Principals / managers if they are coming to witness the carnival are welcome but they have to make their own arrangement outside the campus.(Enjoy food with participants). No Alcohol drinks or smoking inside the venue.

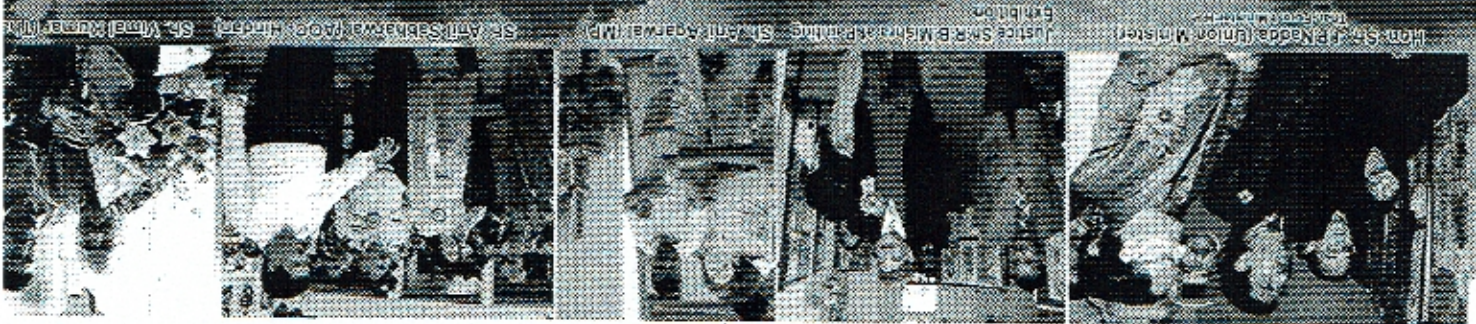
