mohamed Wague** tipped in a missed 3-point attempt by **Nijel Pack** for an 83-82 lead with 1:04 left. After a defensive stop, **Xavier Brown** found **Derrion Reid** in the corner for a 3-pointer and four-point lead with 11 seconds to go. OU forced another miss on UT's next possession and then Pack buried two free throws to seal the game.

► Pack and Brown combined to make 15 field goals and led the Sooners with 23 and 21 points, respectively. Pack was 3-for-7 from 3-point distance while Brown was 2 for 4 from deep and logged a team-high four assists and game-high four steals. It was the eighth 20-point outing for each player in SEC play.

► **Tae Davis** added 14 points and a game-high nine rebounds for OU and Reid scored 11 with the help of 6-for-6 free throw shooting. Wague contributed eight points, five boards and two steals for a Sooners team that held Texas to 41% shooting. In UT's 79-69 win in Norman on Jan. 31, it shot 60% from the floor.

► OU posted a 40-35 rebounding advantage and converted its 10 offensive rebounds into 17 second-chance points. It also outscored the Longhorns 16-10 off turnovers. The Sooners committed 10 turnovers on the night (to UT's 12) and didn't commit their first until 7:34 remained in the first half.

**SCENE SETTERS**

► Oklahoma begins its second SEC Tournament on Wednesday against a South Carolina team that has gone 2-10 since beating OU 85-76 on Jan. 20 in Columbia, S.C. The Gamecocks are coming off a 64-61 road win against Ole Miss on Saturday. USC is 22-33 all-time in the SEC Tournament (1-6 over the last six events) and reached the 1996 and 2008 championship games (lost both).

► In its SEC Tournament debut last year, No. 14 seed OU beat No. 11 seed Georgia 81-75 in the first round before falling to No. 6 seed and 15th-ranked Kentucky 85-84 at the buzzer in the second round.

► This marks the 15th SEC Tournament to be played in Nashville and 13th at Bridgestone Arena. It will be the fourth straight SEC Tourney played in Nashville, sixth of the last seven and 11th of the last 16.

► Oklahoma has held a double-digit lead in nine of the last 14 outings (won six of those nine).

► During their current four-game winning streak, the Sooners have trailed for a combined 9 minutes and 37 seconds out of 165 minutes (0:15 vs. Auburn, 1:08 at LSU, 0:31 vs. Missouri and 7:43 at Texas).

► Also during its four-game winning streak, OU is forcing opponents into 13.0 turnovers per game. Over its first 14 SEC outings, OU opponents averaged just 9.1 turnovers per contest.

► Oklahoma has held each of its last five opponents to sub-50% field goal shooting (42% combined) after five of its previous six foes shot at least 50%.

► OU is the only Power Five team and one of just four out of 361 squads nationally to start the same lineup every game this season. Its starters have been guards **Xzayvier Brown** and **Nijel Pack**, forwards **Tae Davis** and **Derrion Reid** and center **Mohamed Wague**. South Carolina has started 10 lineups.

► Wague is coming off the most productive five-game stretch of his career, averaging 11.4 points, 8.6 rebounds, 2.2 blocked shots and 1.6 steals

while going 21 for 26 (81%) from the free throw line against Texas A&M, Auburn, LSU, Missouri and Texas. The fifth-year center recorded 12 points, 13 rebounds and two blocks against the Aggies, 18 points, nine boards and career highs of four blocks and four steals vs. Auburn, 10 points, nine cars and three rejections at LSU, 11 points, seven boards and three assists vs. Missouri and eight points, five rebounds and two steals at Texas. He entered the five-game stretch averaging 6.2 points, 6.4 rebounds, 1.3 blocks and 0.5 steals while shooting 60% from the foul line.

► The resurgence of guard **Dayton Forsythe** has boosted OU the last few weeks. After a 10-game stretch in which he averaged 1.3 points and went 2 for 31 from the field (he battled sprains of both ankles), the sophomore is averaging 8.8 points over the last 10 contests. Over the last eight games, he is averaging 9.5 points (four double-digit efforts).

