Colonial Quilters Guild May 2012 April Minutes

Helle May Cheney was introduced by Betsy Lawrence and presented an informative program on "Don't Be Afraid to Show Your Quilt." A trunk show of Helle's quilts illustrated her journey into quilting and provided inspiration to the membership.

The meeting was called to order at 8:10 by president Mary Henning. Two representatives from the church spoke on an event taking place on April 21st to benefit Women At Risk (WAR).

Mary said two members are needed for the following committees: Community Service, Fat Quarters, Library and Block of the Month. Sally Viglione and Rose Macaluso volunteered to cochair Community Service. Bonnie Moor would like to chair Fat Quarters with Tedde Anderson.

Quilt Show - Mary Lou Green and Rita Schmell asked people to sign up to work the show. 12 spaces are open Friday, 39 on Saturday and 36 on Sunday. The sign-in sheets will be on the White Glove Table.

Darlene Repash - 25 days until the show. Check in will be Mary 4th between 12 and 7.

Ruth O'Connell - items for the boutique should be tagged and priced. If you bring containers, please take them home. Pick up is Sunday, May 6th from 5 pm on. Thanks to all those who donated items.

Michele McLaughlin will take over the appraisals for Betsy Golden.

Treasurer - Meg Ferry. If you are selling a quilt, Meg will handle it or if she's not there the quilt maker will. The buyer should make out the check to the quilt maker.

Gail Kromer - Tricky Tray - Now have 50 items. If you have a late contribution contact Barbara or Carol Smith.

Cuyler Augustino - the 195 quilts will start to be picked up at 5 pm on Sunday, May 6th. Must present registration sheet and give written permission if someone else is picking up your quilt.

Lois Walters - Registration - Pick up two cards for each quilt. Pin one to the bottom right of the front of the quilt and the other to the pillowcase. Drop Off will be between 1 and 6 on Friday and a registration slip will be given in exchange for the quilt.

Betsy Lawrence - raffle tickets. Need tickets by the day or on the day of the show. Outstanding tickets can be mailed in to Betsy.

Joan Bellis - passed out papers listing items needed for the café. Bring Friday or Saturday morning before lunch.

Ladders are also needed for those helping with take down.

Secretary - Kathy Boushell - On a motion made by Sharon Enstrom and seconded by Barbara Smith, the minutes of the last meeting were approved as listed in the newsletter.

Treasurer - Linda Kleppinger. Beginning balance - \$1,923.81, incoming funds \$1,743.00, outgoing funds \$2,226.30 for a balance of 14,440.51.

Vice President - Shirley Chiles. 103 members attended the meeting with 1 guest. Evelyn Weidel won the door prize.

Community Service - Felicia Geiter, reminded members to turn in their project. 3 pillowcases and 14 oncology quilts were presented to LV Hosp. A list of the total numbers of projects turned in this year was listed on the board.

Bus Trip - Shopping trip will leave from the church at 7 am on April 14.

Saturday Sewcial - Wendy Harwick - Need volunteers for the programs. The June sew-cial will be a Jelly Roll Race organized and led by Sharon Rehrig.

Open Sew for the summer will be the second Tuesday of July and August. The dates are July 10 and Aug. 14. The open sew is free.

Hospitality - Cathy Harding moved and Delores Bartek has volunteered to head the committee. Library - Rose Klim - \$24.75 (½ of the ticket sales) was won by Sharon Enstrom.

Fat Quarters - Ellie Lazar - winners were Marg Fray, Betsy Lawrence, Conny Schick, Joan Bellis and Gail Kromer. Jean Henning was given a prize from Ellie for handling the drawings in her absence.

BOM - Kathy Kemmerer - 13 blocks were won by Conny Schick.

Mary Henning spoke briefly on a project that LV. Hosp. Cancer Center is doing with signed quilt blocks. They had asked for assistance in making quilts from the blocks. Kathy Kemmerer has volunteered to quilt it. Mary will get more information.

Nominating Committee - Charlene Weis was nominated for treasurer and Cindy Fantasia for Vice-president. Nominations were opened from the floor and none were received.

The next board meeting will be Tuesday, May 1st at Wegman's in Bethlehem.

Bylaws - Sharon Enstrom. On a motion made by Cindy Fantasia and seconded by Carolyn Meinhart it was decided to kill Article IV, Section C as it appeared in the newsletter concerning inactive membership and that Article IV, Section A would be strictly enforced.

