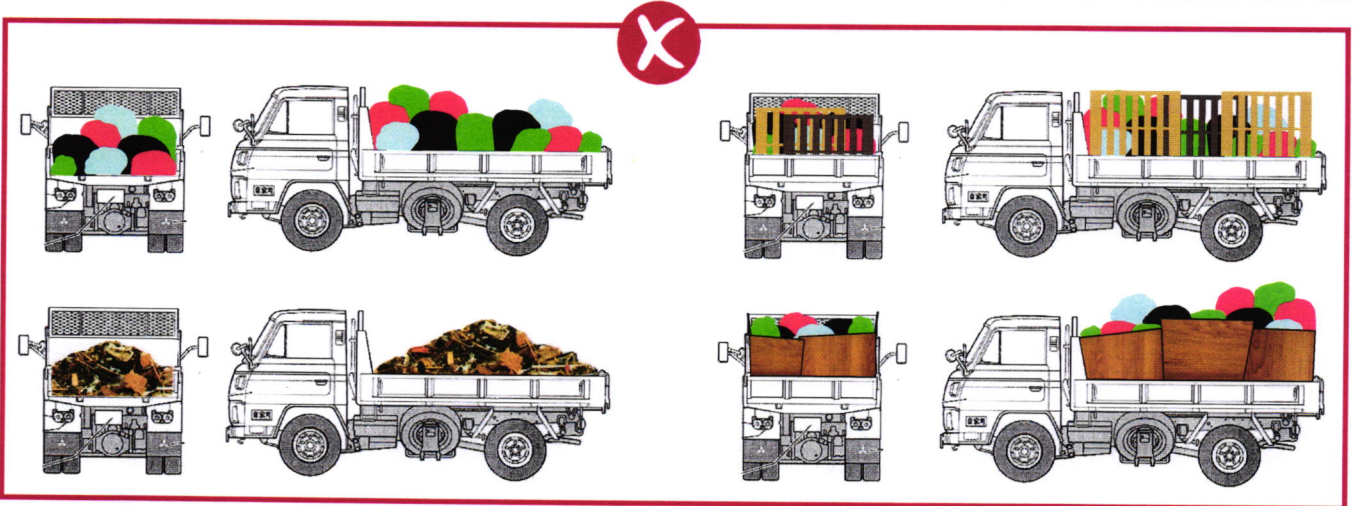
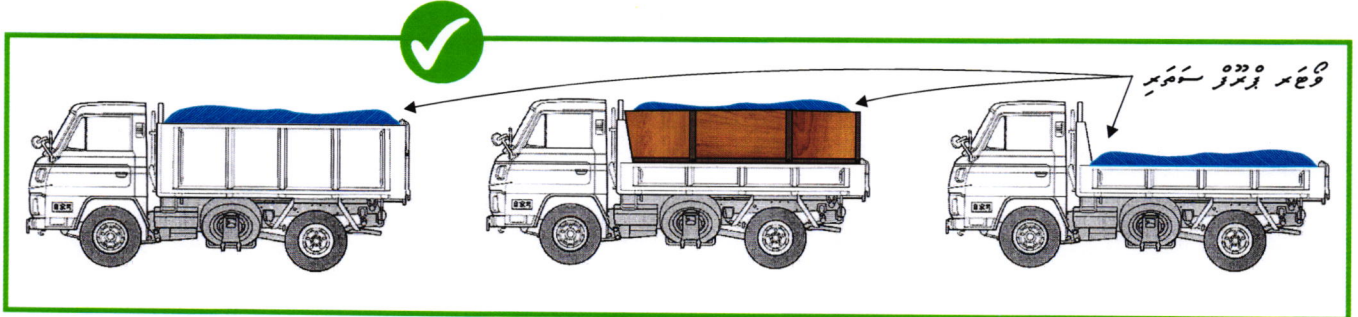

• Waste must be loaded in a way that it does not protrude from the back of the truck.

• Cargo must be secured with straps to prevent shifting and falling during transport.

