Water Filter / Dispenser Specification

1. The Dispenser Should Have Room Temp, Cold and Hot Water Out Let With Indicators.
2. Capacity Should Not Be Less Than 10 L (Combined)
3. The System Should Be Able To Filter 6 L Per Hour (Variable's Acceptable During Evaluation)
4. Connection To Tap Water.
5. System Should Have Easy Filter Replacement Option.
6. System Should Withstand Erosion
7. Systems Filter Should Be Able To Extract & Remove Chemicals, Toxins Etc. (but not limited to) Chloride, Pesticides, Germs, Rust, Sand, Odor, Mud, Sediments, & Other Particles Or Heavy Metals From Water.

Supplier To Comply For The Following Works

1. Supplier Should Be Able To Supply & Install The System In 45 Days After Confirmation (Variable's Acceptable During Evaluation)
2. Supplier Should Install The Dispensers

Supplier To Submit These Information:

1. Supplier Should Provide A Minimum Of 6 Months Warranty
2. Supplier Should Either Be An Authorized Supplier Of The System Or Should Have Own Service / Repair Center.
3. Supplier Should Be Some One Who Has Part Experience In Such Systems & Imports / Stocks Replacements Parts.
4. Supplier To Submit Filtration Details & Certifications.
5. Supplier To Submit Proposed Filter / Dispenser Specifications In Detail.
6. Supplier To State Pricing Of Replacement Filters & Estimated Replacement Time Frame.
