- Conduct stakeholder seminar to discuss and endorse recommendations from the review and assessments of existing land use planning regulation, EIA regulation and EPPA and other relevant laws and regulations
- Conduct high level stakeholder meeting to present and endorse the Guidelines for Climate Risk Resilient Coastal Protection in the Maldives

#### IV. INDICATIVE TASKS

The consultant's work will include but not be limited to the following:

- Identify stakeholders and island communities most relevant for understanding, discussing and evaluating the situation with respect to integrating climate change risks into resilient island planning
- Conduct field visits to discuss and analyse situation with respect to coastal protection, harbour development, land reclamation, flood and drainage control from the perspective of integrating climate change risks. Field visits will include 2 islands in each of the following 4 atolls; Haa Dhaalu, Kaafu, Dhaalu and Gaafu Dhaalu. Domestic travel cost only will be borne by the ICCRRIP Project.
- Specify climate change resilience and risk assumptions requiring guidance support and seek agreement.
- Review of coastal protection issues
- Review existing land use planning regulation, EIA regulation, EIA process, Environmental Protection and Preservation Act, Land Act and regulations, and the guidelines on land reclamation, harbor development and coastal protection measures from a climate change risks and adaptation planning perspective
- Review of reports from Detailed Island Risk Assessments in the Maldives (DIRAM), cost benefit analysis of 3 islands, coastal monitoring reef island shoreline dynamics and management implications, survey on adaptation measures and other studies to feed into land use planning regulation amendments
- Identify land use practices that reduce natural resilience of the islands and increase vulnerabilities to climate change risks
- Review, assess and analyze various coastal protection measures and practices in the Maldives and other small islands like Maldives including conventional adaptation, soft adaptation and traditional measures.
- Review and assess the costs and benefits of different options for reducing vulnerability of current and future climate change risks through land use planning measures such as maintaining and restoring natural buffers (e.g. coastal ridges, beach rock, coastal vegetation) and critical infrastructure based on projected patterns of flooding and beach and coastal erosion
- Prepare a summary of findings and recommendations on the issues, identifying weaknesses and malpractices and social and economic costs and benefits associated with old and new coastal development and protection practices.
- Provide necessary amendments to the Land Use Planning Regulation by defining the environmental protection zone in the context of climate risk resilience in the Maldives
- Provide guidance based on function, design and management of

environmental protection zone to increase climate risks resilience of islands

- Provide necessary guidance and propose amendments to land use planning and EIA regulation, EIA process and EPA as necessary to better address climate change adaptation in the Maldives.
- Provide standards for best practices in coastal development activities undertaken by various sectors such as tourism, fisheries and others.
- Produce a document on guidelines for climate risk resilient coastal protection in the Maldives that can be endorsed at highest political level
- Prepare a draft document and organize and conduct a half day seminar to present the findings to the stakeholders and policy makers for discussion and comment.
- Produce final document on Guidelines for Climate Risk Resilient Coastal Protection in the Maldives

### TERMS OF REFERENCE: Consultancy for formulation of Guidelines for Climate Risk Resilient Coastal Protection in the Maldives

#### I. INTRODUCTION AND BACKGROUND

The Ministry of Housing and Environment in collaboration with UNDP is implementing the first climate adaptation project, Integrating Climate Change Risks into Resilient Island Planning in the Maldives (ICCRRIP) under the National Adaptation Programme of Action. The project is funded by the Least Development Country Fund and UNDP, and is co-financed by the Government of Maldives. The overall goal of the project is to increase the resilience of the Maldives in the face of climate change and improve the country's capacity to respond effectively to climate related hazards. In addition, the project aims to ensure that climate change risks are integrated into resilient island planning and that national, provincial, atoll and island authorities, and communities are able to prioritize and implement climate change adaptation measures.

Currently there are no written guidelines on how to build climate change resilience into erosion control, land reclamation or harbour development. Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) requirements are generic. Various studies such as Detail Island Risk Assessment in the Maldives (DIRAM) make recommendations on good and bad practices.