► Long Beach State transfer **Jadon Jones** averaged 5.4 points over his first 19 outings, but over the last eight games is averaging 7.3 points. The sixth-year guard, who is 15 for 29 (52%) from 3-point range over those eight contests, has drawn 14 fouls while attempting a 3-pointer this season. The 2021-22 Big West Conference Defensive Player of the Year has 20 steals and 14 blocks over the past 14 games.

**SERIES HISTORY**

► Oklahoma holds a 5-2 series lead against South Carolina and has won four of the last five matchups. This will mark the first neutral-site game in the series.

► The Sooners are 3-0 vs. South Carolina in Norman, winning 90-84 in the first-ever meeting in 1974-75 at the OU Field House and 92-76 in 1992-93 and 82-62 last season at Lloyd Noble Center.

► OU is 2-2 against the Gamecocks in Columbia. Its wins came in 1977-78 (65-48 in the Carolina Tournament title game) and in 1991-92 (61-60). South Carolina's victories were in 1975-76 (80-59) and Jan. 20 this season (85-76).

## OU'S RICH HOOPS HISTORY

Oklahoma's storied men's basketball history is the envy of most SEC programs. The Sooners' five Final Four appearances are exceeded in the SEC by only Kentucky (17), Arkansas (6) and Florida (6). OU, which played in the 1947 and 1988 national title games, has participated in 34 NCAA Tournaments and has played in the postseason in 36 of the last 43 years.

Oklahoma has also generated 18 first-team All-Americans, including Hollis Price, Blake Griffin, Buddy Hield and Trae Young since the turn of the century. Griffin and Hield were consensus national players of the year. OU has produced two of the six Wooden Award winners from current SEC schools (Kentucky/Texas two each).

## JAN. 20 AT SOUTH CAROLINA RECAP

- ▶ Oklahoma shot just 19% (5 for 27) from 3-point range and was outscored 18-11 off turnovers in an 85-76 loss at South Carolina on Jan. 20. The Gamecocks shot 45% (9 for 20) from deep.
- ▶ OU junior guard **Xzayvier Brown** scored a game-high 22 points and senior forward **Tae Davis** netted a season-high 20. Brown also logged six rebounds, three assists, a career-high three blocked shots and two steals, while Davis added three boards and three handouts. Sophomore forward **Derrion Reid** scored 11 points on 6-for-10 shooting and pulled down a game-high-tying seven rebounds.
- ▶ South Carolina scored the first 11 points of the game, all by forward **Elijah Strong** and all in the first 2 1/2 minutes. OU fell behind by 14 points at 28-14 with 7:46 left in the period before cutting it to a three-point (39-36) margin at half. The Gamecocks opened the second half on a 12-5 spurt to go up 10 and the Sooners never got closer than five points thereafter. **Nijel Pack** (0 for 7 from 3) was held to nine points. Fellow guard **Jadon Jones** was held scoreless on the night (0 for 4 from the field; all 3-point attempts), but did contribute five rebounds, three blocks and four steals.

## OU'S CONFERENCE TOURNEY HISTORY

- ▶ Oklahoma owns a 48-41 record in conference postseason action, racking up a 23-16 record in the Big Eight Tournament from 1977-1996, a 24-24 mark in the Big 12 Tournament from 1997-2024 and going 1-1 in its SEC Tournament debut last year.
- ▶ The Sooners won Big Eight Tournament titles in 1979, 1985, 1988 and 1990, and claimed three straight Big 12 Tournament crowns from 2001-03.
- ▶ OU is 28-21 in its opening game in postseason conference tournament play (12-8 in Big Eight, 15-13 in Big 12 and 1-0 in SEC).
- ▶ Former head coaches **Kelvin Sampson** (1995-2006) and **Billy Tubbs** (1981-1994) each directed the Sooners to 18 conference tournament wins. Sampson was 18-9 and Tubbs 18-11. They each won three titles.
- ▶ Under Sampson, OU won 10 straight Big 12 Tournament games from 2001-2004.

