Procurement specialist Consultant for APVAX Project

- 1- The Government of the Republic of Maldives (GoM) (the “Client”) has been allocated grant funds (the “Grant”) from Special Funds resources (Asian Development Fund), administered by the Asian Development Bank (ADB) and executed by the Ministry of Finance. The Client intends to apply the funds towards the cost of the Responsive COVID-19 Vaccination for Recovery Project under ADB’s Asia Pacific Vaccine Access Facility (APVAX), and intends to apply part of the funds for the payment of services of a Procurement Specialist Consultant – Intermittent.
- 2- The selected candidate will directly work under the Project Manager as the Procurement Specialist Consultant of the Project Management Unit (PMU). The purpose of the assignment is to carry out the procurement processes under the approved US\$10 million grant project. The Procurement Specialist Consultant will work intermittently, follow ADB procurement guidelines, rules and regulations, use standard bidding documents, and work under the guidance of the Project Manager and Project Director in close collaboration with the relevant units of the Ministry of Health. The Procurement Specialist will report to the Project Manager.
- 3- The consultant should possess a post-graduate degree in Procurement, Project Management, Supply Chain Management and Logistics, or a related field, with at least five (5) years of experience in reputed organizations. At least three (3) years of experience undertaking procurement-related activities in national/international projects is an advantage. Experience working in donor-funded projects, including ADB, World Bank or JICA projects, will be an added advantage. Regional/country experience is required.
- 4- Interested candidates shall submit their EOI online through the ADB Consultant Management System (CMS) – Consulting Services Recruitment Notices (CSRN), in accordance with the instructions contained therein. All other forms of submission, including hard copy, will not be considered for evaluation. The submission deadline and applicable remuneration will be stated in the official recruitment notice.