The consultant will work closely with the Environment Protection Agency (EPA) and other relevant agencies to address gaps in technical knowledge and know-how on how best to plan and develop harbours, conduct land reclamation, other major developments and manage coastal erosion in a changing climate without increasing vulnerability. Current coastal zone management practices will be reviewed to assess their implications for strengthening or reducing climate resilience. Comprehensive technical guidelines on climate change resilient coastal protection, with separate chapters on climate change resilient harbour development, land reclamation and coastal erosion control will be produced and finalized through stakeholder consultations with relevant national, atoll and island authorities and sector specialists. The Project will build on studies undertaken on erosion by EPA, the ICCRRIP project and the Maldives Environment Management Project (MEMP).

#### II. OBJECTIVE

The objective of this consultancy is to formulate a guidelines document for climate risk resilient coastal protection planning in the Maldives. These guidelines should be formulated through participatory approach and recommend amendments to the Land Use Planning and Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) regulations and Environment Protection and Preservation Act (EPPA) of Maldives, National Building Code and Maldives National Building Act and Maldives Land Act as necessary to better address climate change adaptation and provide pragmatic evidence based advocacy for high level political endorsement for the coastal protection guidelines document.

#### III. SCOPE OF WORK

- Source, define and obtain agreement for the development targets to be achieved with respect to climate change resilience and risk mitigation and the climate change risk scenarios to be considered in the guidelines document.
- Assess past and current development practices and coastal protection measures that have had negative impacts such as the reduced natural resilience of the islands and increased vulnerability of the islands to climate change risks
- Review the existing coastal development planning process, engineering designs and, construction implementation and monitoring processes and practices for high, medium and low impact coastal developments from a climate risk planning perspective. These include land reclamation, harbour development, erosion prevention and other coastal protection measures.
- Review the existing EIA process and other policy and legal frameworks for coastal development planning and implementation.
- Formulate objectively verifiable, quantitative standards for coastal land use with respect to coastal development including safe setbacks, land reclamation, infrastructure etc. For example setting a minimum elevation with respect to the high wave energy zone.
- Provide an objective quantitative performance monitoring and evaluation framework for monitoring delivery of the proposed standards.
- Carry out stakeholder consultations to gather information and views.

- Develop the program aims, intended audience, learning outcomes, methods of delivery (appropriate balance between theory and practice), and comprehensive outline of the core training subjects.
- Propose contact between training periods such as assignment and/or small project.
- Develop an indicative book list/ resources/ materials/ for the core subject areas.
- Deliver training 5 trainings at 4 months apart.
- Provide recommendation on the appropriate facilities needed for the training.

## 8. DELIVERABLES

The GIS Service Training Provider shall provide a:

**Final Negotiated Training Program Outline:** The final negotiated GIS User Training program outline shall be submitted not later than 2 weeks prior to the commencement of the assignment. The Final Negotiated Outline should include but is not limited to:

- (i) Aims, intended audience, learning outcomes, methods of delivery, and comprehensive outline of the core subjects; and
- (ii) Indicative book list/ resources/ materials/ equipments for the core subject areas.

**Delivery of GIS User Training:** Five Training should be delivered at 4 months intervals.

**Assessment Report:** A brief report shall be submitted within 5 days following each GIS User Training Session. The assessment should include but is not limited to successes and difficulties in achieving learning outcomes.

## 9. QUALIFICATION CRITERIA

To be eligible for this assignment the Training Service Provider must demonstrate the past experience delivering NGIS hardware, processes and software.

The proposed training instructors (or individual consultant) should meet the following criteria.

- A recognized degree or higher in GIS/Remote Sensing or a similar related field from a tertiary institution.
- Previous experience teaching GIS/Remote or equivalent experience to undertake the assignment;
- A high level of knowledge of NGIS hardware and operating platforms, and high level knowledge of ESRI ArcGIS is 10 is essential.
- Fluent in written and spoken English;
- Excellent interpersonal skills and demonstrated ability to communicate with project stakeholders is essential.

## 10. REPORTING

The consultant is expected to work closely with the Spatial Planning Unit counterpart and will report directly to Section Head, Spatial Planning Unit or his/her designate during the assignment.

**6. OBJECTIVES OF ASSIGNMENT**

The objective of the assignment is to deliver a GIS User training program which reflects the needs of users and end users of the NGIS being implemented in the Maldives to be delivered in accordance with the time schedule specified.