## PACK MENTALITY

- ▶ First-year Oklahoma guard **Nijel Pack** surpassed the 2,000-point mark Jan. 11 at Texas A&M and has 2,244 for his career to rank third nationally among active players.
- ▶ Pack leads active Division I players and ranks 21st all-time with 415 career 3-point field goals. The only player to ever wear an OU uniform who has made more career treys is **Umoja Gibson** (428; was a Sooner during the 2020-21 and 2021-22 seasons).
- ▶ Pack leads the SEC with his .453 season 3-point field goal percentage and 3.3 treys per game. Nationally, he ranks fifth and 19th, respectively.
- ▶ Pack has scored 20-plus points in eight of the last 16 games (24 at Texas A&M, 25 at Missouri, 22 vs. Arkansas, 23 vs. Texas, 20 at Tennessee, 22 vs. Auburn, 21 at LSU and 23 at Texas).
- ▶ Pack has made at least one 3-pointer in 29 of 31 games, at least three in 20 contests and at least five in nine outings.

▶ A sixth-year collegian, Pack spent his first two seasons at Kansas State (he was a first-team All-Big 12 pick as a sophomore when he averaged 17.4 points, made 95 3-pointers and shot a league-high .436 from behind the arc) and the last three at Miami, Fla. (he helped the Hurricanes to their first Final Four his junior season and was named the Midwest Region Most Outstanding Player). He has started 152 of his 153 career games.

## OU'S 'X' FACTOR

- ▶ Junior guard **Xzayvier Brown** averaged 18.7 points over a 15-game span from Dec. 13 through Feb. 7 and ranks second on the team with his 15.6 points per contest on the season. He also leads the team with his 3.1 assists and 1.4 steals per outing.
- ▶ After averaging 8.5 points over a recent four-game span, Brown is averaging 17.7 over the last three, with 20- and 21-point efforts at LSU and Texas.
- ▶ Brown shot 34% from 3-point range in OU's first 26 games but is shooting 53% (10 for 19) over the last five outings. He made two treys in each of those five contests.
- ▶ Brown leads the SEC by shooting 89% from the free throw line (90 for 101) but only has 22 attempts over the last 11 games. For comparison, he attempted 51 free throws over the previous 11 contests. He assembled a streak of 27 makes, which ended Jan. 13 vs. Florida.
- ▶ Brown logged a team-high-tying eight outings of 20-plus points in SEC play.
- ▶ After scoring at least 20 points in 14 of 35 games last year at Saint Joseph's, Brown has a team-high 13 games of 20-plus in 31 outings this season. He has 33 career games of at least 20.

## MORE OU NOTES AND NUGGETS

- ▶ Oklahoma has led for over 20 minutes in nine of the last 12 games and has been ahead for 282 out of 370 minutes (76%) in those nine contests.
- ▶ The Sooners have scored at least 85 points in 15 of their 31 games (48%). The last time OU recorded more 85-point games in a season was in 1992-93 (17; 33 years ago). It also logged 15 such outings in the 1993-94, 2013-14 and 2017-18 seasons. For perspective, OU's last four teams scored 85-plus a combined 21 times in 133 games (16%).
- ▶ OU's top four scorers are all transfers in their first year in the program. **Nijel Pack** averages a team-high 16.1 points per game, while **Xzayvier Brown** (15.6), **Tae Davis** (12.2) and **Derrion Reid** (11.3) also average double figures. **Mohamed Waguo** rounds out the starting five with his 7.1 per contest.
- ▶ OU announced on Dec. 28 the signing of 23-year-old **Kirill Elatontsev** (kee-REEL EE-el-uh-tahn-suv), a 6-11, 240-pound center from Russia who is averaging 4.4 points and 2.3 rebounds in 14.9 minutes per contest over his 19 games. He is shooting 51% from the field, 36% (11 for 31) from 3-point range and 73% (19 for 26) from the foul line.
- ▶ Redshirt freshman forward **Kuol Atak** ranks third on the team with his 38 3-point makes (shooting 43%) despite playing in just 21 of 31 games and averaging only 12.2 minutes in those contests. Twice this season he has made six treys in a contest. Atak, who is 27 for 52 (52%) from long distance in home games, has played in just five of OU's last 14 games (none of the last four).

