WELCOME

A Time for **Assembly**

Introduction to gather together through an ice breaker (10 minutes)

To start: Share briefly how your officemates, business associates or friends got to know that you are a Christian.

WORSHIP

A Time for **Adoration**

Inspiration to worship God through invocation, thanksgiving, and reading of Scripture (25 minutes)

Scripture Reading: Genesis 18:1-19:38

WORD

A Time for Admonition

Instruction to communicate one's investigation of the story (content), interpretation based on the setting (context), and integration of the two for the spiritual truth (concept) (50 minutes)

- Even after God assured Abraham and Sarah that nothing is impossible with Him, Sarah still laughed in unbelief at the promise of a son (18:11-15). Did she continue in this state of unbelief? Read Hebrews 11:11.
- 2. Why did the Lord say he would return the next year? What was the purpose of his passing by (18:3,10)?
- 3. What can we learn from God and Abraham's "bargaining" (18:23-33)?
- 4. What does "the way of the Lord" and "doing righteousness and justice"

mean? (18:19)

- 5. Lot was a believer of God. Why then could he offer his own daughters to the wicked men of Sodom (19:8)?
- 6. What could be the reason why Lot's sons-in-law did not take his sound of alarm that God's judgment had come to Sodom (19:12-14)?
- 7. Did God save Lot from the judgment of Sodom because of his own merit (19:27-29)?
- What are two horrendous consequences of Lot's adoption of the wickedness of Sodom (19:30-38)? Read 2 Kings 24:2 and 2 Chronicles 20:1.

WALK

A Time for **Accountability**

Invitation to apply the implication of the Scripture (connect), implementation of a specific action (condúct), and intercession for the saints/seekers (concern) (about 35 minutes)

- 1. What practices common to our society do you think God considers unacceptable?
- 2. How can we strengthen our testimony to people who reject the standards of the Bible?
- 3. Set a time this week for personal examination when you will ask the Holy Spirit to impress on you any sinful habit or tendency that you have long been following.
- 4. How can the group pray for you? Share now your personal needs or concerns with your accountability and prayer partners. These may include attitudes that need to be changed and/or specific actions to be done in obedience to God's Word. As you intercede for each other, pray also for others outside the group who need to know Jesus.
