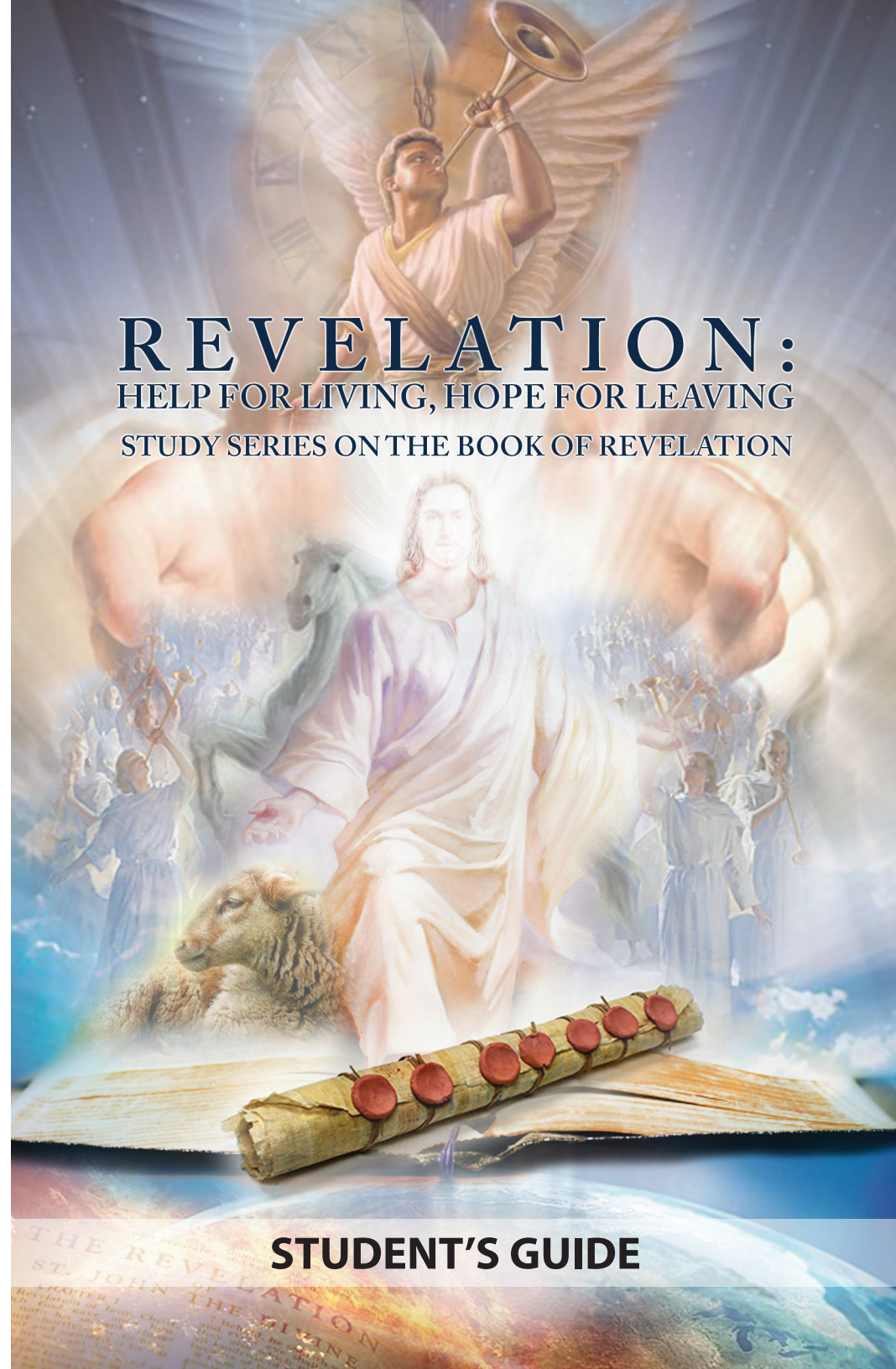

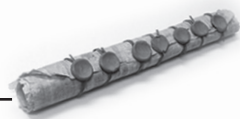

“Letter of Christ to the Church in Pergamum”

Revelation 2:12-17



WELCOME

A Time for **Assembly**: *Introduction* to congregate through ice breaker.
(about 10 minutes)

For Starting Communication: *Aside from the Bible, what other books have greatly influenced you as a Christian?*



WORSHIP

A Time for **Adoration**: *Inspiration* to celebrate through the invocation, impartation of thanksgiving, invitation to worship and read the Scripture.
(about 25 minutes)

Suggested Songs :

“Thy Word,” “We’ll Be Faithful”

Scripture Reading: Rev. 2:12-17



WORD

A Time for **Admonition**: *Instruction* to communicate one’s investigation of the story (content), interpretation based on the setting (context), and integration of the two for the spiritual truth (concept).
(about 50 minutes)

1. How does Christ introduce Himself and what does it signify (v. 12, cf. Hebrews 4:12)?

2. For what does the Lord commend the church in Pergamum (v. 13)?

3. Why did Jesus confront the believers in the church? For what does the Lord condemn them (vv. 14-15)?

4. What instruction did Jesus give to His people as a result of sin in the church (v. 16)?



WALK

A Time for **Accountability**: *Invitation* to culminate in the implication of the Scripture (connect), implementation of a specific action (conduct), and intercession for the saints/seekers (concern).
(about 35 minutes)

1. How have some churches today been influenced away from sound doctrine and God's Word? How have you experienced God's Word work as a "two-edged sword" in your life or seen it evidenced in the life of others you know?
2. If you find that God gives His words of affirmation and consolation to every believer who is able to stand firm for the name of Jesus, what will you do now as you journey with God to receive this words from Him and His consolation?
3. Knowing that God also confronts every believer who sinned against Him and commands to repent for all the sins that have been committed, how will you respond now?
4. Since the Word of God (Bible), the double-edged sword is the only way to discern false teachings, what do you need to work out to have more time reading or hearing it?
5. How can the group pray for you? *Share now your personal needs or concerns with your accountability and prayer partners which may include things that need to be changed and the specific action to be implemented in obedience to God's Word. As you intercede for each other ("saints"), pray also for others outside the group who need to know Jesus ("seekers").*

5. What is the promise and God's consolation for the believers who are able to stand firm for their faith in spite of sufferings and persecutions (v. 17)?

6. What lesson can be learned from Christ's letter to the church in Pergamum (vv. 12, 16)?
