PROGRAMME BACKGROUND

Teacher capacity building has been given a high priority in the revised Inclusive Education (IE) Policy (2020) and the Strategic Action Plan drawn for 2021 to 2025 by the Department of Inclusive Education (DoIE). In this regard, one of the pillars of IE policy emphasizes in building a confident, skilled and capable workforce whereas two goals of Strategic Action Plan, goal 4 and 6, underline activities for building teacher capacity based on inclusive pedagogy and develop procedures and guidelines for teacher registration/licensing programme. More specifically, the IE policy denotes implementation of Universal Design for Learning, Co-Teaching Model and Differentiated Instructions as inclusive pedagogy which are evidence based approaches leading to equitable quality inclusive education.

Pre-service teacher training programmes can lead to develop skilled and vigilant workforce by laying a robust foundation. Therefore, during the initial phase of IE policy implementation, it is crucial to review current IE related modules conduct at various colleges and universities in the Maldives and develop a comprehensive module by aligning to the key documents. This would indeed open doors for both DoIE and higher education providers to work collaboratively so that a better workforce with inclusive mindset and skills can be developed by cultivating an inclusive culture within institution at large.

The objectives of the intervention are:

1) To revise inclusive education modules conduct at colleges and universities in the Maldives and make the module mandatory for all pre-service teachers.

The specific objectives are:

- 1. To align inclusive education modules conduct at colleges and universities in the Maldives according to the teaching approaches proposed in the revised Inclusive Education Policy 2020.
- 2. To develop inclusion standards in which colleges and universities can refer while designing inclusion module outline.
- 3. To develop a guideline of IE module implementing strategy to make sure all the teachers who graduate are mandatory for completing the module.
- 4. To develop a guideline for awarding teacher licensing upon completion of IE module.
- 5. To conduct stakeholder awareness sessions regarding the revised IE module and guidelines
- 6. To develop an advocacy plan for Shaamilu Veshi project and coordinate with Shaamilu Veshi implementation team.
