FOR STARTERS

- Carolina continues its five-game homestand in a Thursday-Saturday series against No. 2 Texas at Founders Park.
- First pitch for both Thursday and Friday's game is at 7 p.m. with Saturday's game starting at 2 p.m.
- Thursday's game will be televised on SEC Network with Dave Neal and Gregg Olson on the call, while Friday and Saturday's games will be streamed on SEC Network Plus.
- All three games also will be broadcast on the Gamecock Sports Network presented by Learfield with Derek Scott and Cade Crenshaw on the call.

SCOUTING TEXAS

- The Longhorns are coming off a 10-8 win over Texas State on Tuesday night.
- Ethan Mendoza was 3-for-4 with three RBI in the win over the Bobcats.
- Aiden Robbins leads the Longhorns with a .372 batting average and shares the home run lead (10) with Casey Borba.
- On the mound, Ruger Riojas was 5-0 with a 1.59 ERA and 64 strikeouts in 39.2 innings pitched.
- Jim Schlossnagle is in his second season at Texas and 24th season as a head coach. He is a two-time National Coach of the Year and has made six trips to the College World Series.

SERIES VS. TEXAS

- Texas holds a 7-2 series advantage on Carolina heading into Thursday's game, but the Gamecocks have won the last two meetings.
- Carolina won both ends of a doubleheader on March 13, 2022, winning the opener 4-2 and the nightcap 9-4.
- Matthew Becker struck out 11 batters in the second game on his way to SEC Pitcher of the Week honors.
- The two teams have faced off three times in Omaha, including the championship games in 1975 and 2002.

BAK'S BIG NIGHT

- Junior Tyler Bak went 4-for-5 with a double, a home run and four RBI in an 11-1, seven-inning win over Wofford on March 31.
- Bak's three-run home run was part of a six-run fifth inning for the Gamecocks.
- Bak is tied for the team lead with 20 RBI while hitting .279 with four doubles and four home runs.

RANDOLPH'S A BLAST

- Fifth-year senior Jake Randolph belted three home runs in the Arkansas series, including a pair in the 9-4 win over the Razorbacks on Sunday, March 22.
- Randolph had a two-run home run on Friday, one of three home runs by the Gamecocks in that game.
- Randolph then had home runs in consecutive at-bats against Arkansas on Sunday. His solo shot to lead off the fourth gave Carolina a 4-0 lead.
- He then had a two-run home run in the sixth, part of a three-run frame.
- Randolph hit a home run in the seventh inning at Georgia on March 29.
- Randolph currently is hitting .323 with eight runs scored and nine RBI.

STONE'S LIKE A ROCK

- Junior Brandon Stone earned his third win of the season in a 9-4 victory over Arkansas on March 22.
- Stone struck out five in 5.1 innings pitched, allowing five hits and two runs.
- Stone is now 3-1 on the year with a 3.23 ERA and 30 strikeouts in 30.2 innings pitched.
- Stone now has five career wins in Columbia with 76 strikeouts at Carolina.

GUNTHER NAMED SEC PITCHER OF THE WEEK

- Junior Josh Gunther was named the SEC Pitcher of the Week on March 2.
- Gunther, who made his first career start, went seven innings and allowed just three with no runs and 10 strikeouts to just one walk in a 7-0 win over No. 15 Clemson.
- Gunther ended five of his seven innings with a strikeout and retired the final six batters of the night.
- Clemson came into the game hitting .332 but Gunther and Alex Valentin combined on Carolina's second shutout of the season.
- Gunther did not allow a hit or a run in Friday's game against No. 23 Florida on March 13. He struck out five in his third career start.

AMP'D UP

- Amp Phillips did not allow an earned run in Carolina's game at No. 23 Florida on Saturday night (March 14).
- Phillips pitched six innings for the Gamecocks and allowed five hits with three strikeouts.
- Phillips then went seven strong innings against Arkansas on March 21, striking out six and allowing one run on three hits.
- Phillips struck out a season high nine batters in six innings of work at Georgia on March 28.
- Phillips has two wins on the season to go along with a 2.68 ERA and a .197 opponent's batting average.

