

How God's Family Grows (The Local Church)

Acts 2:42-6:7

We are looking at one of the most exciting times in the history of the early church, its exponential growth as — both corporately and individually — the church had a laser-like focus on what it was teaching and what it wanted to achieve. This was by the congregation as a whole and not just its leadership.

When we compare how they grew then, to the stale, lifeless way that many churches today are proceeding, we realize we have so much to learn and so far to go. But growth for growth's sake is also dangerous if we grow in the wrong way. So let's look at why the early church grew so fast *and* so well:

CHURCHES GROW THE RIGHT WAY WHEN THE CONGREGATION IS FOCUSED: They were focused on becoming a people of God.

They "devoted themselves" to:

- 1) "The Apostles' Teaching": We must never be apologetic or bashful about emphasizing sound teaching and sound doctrine. What we must be careful of is to not practice what we know. Doctrine is always practical!
- 2) "The Fellowship": This fellowship occurred in both big gatherings (at the Temple, "pasture") and small (house to house, "sheep pens").
- 3) "The Breaking of Bread": Worship through the Lord's Supper or Communion was a regular feature. The emphasis was on reminding believers of God's grace through the Cross.
- 4) "The Prayers": Prayer was a constant feature of the early church. The strength of a church is best measured by its prayer life.

They were not after numbers. They never were. But the church grew because as they faithfully did what was right, God sovereignly "added to their number day by day those who were being saved" (Acts 2:47). The same God who does the saving, does the adding.

CHURCHES GROW THE RIGHT WAY WHEN CHURCH LEADERS ARE FOCUSED: They were focused on leading people to God.

- 1) The leaders do the works of God (Acts 3:1-10; Acts 5:29, 42; Acts 6:1-7).
- 2) The leaders give glory to God (Acts 3:12, 16; Acts 4:20)
- 3) The leaders (by words and example) deliver the message of God (Acts 3:19; Acts 4:12; Acts 5:42; Acts 6:4)

FINAL THOUGHTS

Churches grow because Jesus is focused on keeping His Word when He said "I will build my church". This explains Acts 6:7 "And the word of God continued to increase, and the number of the disciples multiplied greatly in Jerusalem, and a great many of the priests became obedient to the faith".

Nobody wants to be part of a losing cause. So when the church is alive and on fire it creates a self-perpetuating cycle that attracts people, and sends out people who bring in people and who start new ministries in new areas. This is exactly what happened in the early church! Who says it can't happen to us today?

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- 1. In view of Acts 2:42-47, what should our church be doing more of? What should our church be doing less? Explain your answer to the rest of the group.
- 2. Are you already part of a Growth Group (or similar small group for spiritual growth and accountability)? Why or why not? What are the disadvantages for people in a megachurch who are not part of one?
- 3. Pray seriously about your part in our church's growth and future. While no one is indispensable, everyone is important. Ask God for help in discerning your important place and to make your contribution to God's Kingdom Agenda and the growth of His spiritual family, our church.