Praised for his ability to create culture and his never-tiring energy, University of Oklahoma head men's basketball coach Porter Moser is in his fifth season leading the Sooners in 2025-26. Moser was hired on April 3, 2021, becoming the 15th head coach in program history after a stellar 10-year run as head coach at Loyola Chicago that included NCAA Final Four and Sweet 16 appearances.

The 2024-25 season was Moser's most successful at OU, guiding his team to a 20-14 record and a No. 9 NCAA Tournament seed. The Sooners, who won their first 13 games and climbed to as high as No. 10 in the Coaches poll and No. 12 in the AP version, played one of the nation's toughest schedules, with 14 games against AP top-25 opponents and 22 of 34 contests against teams that made the NCAA Tournament. OU went 3-0 to win the Battle 4 Atlantis tournament in the Bahamas in November before navigating its first season in the rugged Southeastern Conference, a league that placed a record 14 teams in the NCAA Tournament. The Sooners also set a program record with their .795 free throw percentage, obliterating the previous mark of .767 by the 2001-02 Final Four team.

Point guard Jeremiah Fears was named to the 2024-25 SEC All-Freshman Team and was selected No. 7 overall in the 2025 NBA Draft by the New Orleans Pelicans to become Moser's highest draft pick. Fears was one of just three Power Four conference players (the only one in the SEC and the only freshman) to average at least 17.0 points, 4.0 rebounds, 4.0 assists and 1.5 steals per contest.

In 2023-24, Moser guided OU to a 20-12 mark, ranking as high as seventh in the AP poll. The Sooners reached 20 regular season wins for the first time since 2015-16 and began the season 10-0, tying the 1991-92 and 2003-04 seasons for the seventh-best start in program history. OU bested Iowa and USC at the Rady Children's Invitational, claiming its second consecutive midseason tournament title, and Javian McCollum and Jalon Moore earned All-Big 12 honorable mention accolades.

Moser completed his second season in Norman in 2022-23, recording four AP Top-25 victories and winning the 2022 ESPN Events Invitational. Tanner Groves became only the second two-time College Sports Communicators (formerly CoSIDA) Academic All-American in program history, receiving third-team honors in 2023 and first-team accolades in 2022. In addition to the Sooners' success in the classroom, Milos Uzan was named to the Big 12 All-Freshman Team. Grant Sheffield and Jalen Hill received All-Big 12 Honorable Mention acclaim.

In 2021-22, Moser led the Sooners to a 19-16 mark and five victories over teams ranked in the top 25 at the time of competition. Oklahoma was selected as a No. 1 seed in the National Invitation Tournament, earning an opening-round victory over Missouri State at Lloyd Noble Center.

Umoja Gibson, Jordan Goldwire, Groves and Elijah Harkless earned All-Big 12 honorable mention honors, and C.J. Noland earned a spot on the Big 12 All-Freshman Team. In addition to the on-court success, Groves was tabbed a Senior CLASS Award Finalist and named to the CoSIDA Academic All-America First Team.

Moser received the keys to the Oklahoma men's basketball program as one of the most successful coaches of the prior half-decade. He has been entrenched in creating and developing team culture at all his stops.

Before his time in Norman, Moser led the Loyola Ramblers to remarkable success during his 10-year run as head coach, including a run to the Final Four in 2018 and Sweet Sixteen in 2021.

He amassed 188 wins (188-141, .571), including five seasons with 20-plus victories. He led Loyola to the postseason every year it was available from 2017-21, winning the 2017 CBI title and qualifying for the 2019 NIT. The 2020 postseason was canceled due to COVID-19.

In addition to his team success, he coached 12 all-conference selections, two Missouri Valley Player of the Year honorees, two Associated Press Honorable Mention All-Americans, two Academic All-Americans, a MVC Defensive Player of the Year, two MVC Sixth Man of the Year honorees and a pair of MVC Freshman of the Year selections.

Moser was one of three coaches in Loyola's history to record 150-plus wins. He guided the 2017-18 squad to a school record 32 victories and an appearance in the Final Four – Loyola's first appearance since winning the 1963 NCAA Championship.

After assembling a 25-5 regular season record (15-3 in MVC play), Moser guided Loyola to seven straight postseason wins, claiming the 2018 Missouri Valley tournament title and making a historic run to the pinnacle event of college basketball as a No. 11 seed.