CRADDOCK NAMED SEC FROSH OF THE WEEK

- Freshman infielder Will Craddock was named the SEC Co-Freshman of the Week on Monday, Feb. 23 after his debut in a Carolina uniform.
- Craddock went 8-for-15 with nine runs scored, two doubles, a triple, two home runs, two walks and six RBI to help lead the Gamecocks to four wins last week.
- He was a perfect 3-for-3 and reached base safely in all five of his plate appearance in the Gardner-Webb win on Wednesday.
- In the win over Navy on Saturday, he opened the first with a leadoff home run and added a two-run double. Craddock had four RBI in the game.
- Then on Sunday in the win over Air Force, Craddock once again led off the Carolina first with a home run. He also added a double in the 4-2 win.
- Craddock becomes the first Gamecock to win Freshman of the Week honors since Tyler Pitzer in 2024.
- Craddock is hitting .295 with six doubles, a triple, six home runs and 19 RBI with a .568 slugging percentage this season.

LECROY RETURNS FOR FIFTH SEASON

- Catcher Talmadge LeCroy returns for his fifth year at Carolina in 2026 after missing the sec-

- ond half of last season due to injury.
- LeCroy has played in 203 games in his Carolina career with 186 starts. LeCroy is one of 17 Gamecocks to play in 200 games or more and the first to do it since Adam Matthews (2009-12).
- LeCroy also is 10th all-time in walks at Carolina with 121 free passes.
- The Belton, S.C., native has 165 hits, 30 doubles, two triples, 12 home runs and 106 RBI in the Garnet and Black, helping Carolina to a Super Regional berth in 2023.
- LeCroy belted his first career grand slam in a win over Princeton on March 8.
- LeCroy is hitting .284 with five home runs and is tied for third on the team with 19 RBI this season.

KJ MOVING TO SHORT FOR 2026

- Sophomore KJ Scobey manned the hot corner last year, starting at third in 56 of Carolina's 57 games in 2025.
- Scobey will now move to shortstop this season, a position he played at Team USA training camp this summer and all through fall ball.
- Scobey had 34 runs scored, seven doubles, eight home runs and 27 RBI in his freshman season.
- Scobey had a walk-off double in Carolina's 3-2 win over North Florida on April 22 and had a home run to lead off the ninth in the Gamecocks' 6-5 win over No. 1 LSU on May 15.
- Scobey spent the summer of 2025 in the USA Baseball Collegiate National Team training camp in Cary, N.C. He had two hits in the Stars and Stripes exhibition on June 30.
- In the second game of the 2026 season, Scobey hit a walk-off solo home run to start the bottom of the ninth, lifting Carolina to a 6-5 win.
- Scobey is hitting .300 with 13 doubles, four home runs and is tied for the team lead with 20 RBI this year.
- Scobey leads the SEC with 13 doubles this season.

MILESTONE CENTRAL

- Talmadge LeCroy became the 17th Gamecock to play in 200 career games in Friday's game against Georgia. LeCroy also moved into 10th place on Carolina's base on balls mark after his two walks vs. Wofford on March 31.
- LeCroy currently is in 13th place for games played at Carolina. Michael Campbell (2003-06) holds the Carolina record with 255 games played.
- LeCroy surpassed 100 RBI in his career after his grand slam in the win over Princeton (March 8). LeCroy has 106 career RBI.

LEE NAMED INTERIM HEAD COACH

- Monte Lee was named interim head coach of the Gamecocks on March 21, 2026.
- Lee is in his fourth season in his second term on the Gamecock coaching staff and ninth year overall.
- Lee has helped the Gamecocks to back-to-back 100-plus home run seasons with an over .400 on-base percentage in 2023 and 2024.
- Lee, who has had 21 winning seasons in his 23 years as a full-time NCAA coach, most recently was the head coach at Clemson University for seven seasons (2016-22), garnering a 242-136 overall record and leading the Tigers to four NCAA Tournament berths.
- Prior to his time at Clemson, Lee was the head coach of the College of Charleston from 2009-15, guiding the Cougars to a 276-145 overall record. In his seven years at College of Charleston, Lee coached four conference players-of-the-year, two conference pitchers-of-the-year and two conference freshmen-of-the-year.
- Lee was an assistant coach with the Gamecocks under Ray Tanner from 2003-08. Lee helped the Gamecocks to the NCAA Regional all six years

- as an assistant, including College World Series appearances in 2003 and 2004 and Super Regional berths his four of his first five seasons.
- Lee was a standout outfielder at the College of Charleston from 1996-99. He was in the top 10 in school history in career doubles, total bases and RBIs.

