Matthew 9:35-38

I. Jesus, the Gospel Proclaimer to All Peoples

- A. Jesus is for all peoples (Luke 19:10)
- B. The Gospel for all peoples (*Mark 16:15*)
- C. Proclaimer for all peoples (*Matthew 28:18-20*)

II. Our Attitude Towards a Diverse Community (Matthew 9:35-38)

- A. We must have the Compassion of the Savior (ν . 36a)
- B. We must know the Condition of the Sinners (v. 36b)
- C. We must obey the Commission to the Saints (v. 37, 38)

- 5. The Workers must be sent.
