God's Work and Warfare

NEHEMIAH 4

You were born in a war zone upon second birth. You were resurrected inside enemy territory. While we may not have the kind of enemies Nehemiah and the remnant faced (who wanted them literally dead) our enemies can be no less determined, and no less harmful.

What can a believer do when God wants to build His kingdom through you, but you face relentless opposition in your ministry (as we remind ourselves that all of life is ministry for a Christian)?

1. THE REALITY OF OPPOSITION: GOD SOMETIMES PERMITS OPPOSITION ACCORDING TO HIS PURPOSES.

- While God called Nehemiah and his team to rebuild the city of God for God's purposes, Sanballat and company opposed them for selfish purposes. They felt threatened (Nehemiah 2:10) and left out (Nehemiah 2:20).
- How did their enemies attempt to stop God's work? The methods they used are just as effective today:
 - 1. Humiliating others (vv. 1-3)
 - 2. Gathering people against others (vv.6-8)
 - 3. Spreading rumors about others (vv. 11-12)

Which of these affects you most? The answer matters because you can then do what Nehemiah and his team did. Which of these have you been guilty of? Breathe a prayer of repentance and ask God to help you live in love, not hatred (Colossians 3:12-14).

2. THE RESULTS OF OPPOSITION: GOD MAY LET US FEEL DOWN SO HE CAN BUILD US UP (vv. 10-11)

• Half-way is a crisis point in anything worthwhile, as Nehemiah's team discovered (v. 6). By that time, initial enthusiasm has worn out but the end is not yet sufficiently in sight to encourage the final push. Add to this setbacks, like opposition — and you have the reason for most unfinished projects — "what might have been".

- Verses 10-11 reveal how badly the workers felt, and how successful the opposition was. You sometimes feel the way they did, in your own life or ministry:
 - Fatigue "The strength of those who bear the burdens is failing" (v. 10a)
 - 2. Frustration 'There is too much rubble. By ourselves we will not be able to rebuild the wall". (v. 10b)
 - 3. Fear (v. 11) our enemies said, "They will not know or see till we come among them and kill them..."

God let them experience these so that they would realize that the Lord, who is great and awesome (v. 14), frustrated the enemy's plan (v. 15), and would fight for them (v. 19). God let them taste seeming defeat so that the final victory would be sweeter (Nehemiah 6:15). God often does the same for His followers today as they carry on His work.

3. THE RESPONSE TO OPPOSITION: GOD SHOWS THE WAY TO HANDLE OPPOSITION VICTORIOUSLY.

- God worked in the heart of faithful Nehemiah, to teach us how to similarly thrive despite opposition. What are the God-pleasing responses to opposition?
 - 1. Pray (vv. 4-5)
 - 2. Prepare yourself and the team well (v. 9)
 - 3. Protect your weak points (v. 13)
 - 4. Preach to your team about God and what He can do (v. 14)
 - 5. Persist. Don't quit. Never give up till the job is done (vv. 15-23)

FINAL THOUGHTS

God's work will always encounter warfare. It comes with your birthright as one of God's own. Even if the attacks seem purely human-caused, they may have an evil supernatural aspect. Sometimes it can be mostly supernatural, and being naïve about it won't help. But "you are from God and have overcome them, for He who is in you is greater than he who is in the world" (1 John 4:4). Therefore, let us be "praying at all times in the Spirit, with all prayer and supplication. To that end keep alert with all perseverance, making supplication for all the saints" (Ephesians 6:18).

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- 1. Some of the principles in no. 3, "The Response to Opposition", are also useful in running any project or ministry (with or without opposition). Which of them are, in your viewpoint?
- 2. Personally, between ridicule, conspiracy, or rumors, what affects you most? Why? How do you think a right view of God can help?
- 3. As you pray together, ask God for discernment when you need to pray against the work of the Evil one in the different circumstances of your lives. Then ask God to help you constantly trust Him all throughout.
