

Revelation 15:1-16:21

WELCOME

A Time for Assembly: Introduction to congregate through ice breaker. (about 10 minutes)

For Starting Communication: Let us say you were given information or news that will have great significance and impact on certain people (like a dam that is about to burst threatening a few community and saving some), how would you respond? Name a few things you might do and how you would do them.

WORSHIP

A Time for Adoration: Inspiration to celebrate through the invocation, impartation of thanksgiving, invitation to worship and read the Scripture. (about 25 minutes)

Suggested Songs:

Scripture Reading: Rev. 15:1-16:21

A Time for Admonition: Instruction to communicate one's investigation of the story (content), interpretation based on the setting (context), and integration of the two for the spiritual truth (concept). (about 50 minutes)

WALK

A Time for **Accountability**: Invitation to culminate in the implication of the Scripture (connect), implementation of a specific action (condúct), and intercession for the saints/seekers (concern).

(about 35 minutes)

1. What encouragement can we draw from this passage? How can the interlude (a be-attitude) in 16:15 help you as a true follower of Christ in your journey in the here and now?

2. How can you make the truth from this passage relevant to people who are yet unbelievers? Think of specific person/s as you ask this question.

3. How can the group pray for you? Share now your personal needs or concerns with your accountability and prayer partners which may include things that need to be changed and the specific action to be implemented in obedience to God's Word. As you intercede for each other ("saints"), pray also for others outside the group who need to know Jesus ("seekers").