A WELL ROUNDED STAFF

- Terry Rooney will begin his second season with the Gamecocks as the pitching coach/recruiting coordinator.
- Rooney was at LSU in 2024 as the Associate Director of Program Development. He has been Mainieri's pitching coach for two years at LSU (2007-08) and three years at Notre Dame (2004-06).
- John Hendry starts his second season as an assistant coach with Carolina. Hendry was at Virginia for three seasons as the program's Director of Player Development.
- Chris Gordon has been named an assistant coach. He is in his second year on staff, serving as the director of player development. Gordon has been an on-field coach for staffs at Texas and Duke.
- Stuart Lake is the Director of Player Development. Lake brings extensive experience, having previously coached at the College of Charleston, Ole Miss, and The Citadel, and served as head coach at Charleston Southern for eight seasons. He was named Big South Coach of the Year in 2014.
- Caleb Westfall (Graduate Assistant), Noah Wise (Director of Operations and Equipment Management), Will Mann (Dir. Hitting Analytics) and Owen Moline-Freeman (Dir. Pitching Analytics) round out the staff.

TANNER, BOUKNIGHT GET THE CALL TO THE HALL

- Ray Tanner and Kip Bouknight are two of 21 standouts who will be inducted into the College Baseball Hall of Fame on February 12, 2026, in Overland Park, Kan.
- Tanner is one of three coaches in the class to win a national championship, joining Ray Fisher (Michigan) and Clint Evans (California).
- Bouknight is one of five Golden Spikes Award winners in this year's class, joining Mike Loynd (Florida State), Phil Nevin (Cal State Fullerton), David Price (Vanderbilt) and Stephen Strasburg (San Diego State).
- Tanner was the head coach of the Gamecocks for 16 years, leading to program to back-to-back national championships in 2010 and 2011 as well as a pair of runner-up finishes in 2002 and 2012. Carolina made six College World Series appearances during his time as head coach and won three SEC Championships, an SEC Tournament title in 2004, 10 Super Regional appearances and 14 NCAA Tournament appearances.
- Bouknight is the winningest pitcher in South Carolina baseball history (45 wins) while holding school records for strikeouts (457) and decisions. Bouknight won the Golden Spikes Award in 2000 and was a consensus All-American that season.

IMPACT TRANSFERS

- Carolina brings in 18 transfers from Division I schools as well as six junior college transfers in 2026.
- Carolina's transfer class was ranked No. 3 in the country by 643 Charts, No. 4 by 64 Analytics and No. 8 by D1Baseball.com.
- Three of Carolina's transfer pitchers were ranked as top portal pickups in the country by D1Baseball.com. Amp Phillips (USC Upstate) was No. 15, while Josh Gunther (Wake Forest) was No. 25 and Alex Philpott (Florida) was No. 35.
- Logan Sutter (Purdue) had 38 doubles in his last two seasons with the Boilermakers. He was an All-Big Ten second team honoree in 2025.
- Ethan Lizama (Western Kentucky) was named the Conference USA Tournament Most Valuable Player after helping the Hilltoppers to a tournament title and an NCAA Oxford Regional berth.
- Amp Phillips (USC Upstate) was the Big South Newcomer of the Year and an All-Big South first team honoree, helping the Spartans to a Clemson Regional appearance.

GAMECOCKS IN THE MLB

- Carolina will have a trio of players on Opening Day rosters this weekend.
- Carlos Cortes (Athletics), Carmen Mlodzinski (Pittsburgh Pirates) and Christian Walker are all on Opening Day rosters.
- Clarke Schmidt (New York Yankees) and Jordan Montgomery (Texas Rangers) are on the 60-day IL.

Monte Lee was named the associate head coach/recruiting coordinator for the South Carolina baseball team on Aug. 18, 2022. He was named interim head coach on March 21, 2026.

In his first season back in Columbia, Lee helped the Gamecock offense to 117 home runs (10th in the country), 380 walks (second in the SEC) and a school-record 107 hit-by-pitches. Carolina had a .408 on-base percentage, 58 stolen bases, 491 runs scored and a .499 slugging percentage. Lee coached Braylen Wimmer, who played shortstop and hit .304 with 11 doubles, 14 home runs and 43 RBI. He also coached Gavin Casas, who hit 19 home runs and had a .569 slugging percentage in his first season with the Gamecocks. Talmadge LeCroy had 10 doubles and 42 RBI and was the MVP of the Clemson series.

