
It's March already! The year is 1/6 over. The Club's racing season is under way. Amboy in 2 weeks, Sam Costa in 3, the Rhenda Acton Ultimate Challenge is in 5 weeks! The Mini is just 9 weeks away. The Club has its "Run Up to the Mini" training runs going on right now. The "Run Up" is a free 12 week running program, which increases the distance up to around 10 miles (The Ultimate Challenge) to help get you prepared for the Mini or any spring 1/2 or just get you ready and in better shape for the running season. It takes place in Kokomo at Foster Park on Saturdays at 11 am. Every Saturday from now up to the Mini, on non-race days, the group will be running from the tennis courts at Foster Park and the route will stay in Foster Park, UTC Park and the IHT, no road crossings. With this route everyone will be included and you won't feel left behind.

Also the Club has its weekly Wednesday run in Highland Park at 5:30 pm. You can run as little or as far as you would like. Time yourself and write down how far and how long it took you on the sign in sheet. We'll post it on Facebook for prosperity and accountability.

This distance of route is easily modified if you want.
