TERMS OF REFERENCE

Consultancy Services for the Development of an Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) for the Installation of an Incineration Plant at Fuvahmulah City

1. INTRODUCTION

The Government of the Republic of Maldives is working to establish a proper and an efficient waste management system in all islands in Maldives and in this regard the Ministry of Environment plans to establish an Incineration Plant and construct an auxiliary facility at Fuvahmulah City Island to support the island to enhance and improve the current condition of the waste management in the island.

Hence, the Ministry of Environment intends to procure the services of a consultant/ firm to carry out an Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) and produce a report based on the findings for Fuvahmulah City for the proposed works as mentioned above.

Carrying out an Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) is a legal requirement for the development projects that may have any undesirable impact on the environment. As per the Environmental Impact Assessment Regulation 2012, Installation of Incinerators is listed as one of the activities where an Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) is compulsory.

2. OBJECTIVE

The overall objective of the project is to support the island in managing the wastes in the island for a maximum extent of best practical. However, the specific objective of this assignment is to ensure that the installation of an incinerator do not pose major irreversible impacts on the island environment and as well as negative health effects to the residents of the island. The assignment will also ensure the project is in compliance with the existing relevant laws and regulations.

3. SCOPE OF WORKS

The assignment includes;

Preparation of the Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) report for the proposed installation at Fuvahmulah City Island;

The Consultant shall produce EIA through consultative process in accordance with EIA regulation 2012. Consultation shall be made with but not necessarily limited to; Ministry of Environment, City Council of Fuvahmulah City and where necessary community consultation shall also be undertaken. The tasks to be undertaken by the consultancy firm under this Terms of Reference are to be managed in close collaboration with PMU of the Ministry of Environment, and include but are not necessarily limited to the following:

The overall tasks to be undertaken not necessarily limited to, the following include;

- Undertake the application process for the EIA and EMP works of the assignment
- Undertake the scoping or screening whatever is applicable for the assignment
- Undertake field data collection survey and develop the EIA report as per the approved Terms of Reference by Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) of the Maldives after the scoping meeting.
- Submit draft report to the Ministry for review before submitting to EPA for decision,
- Submit the final EIA Report to EPA and obtain approval/decision statement
- Undertake submission and provide any clarifications where as necessary to the submitted EIA report
- Accommodate any request by PMU/ME for any additional information regarding the submitted EIA report.
- Baseline data collection must focus on key issues needing to be examined for the EIA. Consideration of likely monitoring requirements should be borne in mind during survey planning, so that the data collected is suitable for use as a baseline for impacts monitoring.
- All available data from previous and present studies, if available should be presented.

The Project will support the development of a full Environmental Impact Assessment in accordance with the Maldives Environmental Impact Assessment Regulations (2012). The final EIA Report will be submitted to the Maldives Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) for their respective concurrence.

4. Deliverables

The consultant is required to submit the following

1. Final EIA report
2. Raw data set. These data are collected for and during the assessment

6. SIMILAR ASSIGNMENTS

To be eligible for this assignment, the consultant must demonstrate past experience in performing the services (description of similar assignments, Value of such assignments). The Consultant shall have carried out a minimum of three (03) similar assignments.

7. QUALIFICATIONS OF TEAM

The Consultant should submit full CV's for each of the proposed staff members highlighting the criteria given below.

a. EIA Consultant

Main EIA consultant must have to be a registered consultant at Environment Protection Agency (EPA) of the Maldives, should hold a valid license to carry out EIAs in the Maldives.

9. PAYMENT

Payment will be in accordance with the schedule specified below;

10. STANDARD OF REPORT

All documentation must be developed according to the guidelines provided in the Environment Impact Assessment Regulations, 2012 and amendments and report writing guidelines provided by EPA. The report shall fulfil both, the specific requirements outlined in the project TOR approved by EPA.

11. DURATION

- The consultant shall complete the EIA assignment by 45 days from the date of signing the contract.
- A detailed work schedule should be given which demonstrates the commencement and completion date.
- Consultant's project duration shall start from the date of contract signing. Please note that the project duration shall NOT commence from the date of TOR approval by EPA. Therefore it is the consultant's responsibility to expedite the process of EIA application submission, follow up on scoping meeting, draft TOR submission, and follow up on TOR approval, obtain and address the queries made by the EIA reviewers and follow up on the EIA review and approval process.
- Consultant's project duration shall be completed on the date of EIA approval by EPA, i.e. release of EIA Decision Statement. It is the consultant's responsibility to expedite the process of EIA draft submission to the client, final EIA report submission to PMU/ME, providing additional information to PMU/ME if required, and follow up with PMU/ME on EIA approval.
- The consultants are required to consult with the relevant stakeholders such as but not limited to; Island Council, Island Community members
- Any delays in failing to meet the deadlines provided by the consultant's duration will result in Liquidated Damages (LD) calculated below.

The delay rate per day for liquidation damages shall be calculated as follows; for a maximum of 15% of the bidder's price. In the case of unapproved time delays extending beyond 07 days, the Client reserves the right to terminate the Agreement and execute the remainder of the works with another Consultant. Any additional costs resulting from the termination of this agreement shall be paid by the Consultant and may be deducted from any amounts owed to the Consultant.

RW / CD x 0.75 Where;

RW = Remaining works (i.e Total Contract Price Less Value of Certified Works)

CD = Total Contract Duration.

If the delays are due to issues which could not be influenced by the consultant, i.e. delays due to PMU/ME and/or delays due to the client, in order to negate the LD charges; the consultant is to provide sufficient paper work evidence to justify the consultant has done his/her responsibilities to the best of his/her abilities.
