Terms of Reference (TOR) for Designing High Fidelity Testable User Interface for Court Websites

BACKGROUND:

The aim of this project is to enhance the user experience and functionality of court websites by designing high fidelity testable user interfaces. Court websites serve as vital platforms for disseminating information, providing services, and facilitating communication between the court system and the public. To ensure effectiveness and efficiency, it is essential to improve the usability and accessibility of these websites.

OBJECTIVES:

- To design high fidelity testable user interfaces for court websites.
- To identify areas for improvement by evaluating existing court websites.
- To gather feedback and requirements from court staff regarding additional features and functionalities for the websites.

SCOPE OF WORK:

- The scope of work includes, but is not limited to:

DELIVERABLES:

- High fidelity prototypes of redesigned user interfaces for court websites.
- Testable prototypes for usability testing and evaluation.
- Final report summarizing the design process, key findings, recommendations, and guidelines for implementation.

METHODOLOGY:

The following methodology will be adopted for the project:

- Review of existing court websites to evaluate usability, accessibility, and functionality.
- Interviews and consultations with court staff to gather insights and feedback.
- Iterative design process incorporating feedback and requirements into the prototypes.
- Usability testing of prototypes to validate design decisions and identify areas for improvement.
