

Academic Committee

Introduction

Academic Committee is a standing committee of the Institute, formed pursuant to section 25 (a) of the Maldives Chartered Accountants Act (Law No: 13/2020).

Mandate

Academic Committee is mandated to approve and conduct courses, issue academic certificates, and deliberate and resolve academic matters related to the accountancy profession of the Maldives.

Composition of the Committee

The committee shall comprise of seven (7) members of the Institute. The composition shall be as follows:

- A council member of the Institute appointed by the Council as the chairperson of the Committee
- One (1) representative from Auditor General Office
- Three (3) members from the private or public sector
- One (1) Government Representative
- One (1) Member of the Institute (Vacant Position)

Application Criteria and Evaluation

• Applicants for the Committee shall hold relevant qualification and experience