Gloria Tarby made a motion which was seconded by Sharon Rehrig to amend the bylaws as follows under Article A. Active Membership

"6. Exemption for these requirements may be permitted by a majority vot of the Executive Board for any member due to <u>temporary</u> illness or unusual circumstance. A member must request an exemption by contacting the Vice President explaining the circumstances.

B. Golden Membership

1. Any member who is 80 years old by the June meeting and has been a member for 15 or more years will no longer be required to pay dues.

C. Honorary Membership

1. Any member of 15 years or more of active service that can no longer fulfill active membership on a permanent basis (after being exempt from the Executive Board, A6) will be placed on the Honorary Membership list. They will be required to pay annual dues (except Golden Membership), receive the newsletter and may attend meetings as able.

Rationale: There are many 80 year old members who are very capable to be active members and enjoy it. Members younger than 80 have given many years of service should not be looked upon in a negative way. They wish to be members but are unable because of their situation. Their dignity should be honored. In this way the Active

Sally Viglione called for a vote on the motion. It was seconded by Grace Crowther. The motion did not pass.

It was suggested that perhaps the guild could have a special meeting to discuss the members' ideas on the bylaws.

Susie Metz made a motion which was seconded by Grace Crowther to leave the bylaws as they currently exists. The motion was voted down

The bylaws and the committee will continue to be reviewed.





Cutting Instructions

Layer Cut Right Sides Together

- (1) 7" square light
- (1) 7" square first dark



- (1) 3 1/2" x 7" light
- (1) 3 1/2" x 7" first medium



- Layer Cut
- (2) 1 3/8" x 45" strips second medium
- (2) 1 3/8" x 45" strips second dark



(4) 3" squares first medium



(1) 3" square first dark




Making Eight




and Four



- 1. Draw on 3 1/2" square lines.
- 2. Draw on diagonal lines. Pin.



3. Sew a 1/4" seam on both sides of the diagonal lines. Press.




- 4. Cut apart on all lines.
- 5. Press the seams to the darker side.
- 6. Square to 3".

Making Four






- 1. Cut a 14" piece from each 45" strip.
- 2. Lay out strips. Discard extras.
- 3. Sew together.



- 4. Press the seams to the darker sides. The sewn together strips should measure no less than 3".
- 5. Flip the shorter set of strips right sides together to the longer set, and nestle the seams together.


 Cut into (4) 1 3/8" sections. These layered sections are ready for sewing.



- 7. Remove the shorter set excess and cut from it an additional (4) 1 3/8" sections.
- Assembly-line sew the layered 1 3/8" sections. Wiggle-match the seams in the center.




- Add a single section, completing each nine-patch.
- 10. Press the seams to the dark side.
- 11. Cut (4) 3" sections.



12. Square to 3", trimming edges equally.

Sewing the Block Together

- 1. Lay out the pieces.
- 2. Sew the vertical and horizontal rows with a 1/4" seam allowance plus two threads.

If you would like a sitting job, we do need people to sit at the voting table for viewers' favorite challenge quilt and show quilt.

Now, please think CAFÉ DONATIONS. All during the day on Friday, May 4, you can bring in items that the Café committee has suggested, including food and condiments and all sorts of things that are related to food service.

Remember that if you are picking up a quilt on Sunday, the quilts will not be organized and ready until 5pm, and a receipt must be presented in order to receive the quilt(s).

Set Up/Take Down

I will look forward to seeing you on Friday beginning at 11 AM. Stay for as much time as you can to get the job done. Come well equipped with patience and good humor.

Sunday take down will begin promptly at 4 PM. Please, anyone who can help, come. Instructions will be given then.

Lois will be accepting quilts beginning at 1PM until 6 PM on Friday in the hallway outside of the gym. You <u>must</u> have your tags properly placed and get a receipt for the quilts. You must also note on the receipt the name of anyone else who might be picking your quilts up.

Quilt pick up on Sunday will begin at 5:00PM. Bring your receipt. You will wait in the hall, lining up at the farthest door of the gym (the door closest to the rear exit in the hall, or by the Book Nook if you were in the gym). There Lois and friends will check your receipt and send a few people in at a time to collect and check your quilts at the pick up area (formerly the Book Nook). When you have checked your quilts you will leave through the same door, letting Lois know you are leaving, so she can send the next person in. Be Patient! The safety and welfare of your quilts is our goal.
