SUMMARY

Islamic University of Maldives is seeking a qualified and experienced Software Developer. This candidate's primary responsibility shall be to carryout works in the creating of new systems and enhancements to existing systems from requirement analysis of concept to launch as part of a cross-functional project. This includes designing, implementing, and testing solutions that result in compelling, easy to use systems.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- To develop software to requirements of the departments by analyzing information needs; conferring with users; studying systems flow, data usage, and work processes; investigating problem areas; following the software development lifecycle.
- Develop features across multiple subsystems within our applications, including collaboration in requirements definition, prototyping, design, coding, testing and deploying programs and systems
- Identifying areas for modification in existing programs and subsequently developing these modifications
- Understand how applications are operated, structured, and users use them
- Investigate, analyze and make recommendations to management regarding technology improvements, upgrades and modifications
- Determining operational practicality by evaluating analysis, problem definition, requirements, solution development, and proposed solutions.
- Documents and demonstrates solutions by developing documentation, flowcharts, layouts, diagrams, charts, code comments and clear code.
- Prepares and installs solutions by determining and designing system specifications, standards, and programming.



- Must have a strong understanding of UI, cross-browser compatibility, general web functions and standards
