# Two Goodfellows' stories warmed Johnny 'O's heart

Two Goodfellows' volunteers told me stories that happened during the Christmas season that warmed my heart.

The first story was by Brian West of UAW 1166, who directs Goodfellows' Christmas program. He was having dinner at a local restaurant with a couple who were retired. They asked Brian why he worked so hard to help "those people." About that time, a waitress came to Brian's table and thanked Brian and Goodfellows for providing her family with Christmas. "That waitress is one of 'those people,' Brian told the retired couple. "She works two jobs just to make ends meet." There are exceptions, but the waitress exemplifies most of "those people" Goodfellows helps, Brian said. The retired couple responded by saying they would like to be Goodfellows next year.

The second story occurred during Goodfellows' client shopping. Annie 'O worked with a high school senior. Most Howard County high school seniors volunteer for Goodfellows to become eligible for one of two scholarships Goodfellows available at each high school. However, this was not the only reason the senior working with Annie 'O volunteered. When she was a little girl living in Texas, her parents divorced and she and her siblings moved with their mother back to Howard County. "If it wasn't for Goodfellows, we would not have had Christmas for several years," she said. "I've always wanted to volunteer for Goodfellows, and I was able to do so this year."

Also warming Johnny 'O's heart this Christmas season were the following 20 Club Kokomo Road Runners, who, in most cases, once again became Goodfellows during client shopping Dec. 3-6, 2018.

Goodfellows helping people would not be possible without the money provided by We Care; the assistance of Meijer, a huge supporter of all programs in Howard County; and volunteers, including members of UAW 1166, Firefighters Local 396, EMA, Club Kokomo Road Runners, Kokomo High School women's golf team and coaches, local Marine Corps League, Kiwanis, and 20 high school seniors from all five Howard County high schools.

Goodfellows is the oldest Christmas program for children in Howard County. It was founded in 1911, and this was its 108<sup>th</sup> year of helping children in Howard County. Goodfellows is an all-volunteer organization. It has no paid staff and no building.

Goodfellows spends thousands of dollars each year on clothing for children. We Care provided \$105,000 in 2018 to Goodfellows, \$105,000 to Kokomo Rescue Mission, \$105,00 to Salvation Army, \$85,000 to Bona Vista, \$10,000 to the Mental Health Association, and \$5,000 to Urban Outreach. Goodfellows also receives corporate and individual donations, which help fund Goodfellows' scholarships and donations to Howard County youth programs, such as CK's Coyote Kids, Special Olympics, and Jim Moose Carden Kids Fishing Clinic.
