Colonial Quilter Guild Minutes — General Meeting — December 8, 2015

Guild members gathered at 6:30 to enjoy a delicious dessert provided and served by Darlene Repash, Richele Voice, and Mallory Repash. Many thanks to these ladies!

Call to Order – Meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m. by Vice President Linda Kleppinger. Linda informed the group that President Eugenia Emert apologized for her absence.

Minutes and Correspondence – Corrections to the November minutes were as follows:

- The meeting was not suspended for the bylaw changes but rather it was amended to hold discussion at that time.
- The motion to accept the removal of the bylaw clause concerning Golden members was made by Carol Moll and seconded by Nancy Snow.
- Darlene Repash's and Carolyn Meinhart's names were misspelled.

There being no additional changes, the minutes were approved as amended, motion made by Lois Walters and seconded by Mary Henning. The minutes will be placed on file.

Need to Replace Board Positions – The guild's secretary has resigned and there is an urgent need to nominate and elect a replacement. The job requires that the secretary record minutes of all General Meetings and Board Meetings, submit minutes for both meetings to the President and Newsletter by the appropriate deadline, maintain correspondence, retrieve mail from the Post Office on a regular basis, assist the president in contacting Board members for extra meetings when needed. It is essential that the candidate be proficient with a word processing application on the computer since communications are handled electronically. There were no nominations, so any member interested in serving is asked to contact Eugenia Emert or Lois Walters as soon as possible. Additionally, Darlene Repash will not be able to continue as Program Chair for 2016-17 and asked that interested members consider taking on this responsibility. The Committee can be chaired by an individual or responsibility can be shared among several people.

Treasurer's Report – Betsy Lawrence gave the Treasurer's Report. Beginning balance for the month was \$14,373.18, \$103.75 was received, \$105.10 was disbursed, for a closing balance of \$14,371.83. The Treasurer's Report will be placed on file for audit.

Award Ribbons – Three entries have been received for the ribbons to be awarded at the Spring Quilt Show. Deadline for entering has been extended to the January meeting.

New Members/Guests – 87 members were present, as well as 3 guests. Barbara Smith won the drawing.

JANUARY BLOCK OF THE MONTH: BLAZING ARROWS

Please use black for the background and red solid or print as your color.

Color 1 needs: one 3-1/2" x 14" strip AND one 3-1/2" x 13" strip AND one 7-1/4" square AND one 3-7/8" x 7-Color 2 needs: one 3-1/2" x 14" strip AND one 3-1/2" x 13" strip AND one 7-1/4" square AND one 3-7/8" x 7-Please abide by the Terms and Conditions of use! :0) Start by cutting the Color 1 and Color 2 3-1/2" x 14" strips into four 3-1/2" squares of each... ** Preparing the Pieces and Sewing the Block ** ** Supplies List ** This makes a 12" block ! 3/4" strip 3/4" strip red print or solid top strip black / black Color 2 bottom red Color 1

This is the January newsletter block, to be submitted in February.

Stack the Color 1 and Color 2 7-1/4" squares right sides together and all edges aligned. Cut in half on both diagonals to make four quarter square triangles of each. Sew together two pairs of triangles in the manner shown at left. Sew the pieced triangle units together to make the block's center. The other quarter square triangles are extra and can be saved for another project or another block...

Now cut the Color 1 and Color 2 3-1/2" x 13" strips into two 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles of each...

Next speed piece the half squares, by stacking the Color 1 and Color 2 3-7/8" x 7-3/4" strips, right sides together and all edges aligned. On the back of the top strip, lightly mark the 3-7/8" square line and mark the diagonals in the direction shown at left. Now sew a scant 1/4" above and below the marked diagonals, pivoting at the square line. Now cut apart on the marked diagonals, and on the 3-7/8" square line. This will give you four half squares.

Press seam allowances towards the darker fabric. Trim these back to measure 3-1/2" if needed...

diagonal marking. Cut off the excess seam allowance. Press the remainder towards the corner. To make a side unit, place a Color 2 square right sides together atop a Color 1 rectangle, with Repeat this with another Color 2 square on the other end of the rectangle. Make two of these, outer edges aligned. On the back of the top square lightly mark the diagonal. Sew on this and make two more using Color 1 squares and Color 2 rectangles...
