Rooted in Heritage, Established in the 1970s by Bob Stein, our winemaking legacy extends to Johann Stein in 1838, introducing Riesling to Australia. Today, led by third-generation winemaker Jacob, our aged vines produce some of Mudgee's most awarded wines.

Jacob Stein, our chief winemaker, credits Mudgee's optimal conditions for our award-winning wines. Our Top Red 5 Stars by James Halliday is a testament to our commitment to quality & the distinct regional character embedded in every bottle.

The family vineyard which is now over 45 years old, is seeing its "old vines" produce exceptional quality fruit for wine. Jacob attributes much of his wine making success to the excellent vineyard site selected by his grandfather and growing conditions of the Mudgee region. The region has a continental climate with warm days and cool nights, combined with excellent soil profiles are some of the attributes that help Mudgee produce great wines with a distinct regional character"

Our mission to create a selection of charcuterie meats stems from our commitment to ethical & sustainable farming for creating locally sourced ingredients.

Our regenerative farming practices encompass a working farm surrounding our vineyard, where Angus Cattle, Dorper Sheep & Free Range Berkshire Pigs graze on native grasses & winter crops. We also source surplus from other producers in the region including spent grain from local brewers & by-product Whey from cheese producers.

Mudgee

- Elevation of town is 462m but most vineyards are at 600m and reach as high as 1182m (Nullo Mountain).
- Harvest during March and April are some of the drier Months.
- MJT: 22.9 ⁰C Warmest month
- Average annual temperature 15.2 ⁰C considered Cool, high variation.
- Mudgee Average Rainfall is 650 mmdrier than Orange and Hunter, but Clare is drier.
- Mudgees wettest months are November
 & December
- Warm summers and quite cold winters.