The Ramblers were just the fourth No. 11 seed to advance to the Final Four, beating Miami, Tennessee, Nevada and Kansas State.

Loyola finished the 2017-18 season ranked No. 7 in the final USA Today Coaches Poll. Moser was named the Missouri Valley Conference (MVC) Coach of the Year and the National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) District 16 Coach of the Year.

The 2017-18 team ranked second nationally in personal fouls per game (just 13.9), third in field goal percentage (.507) and sixth in scoring defense (62.6 ppg).

During the 2017-18 season, Rambler guard Clayton Custer was named MVC Player of the Year and earned Associated Press (AP) Honorable Mention All-America honors, becoming the first player in Loyola history to receive both in the same season.

Cameron Krutwig earned MVC Freshman of the Year honors and Ben Richardson was named MVC Defensive Player of the Year. In addition to his on-court success, Custer was named CoSIDA Academic All-District. He is in his fourth year working with the Sooners and second as an assistant coach in 2024-25 after two seasons as the director of video operations and player development from 2021-23

Moser boasts six NCAA Tournament wins from 2018-21 – tied for the seventh most nationally in that time frame. Loyola, Gonzaga and Houston were the only teams outside major conferences to reach two Sweet 16s during the three-year run.

In his final season at Loyola (2020-21), Moser led the Ramblers to a 26-5 record and Missouri Valley Conference regular season and tournament titles. As an eighth seed in the NCAA Tournament, his squad upset No. 1-seed Illinois in the second round to advance to the Sweet 16 for the second time since 2018.

The 2020-21 Rambler squad ranked second in adjusted defensive efficiency (KenPom.com), allowing only 87.0 points per 100 possessions. Loyola's 16-2 record in MVC play set a program record for most wins in conference action.

After 19 wins during the 2014-15 season, the Ramblers earned a bid to the College Basketball Invitational (CBI), advancing to Loyola's first postseason appearance since the 1985 season. Loyola made the most of its chance at postseason play, winning the CBI Championship over Louisiana-Monroe with back-to-back victories in the best-of-three championship series.

After rebuilding during the 2013-14 season, Moser led the Ramblers to a 24-13 mark next season. The 24 victories were the most by a Moser led team and the most for Loyola since 1985.

In the early stages of building Loyola to a mid-major powerhouse, Moser led the Ramblers to an eight-game improvement in the win column from his first season at the helm to his second in 2012-13. The improvement was the most by a coach from his first year to his second in program history.

Owner of a 359-287 (.556) career record, Moser was hired for his first head coaching job in 2000 at Arkansas-Little Rock. In three seasons with the Trojans, Moser took over a program that went 4-24 during the season before his hiring and went 18-11 just one year later.

The Trojans ranked last in the conference in several defensive categories before his tenure. Moser turned the program around in one season, finishing with the Sun Belt's best field goal percentage defense and second-best scoring defense.

He steered the Trojans to a 54-34 overall record before heading to Illinois State in 2003.

After his 2003-04 squad notched a 10-19 record, Moser improved to 17-13 in 2004-05 despite being picked to finish last in the league in the preseason poll.

Following four years at Illinois State, Moser worked under legendary coach Rick Majerus at Saint Louis as an assistant coach from 2007 through 2011. He returned to a head coaching role by being named Loyola's head coach before the 2011-12 season.

A Chicago area native, Moser grew up in Naperville, Ill. He was a two-year starter at Creighton and helped lead the Jays to the 1989 Missouri Valley Conference title and a berth in the NCAA Tournament. He graduated in 1990 with a degree in business management.

Immediately following his collegiate playing career, Moser began his path in coaching at his alma mater as a graduate assistant. He left Creighton for an assistant coach role at Texas A&M for four seasons followed by a year at Wisconsin-Milwaukee. Moser returned to Texas A&M for two more seasons (1996-98) on the Aggies' bench, then served as an assistant coach at Little Rock for two years before his promotion to head coach.

Moser and his wife, Megan, have four children – Jordan, a former OU's women's basketball player, Jake, a former OU men's player, and Max and Ben.