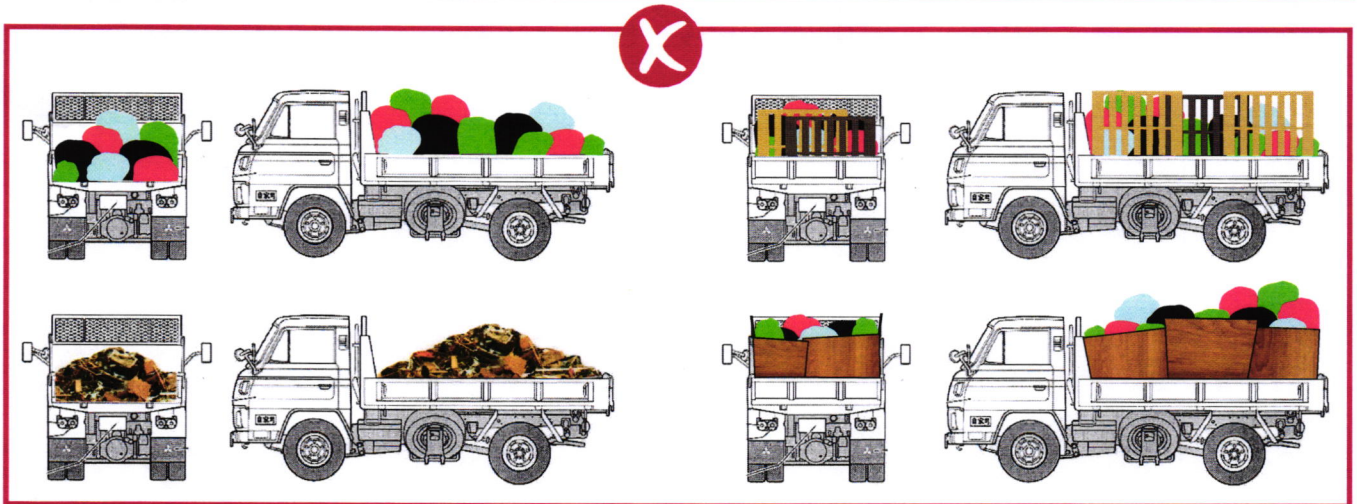
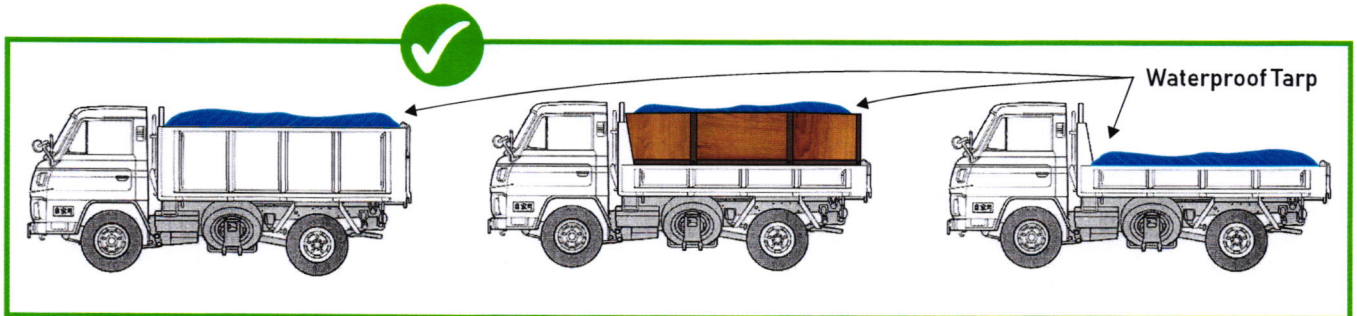

STANDARDS FOR VEHICLES THAT TRANSPORT WASTE

WASTE MANAGEMENT REGULATION 2013/R-58



- Waste will need to be covered by a waterproof tarp or equivalent covering at all times during transport.
- Vehicles specific to carrying waste should not use materials such as a loose sheets/pallets as siding.
- Vehicles that transport dusty/muddy/wet waste, construction debris or soil should be designed as such that there is no leakage on to the road during transport.

After 1st May 2018 Action will be taken against violators of this standard
