

Θ	WELCOME A Time for Assembly : <i>Introduction</i> to congregate through ice breaker. (about 10 minutes)			
	For Starting Communication: What kind of experience or trial would you consider as worst that affects the spiritual, physical, mental and emotional aspects of a person?			
D	WORSHIP A Time for Adoration : <i>Inspiration</i> to celebrate through the invocation, impartation of thanksgiving, invitation to worship and read the Scripture. (about 25 minutes)

	Scripture Reading: Rev. 6:1-17			
Ŀ	WORD A Time for Admonition: Instruction to communicate one's investigation of the story (content), interpretation based on the setting (context), and integration of the two for the spiritual truth (concept). (about 50 minutes)			
	1. The first seal is broken (read verses 1 and 2). First living creature calls out the first horseman. Bow in hand, crown on his head, and commanded to conquer, who or what does this white horsed rider represent?			

2. The second seal is broken (read verses 3 and 4). Second living creature calls the second horseman to come out. Permitted to take peace from the earth, resulted in people killing each other, a great sword on hand, who or what does this bright red horsed rider represent?

3. The third seal is broken (verses 5 and 6). Third living creature calls the second horseman. A pair of scales on his hand, who or what does this black horsed rider represent? Factor in what the four living creatures said in verse 6.	- - -
