WELCOME

A Time for **Assembly**

Introduction to gather together through an ice breaker (10 minutes)

To start: Briefly share “white lies” that many Filipinos are fond of making.

WORSHIP

A Time for **Adoration**

Inspiration to worship God through invocation, thanksgiving, and reading of Scripture (25 minutes)

Scripture Reading: Genesis 12:10-20

WORD

A Time for **Admonition**

Instruction to communicate one’s investigation of the story (content), interpretation based on the setting (context), and integration of the two for the spiritual truth (concept) (50 minutes)

1. God had just given His great promises to Abram (12:1-3). What could be His purpose for allowing famine to come (12:10)?
2. Why did Abram resort to lying about his wife (12:11-13)? What weakness did Abram demonstrate by resorting to deception?
3. What serious consequence could Abram’s deception have brought (12:14-15)?
4. How did God respond to Abram’s lack of faith in God’s protection and blessing (12:16, 20)?
5. What lesson can we learn from Abram’s actions? Read 1 Corinthians 10:11 and Romans 11:29.

WALK

A Time for **Accountability**

Invitation to apply the implication of the Scripture (connect), implementation of a specific action (conduct), and intercession for the saints/seekers (concern) (about 35 minutes)

1. As an act of trust in God that He will protect you, what “white lies” will you avoid making?
2. What promises of God will you claim this week?
3. Remember an instance in your faith journey when you compromised your integrity. How did God correct you?
4. How can the group pray for you? Share now your personal needs or concerns with your accountability and prayer partners. These may include attitudes that need to be changed and/or specific actions to be done in obedience to God’s Word. As you intercede for each other, pray also for others outside the group who need to know Jesus.
