


Entry Criteria

- 1.Officer in charge of a Navigational Watch on ships of 500 gross tonnage or more OR
- 2. Masters and Chief Mates on ships of 3000 gross tonnage or more OR
- 3. Masters and Chief Mates on ships between 500 and 3000 gross tonnage OR
- 4. Masters and *OOW of ships less than 500 gross tonnage AND
- 5. a. Have completed Radar Navigation at Operational Level (RADAR/ARPA)
 - b. Have at least 3 months of bridge watch keeping service
 - c. Have considerable familiarization with personal computing operation systems, keyboards and mice or trackballs
