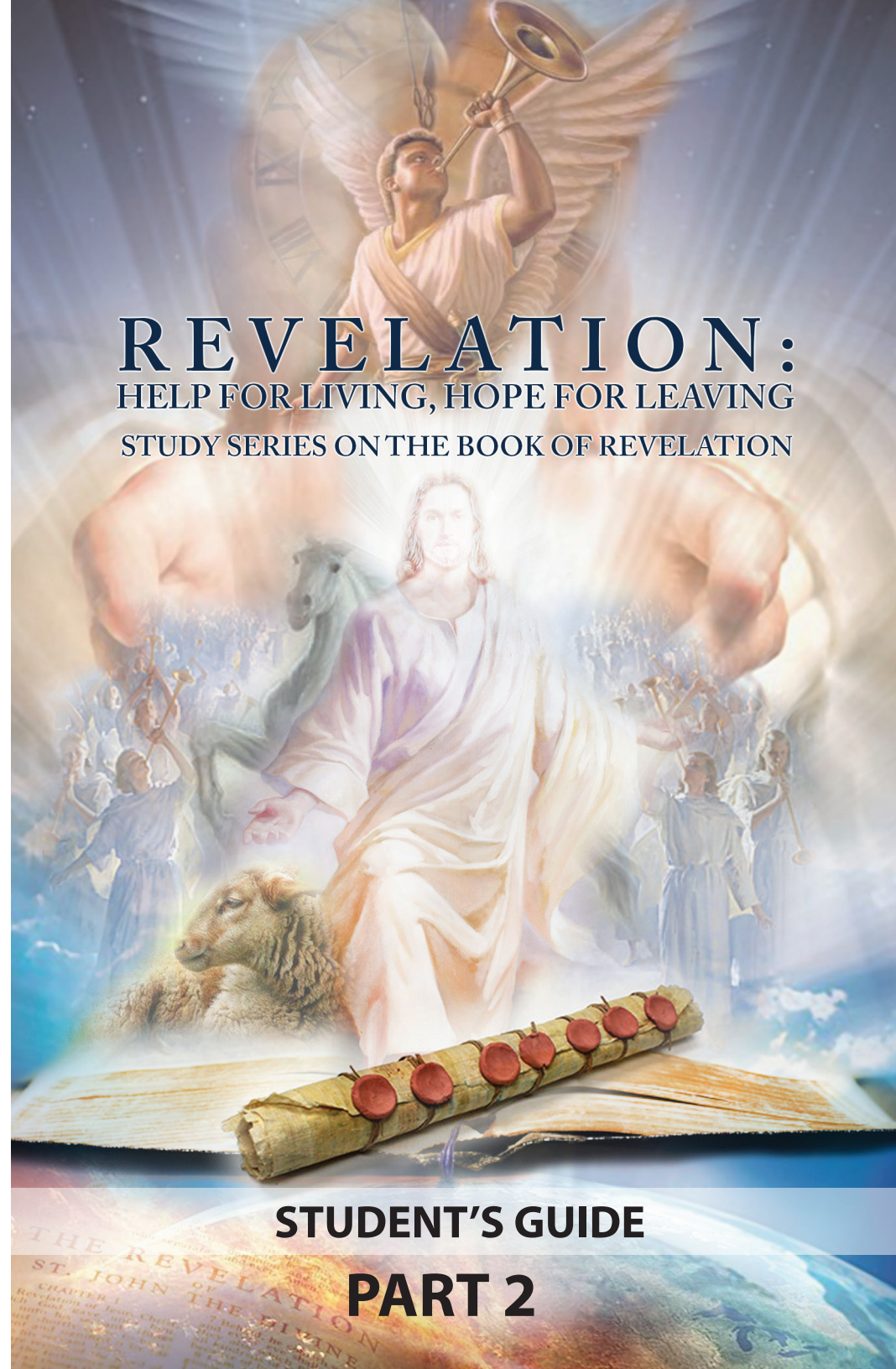

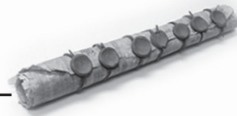

### WELCOME

A Time for **Assembly**: Introduction to congregate through ice breaker.

(about 10 minutes)

For Starting Communication: What is it that gives you strength and hope and even encouragement when you feel you are in a difficult situation?



### WORSHIP

A Time for **Adoration**: Inspiration to celebrate through the invocation, impartation of thanksgiving, invitation to worship and read the Scripture.

(about 25 minutes)

A Time for **Admonition**: Instruction to communicate one’s investigation of the story (content), interpretation based on the setting (context), and integration of the two for the spiritual truth (concept).

**WALK**

A Time for **Accountability**: *Invitation* to culminate in the implication of the Scripture (connect), implementation of a specific action (conduct), and intercession for the saints/seekers (concern).  
*(about 35 minutes)*

1. As a Christian and a follower of Jesus Christ what is your mission and plan to do, knowing that it will be too dangerous and difficult for the people to live and survive during this time, knowing also that there are possibilities that your loved ones and friends will experience this because most of them do not have a personal relationship with Jesus Christ?
2. Share where you find hope in times of trials and sufferings. How do you intend to live out your faith in Christ and your integrity as a Christian despite the difficulties in life?
3. How can the group pray for you? *Share now your personal needs or concerns with your accountability and prayer partners which may include things that need to be changed and the specific action to be implemented in obedience to God's Word. As you intercede for each other ("saints"), pray also for others outside the group who need to know Jesus ("seekers").*
