

Volunteer's obligations

Volunteers taking part in the programme organised by Green Blue Life Uganda are personally responsible for their own behaviour, personal belongings and health (food, water intake, antimalarials, vaccination, etc). Volunteers are also responsible for arranging their travel insurance, which is mandatory.

A considerable part of the programme takes place in the indomitable African nature, where volunteers will be surrounded by wild animals.

Green Blue Life Uganda ensures professional leadership and volunteers are obliged to follow the instructions of the park rangers, guards, guides and leaders regardless of rank during the whole stay. Volunteers must be in a good physical and mental shape in order to participate.

The consumption of alcohol and other illicit substances is prohibited during the whole stay.

In case that these rules are broken by the volunteer, the programme will be terminated immediately without a refund.

The deposit is non-refundable.

Green Blue Life Uganda is not responsible for damages to the volunteer's belongings or health. Furthermore, Green Blue Life Uganda is not responsible for any damages caused by the volunteer to other parties, subjects or institutions.
