



ABOUT COMPANY

Anigozi is one of the largest walnut producers in Georgia with state-of-the-art processing facilities in the village of Martkopi, Gardabani municipality established with support from Rural Development Agency under the Georgian Ministry of Environment Protection and Agriculture. Working cooperatively with local farmers the company processes and packs Chandler, Lara and Howard walnuts from various regions of Georgia to exacting international specifications. In Georgia, walnuts are harvested from the end of September until the end of October.

All of Anigozi's walnuts are produced to meet the needs of international audiences, especially buyers in EU and Gulf countries. As such, the company maintains a FSSC 22000 certificate, ensuring quality and food safety assurances throughout every stage of operations. With its head office in Georgia's capital city of Tbilisi, the company manages both domestic and international accounts in a manner that ensures accurate and timely deliveries.

In-shell walnuts are packaged in 25kg bulk bags, whilst kernels are available in 5kg, 10kg, 15kg and 20kg vacuum bags.
