October Speakers: Ballot on the Charlotte School Tax Referendum



Ian Vincent — who is the Chairman of the Charlotte County School Board — has been an Environmental Consultant in Charlotte County since 1997, and is the Managing Member of Ian Vincent and Associates. Mr. Vincent has been a Charlotte County School Board Member since 2010 serving as Vice Chairman in 2012 and 2013 and Chairman in 2014, 2016, 2017, and 2018. Mr. Vincent is married and has two children who attend Charlotte County Public Schools.



Harvey Goldstein was born and raised in Brooklyn, New York. He attended the New York City Public Schools, earned his undergraduate and graduate degrees at Binghamton University, New York University, and did postgraduate work at Tufts University and the University of Oregon. While in Houlton, he also served as a guest minister at the Oakfield Maine Unitarian/Universalist church.

He then served at the University of Maine, American International College, and Greenfield College. He was chairman of the Republican party in Athol MA, and served as Director of Veterans Services for North

Central Massachusetts for over 20 years.

In Charlotte County, he was on the Board of Directors of Deep Creek Section 23 Property Owners Association, and is a long time elected member of the Charlotte County Republican Executive Committee. Harvey is a life member and past Commander of the American Legion, a Life Member of Veterans of Foreign Wars, and a Life Member of Vietnam Veterans of America.

Harrington, will be held Saturday October 13, 2018 at 6:00 p.m. The tickets are \$80 and can be obtained from Raul Fernandez.