**7. TASKS OF THE CONSULTANT**

The tasks to be undertaken by the consultant under this outline Terms of Reference are to be undertaken in close collaboration with the Spatial Planning Section, and relevant stakeholders as necessary, and include, but are not necessarily limited to, the following:

## **Metadata Standards**

For metadata, the international ISO 19115 standard for metadata should be adopted. ISO 19115 defines the schema required for describing geographic information and services. It provides information about the identification, the extent, the quality, the spatial and temporal schema, spatial reference, and distribution of digital geographic data. ISO 19115:2003 is applicable to:

- cataloguing of datasets, clearinghouse activities, and the full description of datasets; and
- geographic datasets, dataset series, and individual geographic features and feature properties.

Though ISO 19115 is applicable to digital data, its principles can be extended to many other forms of geographic data, such as maps, charts, and textual documents as well as non-geographic data.

## **Platform Sizing**

In year 1, it is estimated that a total of 12 peak concurrent users would connect to the NGIS. Five users from SPS would connect using ArcGIS Desktop. For EPA, one user would connect using ArcGIS Desktop whereas another two would connect using ArcGIS Desktop through WTS. The same would apply for the three MRC users. In the case of ES, only one user is forecasted to access the NGIS with ArcGIS Desktop through WTS.

At the end of Year 2, the first set of web-based GIS applications should be ready for integration testing (i.e., deployed the test/staging server for testing) with follow-on software development life cycle (e.g., user acceptance testing and deployment to production) activities in Year 3. It is anticipated that 15 peak concurrent users would be accessing several candidate web-based applications. The key participating agencies, led by the SPS, will propose one or more web-based GIS application to be considered for development to the GIS Steering Committee. With approval from the GIS Steering Committee, software development professional services will be procured for the development of the web-based GIS applications.

## **Hardware**

The procurement of hardware and installations for the NGIS includes firewalls, reverse proxy server, MAN remote site connections, Windows Terminal Server (WTS), Geo-database Server, and workstations) have been completed.

## **Software**

The current version of ESRI ArcGIS is 10 has been procured and installed for the NGIS. All software installations in the local systems have been completed.

## **Geo-database**

The design of geo-database strategies that will enable migration and integration of current data held by stakeholders, taking account of future data migration needs, and which are compatible with end user needs have been completed.

## **GIS User training**

It is proposed that the GIS User training will be delivered in 2 x two week blocks **four months** apart over the next two years.

The GIS User Training Program should incorporate both overall GIS user skill development in combination with the skills users and end users required in order to participate in the NGIS implementation. The main focuses of the skills GIS users require in order to participate in implementation of the NGIS are:

- NGIS Governance and structure and operating systems.
- Data creation, databases management, and migration and integration of databases.
- Web-base application, internet mapping and services, and GPS data collection and processing etc.
- Remote sensing and digitizing base data from remote sensing imagery.

Possible training program subjects and modules are provided below but are provided for guidance and are indicative only:

- Island Allocation Web Viewer: Display island usage (e.g., fisheries vs. agriculture)
- Project Web Viewer: Displays location and status of various development projects in the Maldives.
- Remote Sensing Imagery Viewer: Displays aerial and satellite imagery and allows users to select and download areas of interest.

At a minimum and above the basic navigation capabilities, for any application, a user should be able to draw and measure distance and calculate area.

### User Workflows

GIS technology is not widely used in the Maldives and as a result, it is a difficult task for the key participating agencies to describe how GIS is planned to be used within their agencies given their limited exposure to GIS. Nonetheless, the common requirement expressed by the key participating agencies was the ability to discover and access geospatial data from other agencies, manage geospatial data, and create map products using external data sources and their own data. Although the ability to deal with three-dimensional data, specifically visualize these types of data, and perform spatial analysis (e.g., buffering, search by location) was expressed on several occasions, map authoring constitutes the primary user workflow.

The SPS is responsible for managing and distributing official government geospatial data from other line agencies and as such, will be required to perform multiple diverse GIS functions, such as advanced data management and editing, map authoring and publishing, and spatial analysis.

In the case of the EPA, will mostly use GIS for basic data conversion and creation, and map authoring. The same software recommendations are made for the EPA and MRC.

