1. INTRODUCTION

Maldives Transport Authority (MTA) is seeking Flag State Surveyors for the administration. Surveyor is responsible for conducting flag state surveys independently. Primary function is to examine and report on vessels and other marine structures during and after construction relative to compliance with the applicable requirements for maintaining the vessel and meeting associated statutory and special service requirements related to Safety of Life at Sea, Load line, Tonnage, Cargo Gear, and Pollution Prevention certification etc.

2. REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS AND WORK EXPERIENCE

1. Bachelor's degree or higher in Naval Architecture from a reputed university or equivalent; or Bachelor's degree or higher in Marine Engineering from a reputed University or equivalent; or Minimum five (5) years of relevant work experience in a Classification Society or equivalent, or;

Certificate of competency as Chief Engineer (Class I) with minimum six (6) months sailing experience as a Chief Engineer, or Certificate of competency as Master Mariner (Class I) with minimum six (6) months sailing experience as a Master, and;

- have successfully completed a recognized ISM course, and;
 - have successfully completed a recognized PSC course, and;
 - have successfully completed a recognized ISPS course, and;
 - have successfully completed a recognized Maritime Labor Convention (MLC) 2006 training course, and;
 - have successfully completed approved training course in MARPOL and Environment Management System, and;
2. must possess proficiency in the English language and be able to demonstrate competency with the scope of statutory certification, and;
 3. should not be a surveyor in any RO (recognized organization or classification society), and;

3. DURATION

To be decided by the administration and the surveyor



4. MANDATORY QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENT

- The applicant shall have the necessary technical maritime expertise back ground mentioned in the required qualification and work experience area mentioned in clause 2.
- CV's of the above expertise available shall be attached with the profile document.
- Failure to provide the evidence of qualification and experience mentioned in clause 2 shall result in rejection of the applicant.

5. REMUNERATION

Will be decided by the by the administration.

- Letter requesting as a Flag State Surveyor.
- Copy of national identity card or passport.
- Copies of academic certificates.
- Copies of the CoC and CDC if any
- Copies of all IMO and maritime educational and technical courses mentioned in clause 2
- Profile and Portfolio of the type of survey conducted for the past 5 years if any
- Curriculum Vitae (CV)

All eligible surveyors will be selected through an interview conducted by the administration.
