# A Time for **Admonition**

*Instruction* to communicate one's investigation of the story (content), interpretation based on the setting (context), and integration of the two for the spiritual truth (concept) (50 minutes)

- From what is recorded in Genesis, God had not spoken to Abram since he decided to sleep with Hagar and she conceived a son (16:6). Thirteen years later, God broke His silence (17:1). What name of God did He reveal to Abram (17:1)?
- 2. What is the focal point of Genesis 17 (17:1,2)?
- 3. What is the difference between the Abrahamic Covenant and the Covenant of Circumcision (17:9-14)?

- 4. What are the specific blessings of the Abrahamic Covenant, that is, God's covenant with Abraham (17:6-8)?
- 5. What is the significance of God's act of changing the names of Abram and Sarai (17:5,15)?
- 6. Did Abraham fully understand right away that God will fulfill His promise through Sarah's giving birth to a son (17-18)?
- 7. How did God respond to Abraham's continuing uncertainty (17:19-21)?

# WAIK

# A Time for **Accountability**

Invitation to apply the implication of the Scripture (connect), implementation of a specific action (condúct), and intercession for the saints/seekers (concern) (about 35 minutes)

- God oftentimes fulfills His promises to us in the course of several years.
  What promise of God have you been claiming that He has been fulfilling?
- 2. If you had failed to cling to God's promises to you, what renewal of faith in these promises will you make?
- 3. How can the group pray for you? Share now your personal needs or concerns with your accountability and prayer partners. These may include attitudes that need to be changed and/or specific actions to be done in obedience to God's Word. As you intercede for each other, pray also for others outside the group who need to know Jesus.
