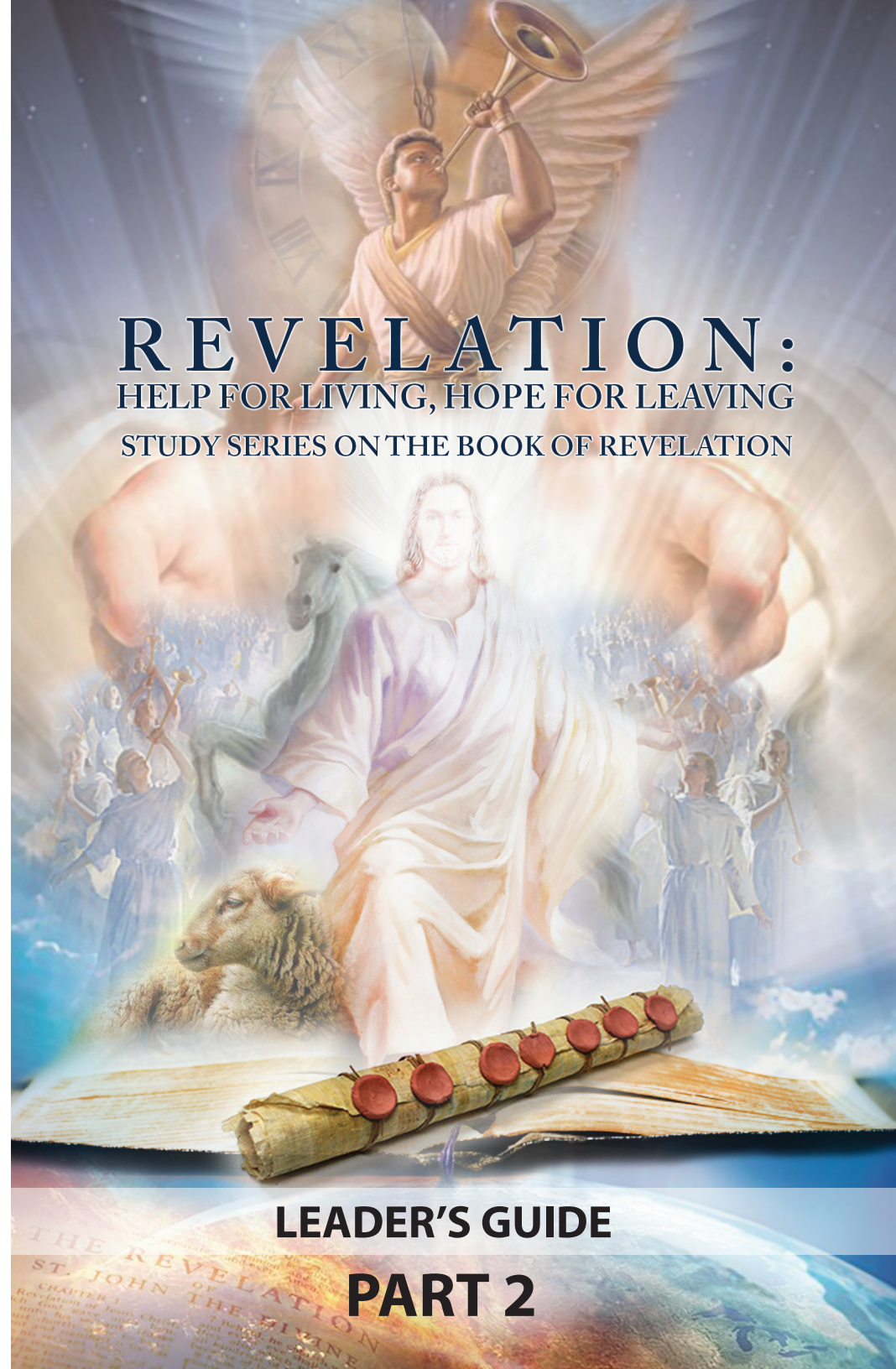

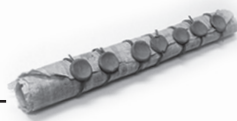

### WELCOME

A Time for **Admonition**: *Instruction* to communicate one’s investigation of the story (content), interpretation based on the setting (context), and integration of the two for the spiritual truth (concept).

*(about 50 minutes)*

### WALK

A Time for **Accountability**: *Invitation* to culminate in the implication of the Scripture (connect), implementation of a specific action (conduct), and intercession for the saints/seekers (concern).  
(about 35 minutes)

1. How does the certainty of Satan’s defeat affect the way you think about God and serve Him in this present world that is filled with opposition to Him?
2. How do the rewards of those who were martyred because of their testimony about Jesus and the word of God encourage you to share your faith and testimony to people who are resistant to God and the Gospel? Is there anyone whom God may be prodding you to share the Gospel this week?
3. How can you guard yourself from Satan’s deception and influences and be victorious?
4. Are you sure that your name is in the book of life? If you are, how are you sharing this good news to people in your spheres of influence? If you are not, what must you do to be saved from hell?
5. How can the group pray for you? *Share now your personal needs or concerns with your accountability and prayer partners which may include things that need to be changed and the specific action to be implemented in obedience to God’s Word. As you intercede for each other (“saints”), pray also for others outside the group who need to know Jesus (“seekers”).*
