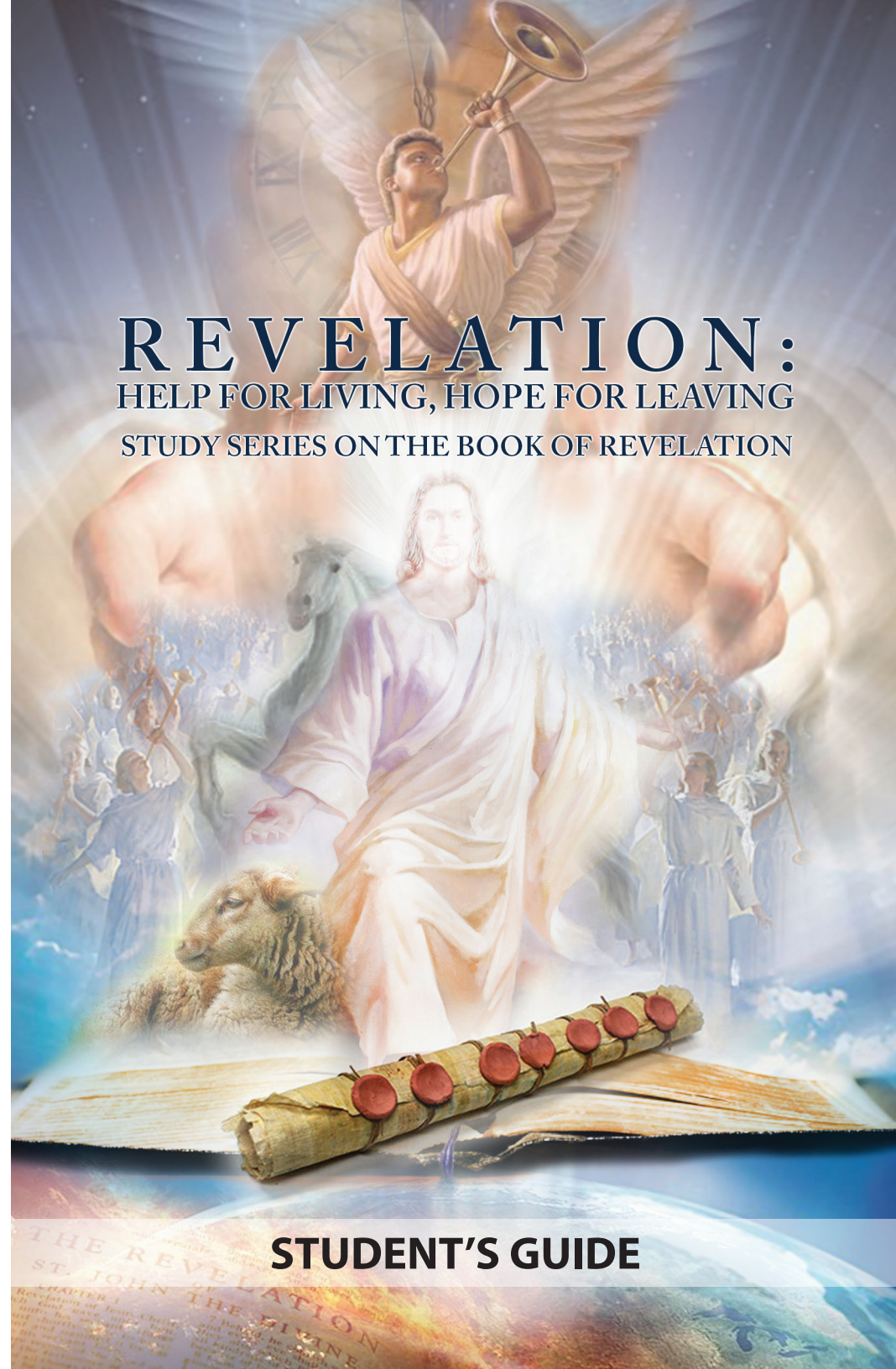

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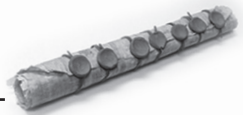

“Letter of Christ to the Church in Philadelphia” *Revelation 3:7-13*



WELCOME

A Time for **Assembly**: *Introduction* to congregate through ice breaker.
(about 10 minutes)

For Starting Communication: *Have you ever been bullied? (This can either be in school or even in the workplace, by either your peers or even your boss.)*



WORSHIP

A Time for **Adoration**: *Inspiration* to celebrate through the invocation, impartation of thanksgiving, invitation to worship and read the Scripture.
(about 25 minutes)

Suggested Songs :

“In Christ Alone,” “We’ll Be Faithful”

Scripture Reading: *Rev. 3:7-13.*



WORD

A Time for **Admonition**: *Instruction* to communicate one’s investigation of the story (content), interpretation based on the setting (context), and integration of the two for the spiritual truth (concept).
(about 50 minutes)

1. What is the description given to Christ in verse 7?

2. How are the people of the church in Philadelphia depicted in the letter (v. 8)?

3. Who are the people being referred to in verse 9?

4. What promises does Christ give the church (vv. 10-11)?

5. What will be given to the ones who persevere until the end (v. 12)?

6. What lesson can be learned from Christ's letter to the church in Philadelphia (vv. 7-11)?



WALK

A Time for **Accountability**: *Invitation* to culminate in the implication of the Scripture (connect), implementation of a specific action (conduct) and intercession for the saints/seekers (concern).
(about 35 minutes)

1. Thank God that we live in a country where there is religious freedom. There is no hostile persecution against Christians here compared to other countries. However, that doesn't mean that we do not face persecution for the beliefs that we hold. How do we experience persecution in our present society and culture?

2. In light of the text, what is the attitude or point of view we can take towards the persecutions we face? How are we to act in relation to these persecutions?

3. How can the group pray for you? *Share now your personal needs or concerns with your accountability and prayer partners which may include things that need to be changed and the specific action to be implemented in obedience to God's Word. As you intercede for each other ("saints"), pray also for others outside the group who need to know Jesus ("seekers").*
