Johnathan McQuaide: 2:22.57

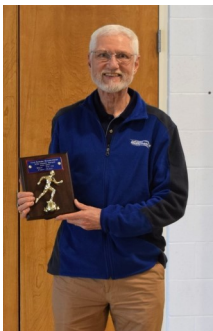
