A Time for Assembly

Introduction to gather together through an ice breaker (10 minutes)

To start: Share briefly a Christian funeral service where the gospel was presented to the bereaved family.

WORSHIP

Inspiration to worship God through invocation, thanks giving, and reading of Scripture (25 minutes)

Scripture Reading: Genesis 23:1-20

WORD

A Time for **Admonition**

Instruction to communicate one's investigation of the story (content), interpretation based on the setting (context), and integration of the two for the spiritual truth (concept) (50 minutes)

- 1. What did Abraham signify by his purchase of a burial site for Sarah (23:3-4)?
- 2. While Abraham believed that God will eventually give the Promised Land to him, Abraham still recognized and followed the Hittites, the local authorities (22:17). What does he model for us who live in our country today? Read 1 Peter 2:11-17.
- 3. The burial site of Sarah was the only piece of property that Abraham possessed (23:19-20). What was Abraham looking forward to beyond accumulating material wealth? Read Hebrews 11:9-10, 13-16.

4. In what way did Abraham demonstrate his faith in God to the Hittites when he bought the burial site of Sarah and buried her there (23:12-16)?

WALK

A Time for Accountability

Invitation to apply the implication of the Scripture (connect), implementation of a specific action (condúct), and intercession for the saints/seekers (concern) (about 35 minutes)

- 1. What would you plan to do to people who are presently grieving the loss of their loved one?
- 2. What would you like to include in your own memorial service?
- 3. How can the group pray for you? Share now your personal needs or concerns with your accountability and prayer partners. These may include attitudes that need to be changed and/or specific actions to be done in obedience to God's Word. As you intercede for each other, pray also for others outside the group who need to know Jesus.