The ES is anticipated to use the NGIS on a relatively infrequent basis considering that many of its “doing” or implementing agencies have been re-organized and now fall under the EPA. Based on feedback from this agency, it is anticipated that users involved with policy development may occasionally need to search and view maps that are related to the Maldives.

### Platform Configuration

A two-tier architecture, which includes GIS server and data platforms, is recommended. The Web server and GIS server components are located on the GIS server platform and the data server is located on a separate data server platform.

### Data Standards

Currently, there are no data standards in place for the NGIS. It has been recommended that a GIS Steering Committee be established and under its authority, a technical working group be established to focus on the development of data standards for the NGIS. As an example, islands are coded currently using multiple different feature codes by various agencies. In practice, all islands should be coded using the same classification scheme. A data standard for coding islands should be developed by a technical working group, approved and endorsed by the GIS Steering Committee, and put into effect by all key participating agencies.

#### **4. IMPLEMENTATION OF THE NATIONAL GEOGRAPHIC INFORMATION SYSTEM (NGIS) STRATEGY**

The system design assumes a phased-in approach, meaning that the implementation of the NGIS will be in stages or phases, taking place over several years. This approach implies that the necessary hardware, software, and professional consulting services will be procured on a yearly basis.

**Year 1** focuses on the following key tasks or activities: (1) creating a NGIS steering committee, its governance structure, and operating procedures; (2) establishing the base NGIS infrastructure (i.e., servers, workstations, and software); and (3) training key SPS, EPA, MRC, and ES staff with the use of GIS. At the end of Year 1, the NGIS will be accessible by the key participating agencies, thereby meeting the requirement set by the MEMP for the SPS to provide access to user-friendly GIS platforms.

**Year 2** focuses on the following key tasks or activities: (1) creating metadata for existing SPS base data; (2) converting and loading SPS and key participating agency spatial data into the NGIS geo-database and making it accessible; (3) digitizing new base data from the Quickbird remotely sensed imagery; (4) continuing user training; (5) updating the NGIS infrastructure in preparation to support web-based GIS applications; and (6) procuring and starting the development of the first few web-based GIS applications.

**Year 3** focuses on the following key tasks or activities: (1) creating metadata for spatial data from external agencies (i.e., agencies that were not within the original scope); (2) loading spatial data from external agencies into the NGIS geo-database; (3) continuing user training; (4) completing the development and implementation of the Phase 1 web-based GIS applications; and (5) starting the development of the Phase 2 web-based GIS applications.

#### **5. OVERVIEW OF SYSTEM ARCHITECTURE DESIGN**

##### **NGIS Governance**

The NGIS is governed by a GIS Steering Committee. The role of the NGIS Steering Committee is to provide direction and oversight for the development and implementation of the NGIS. Moreover, it provides a forum for agencies to discuss current and planned NGIS-related activities (e.g., data collection or upcoming workshops) with one another. The NGIS Steering Committee should meet at a minimum twice a year, about six months apart, to ensure that all agencies are kept abreast of the current status of the development and implementation of the NGIS.

It is envisioned that it will be the role of the NGIS Steering Committee to authorize the establishment and dissolution of technical working groups (WGs) to address specific technical needs and concerns. It is recommended that a technical WG be established as soon as possible to focus on the development of GIS data standards for the NGIS (e.g., island feature coding and cartographic standards). Another may be established on applications of GIS to share experiences to be reported throughout the Government.

##### **GIS Applications**

Once the NGIS has been established and data loaded into its data warehouse, the SPS envisions making several geospatial data types available for access and potentially download through the Internet. Specifically, the SPS foresees developing the following five web-based GIS applications:

- Census Web Viewer: Display census data (e.g., income level) online that are collected by the Statistics Section of the DNP.
- Infrastructure Web Viewer: Display location of national infrastructure (e.g., which islands have fuel stores or hospitals)

## **1. BACKGROUND**

The Government of the Republic of Maldives has received Credit from the International Development Association (IDA) towards the cost of the Maldives Environmental Management Project, under the contract for the services of a Training Service Provider to deliver a GIS user training program in the Maldives.

Maldives Environmental Management Project (MEMP) was approved by the Board of Directors of the World Bank on June 10, 2008.
