MAIN DUTIES TO BE PERFORMED:

Under the direct supervision and guidance of the Director of Safe Mother Hood and Reproductive Health Unit of the Health Protection Agency, the incumbent will be responsible to carry out the following tasks:

- 1. Provide overall technical support for implementation of Safe Motherhood action plan, Develop a detailed operational plan, design and coordinate the implementation of activities to harmonize, strengthen and build the capacity of health service providers (doctors, nurses, health workers) working in maternal child health area.
- Support the implementation of activities and coordination from central level to roll out to Regional level and Atoll and Health centre level
- 3. Strengthen the mechanism of Birth pre-paredness plan for each pregnant woman and early identification referral of high-risk pregnancies
- 4. Work with relevant stakeholders and partners to strengthen the monitoring and tracking of key maternal child and nutrition coverage indicators.
- 5. Systemized monitoring of maternal and perinatal death monitoring surveillance and response system, and strengthen monitoring of maternal and infant deaths, near miss, and maternal morbidity Enhance existing medical stock management system
- Conduct orientation and periodic online sessions for RH focal points in Atolls and supportive supervision of Regional Atoll and Island Hospitals
- 7. Strengthen mechanism to provide outreach from atoll and regional health facilities to health centres by MCH specialist team.
- 8. Support the development of monitoring tool to track implementation through the platforms, supervise and monitor the implementation progress
- 9. Documentation of all activities conducted under the Safe motherhood action plan
