Developing CMDA's Website and a Market Disclosure Platform

A. Background

CMDA is an independent institution established under the Maldives Securities Act 2/2006 for developing and regulating the capital market in the Maldives. The CMDA has statutory powers to license securities market intermediaries including brokers, dealers, investment advisers, asset managers, custodians, credit rating agencies as well as stock exchanges and central depositories. The CMDA also has the mandate for supervision of the Maldives Pension Retirement Scheme (MRPS) under the Maldives Pension Act 8/2009.

CMDA's website is the mainstream medium to pass information material to market intermediaries and stakeholders. As part of its strategic development effort, CMDA is planning to revamp its current website with enhanced versatility and user experience.

B. Objectives

The aim for this new website and disclosure platform as proposed in this TOR is to enhance user experience and interaction compared to the current website. CMDA is inviting proposals from qualified companies with a track record of success in designing and producing digital solutions that can aid in developing a new website at www.cmda.gov.mv. The new solutions should provide a fluid and responsive website, further enhancing the functionalities compared to the current website to make it more organized, attractive and user-friendly.

C. Duration

The duration of the project is 3 months.

 company/ entity will propose at least two hosting options with automated backup and present
 their cost and features.
- The company will adjust the chosen concept based on feedback and comments from the CMDA team.
- The vendor will develop the site, adapting it to the different components outlined in the section "deliverables" and adjusting it based on feedback and comments from the CMDA team.
- To create new/integrate and or adapt existing responsive CSS and graphic design elements.
- Development of web sections and content upload.
- All code should be commented and should follow programming best practices.
- Integration and final approval by CMDA.
- Test site before going live.

E. EVALUATION AND SELECTION PROCESS - Total 100 points

Submissions will be evaluated first by **Technical Offer** after which if qualified will then proceed to evaluation of **Financial Offer**.

F. Evaluation of Technical Offer (Phase One and Phase Two) – Total 70 points

G. Qualification for Evaluation of Financial Offer

In order to qualify for further consideration, the company must accomplish a minimum score of 50 points in the technical offer (Sum of Phase one & Phase two).

Formula to get Technical Offer Points:

Total Points for Technical offer = (Sum of points received for Phase One and Phase Two)

H. Evaluation of Financial Offer (Phase 3) – Total 30 Points

The financial offer will account for a maximum of 30 points.

- CVs of the lead developer and other team members (such as junior developers, graphical integrators, graphic designers) for the project to be included in the proposal; (Minimum 2 Team members mandatory Include Individual references and portfolio of work)
- Tax Clearance Report, Shareholders' information and a copy of Company Registration certificate must be submitted to the following address in a sealed envelope.

A separate financial proposal to address the work. The lump-sum fee which is proposed for the
project should indicate the breakdown of all costs as per sample table given below. This fee
should be inclusive of ALL considerations.
