TERMS OF REFERENCE

1. Introduction

The Maldives Integrated Tourism Development Corporation Ltd. (MITDC), a 100% Maldivian Government owned corporation has been established in 2016 and has been mandated with the development of integrated tourism in the Maldives.

The Maldives Integrated Tourism Development Corporation (MITDC) is seeking a qualified and experienced party to conduct a comprehensive assessment of the Tourist Village development project on the island of Kaashidhoo.

2. Project Background

- **Project Name:** Kaashidhoo Tourist Village Development
- Location: Kaashidhoo, Maldives
- Development Area: 200,000 square feet.
- **Structures Planned:** 13 prefabricated structures (10 guesthouses, 3 service buildings)
- **Status:** Structural frames for 2 service buildings and 1 guesthouse erected in 2017; progress halted
- Current Condition: Structures have sustained damage due to vandalism

3. Objectives of the Assessment

The assessment's main objective is to provide a detailed evaluation of the current state of the project and outline the necessary steps to resume and complete the development. The assessment should include:

1. Structural Integrity Evaluation:

- Inspect and assess the condition of the existing prefabricated structures.
- o Identify any damage or deterioration, including those caused by vandalism.

• Provide recommendations for repairs or reinforcements needed.

2. Site Assessment:

- Evaluate the overall condition of the site, including environmental and infrastructural aspects.
- Identify any new requirements or changes in site conditions since the project was halted.

3. Project Plan Review:

- 2. Expertise in structural engineering and prefabricated building systems.
- 3. Knowledge of construction project management and risk assessment.
- 4. Familiarity with local building codes and regulations in the Maldives.
- 5. Strong analytical and report-writing skills.