The offense had a .411 on-base percentage and 382 walks, which led the country most of the season, in 2024. The Gamecocks hit 101 home runs under Lee's tutelage and scored 461 runs, which was fifth in the SEC at the end of the regular season. Carolina stole 66 bases in 2024, 16 more than the previous season, led by Blake Jackson's 16. Cole Messina had 71 RBI, including an SEC Tournament record 16 in Hoover, while joining Ethan Petry with 21 home runs on the year. The Gamecocks had three players in double digits in doubles (Messina 19, Parker Noland 12, Kennedy Jones 10) and four in double digits in home runs (Messina and Petry 21, Dalton Reeves 11, Gavin Casas 10). Lee coached Nathan Hall in 2025, who led the Gamecocks with a .322 batting average, 13 doubles and seven home runs. Petry closed out his Gamecock career with 10 more home runs in 2025 and has 54 in his three years in Columbia, which is second all-time on Carolina's career home runs list.

Lee, who has had 21 winning seasons in his 23 years as a full-time NCAA coach, most recently was the head coach at Clemson University for seven seasons (2016-22), garnering a 242-136 overall record and leading the Tigers to four NCAA Tournament berths. Lee coached nine All-Americans, including at least one All-American in six of his seven seasons, and had 34 players drafted a total of 38 times at Clemson. He coached Max Wagner, a Dick Howser Trophy finalist and ACC Player of the Year, in 2022. Clemson won the 2016 ACC Tournament, going 4-0 in Durham, N.C., helping the Tigers to a No. 7 national seed in the NCAA Tournament. The Tigers then won 42 games in 2017, hosting a regional for the second-straight season. Lee's first five teams at Clemson all received perfect 1,000 APR scores.

Prior to his time at Clemson, Lee was the head coach of the College of Charleston from 2009-15, guiding the Cougars to a 276-145 overall record. In his seven years at College of Charleston, Lee coached four conference players-of-the-year, two conference pitchers-of-the-year and two conference freshmen-of-the-year. Lee won 200 games at College of Charleston faster than any coach in school history. The College of Charleston advanced to the Lubbock Super Regional in 2014 after winning the Gainesville Regional. He also led the Cougars to NCAA appearances in 2010 and 2015. The 2015 team was ranked in the top-25 for much of the season and finished 20th in the final USA Today Coaches' Poll.

Lee is no stranger to Columbia, as he was an assistant coach with the Gamecocks under Ray Tanner from 2003-08. Lee helped the Gamecocks to the NCAA Regional all six years as an assistant, including College World Series appearances in 2003 and 2004 and Super Regional berths his four of his first five seasons. The 2004 team won 53 games, including the 2004 SEC Tournament, going a perfect 4-0 in Hoover. The Gamecocks won an SEC East Division championship in 2003, going 19-11 in league play. Lee also coached Justin Smoak, who set school records for home runs (62), RBI (207), walks (151) and total bases (485).

He began his coaching career as an assistant (2001-02) at Spartanburg Methodist College. The 2002 squad totaled a school-record 51 wins, while the 2001 team played in the NJCAA College World Series. Lee also was the head coach of the South Carolina Diamond Devils AAU team in 2002 after serving as an assistant coach in 2001.

Lee was a standout outfielder for the Cougars from 1996-99. In 206 career games, he hit .333 with 156 runs, 240 hits, 50 doubles, six triples, 22 homers, 150 RBIs, 88 walks and 66 steals. He was in the top 10 in school history in career doubles, total bases and RBIs. In 2004, he was inducted as an inaugural member of College of Charleston's Baseball Wall of Fame at Patriots Point Stadium.

He became the first position player drafted in Cougar history when the St. Louis Cardinals selected him in the 39th round in 1999. He played 82 games over two years (1999,00) in the minors.

Lee, who received academic all-district honors as a senior, earned his bachelor of science degree in elementary education from College of Charleston in 2000 after playing four seasons of baseball and two years of football at Lugoff-Elgin High School in Lugoff, S.C.
